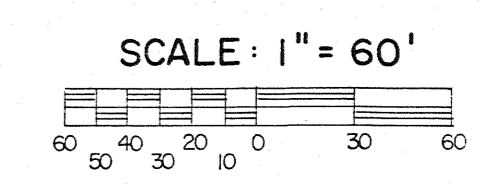


PLAT OF BOUNDARY SURVEY

 & ASSOC., DATED MAY 18, 1974

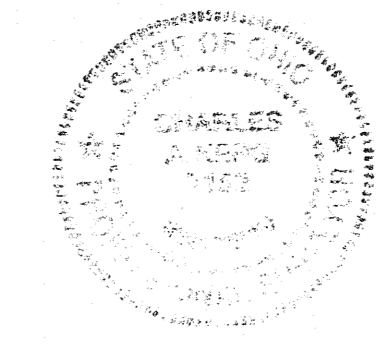
