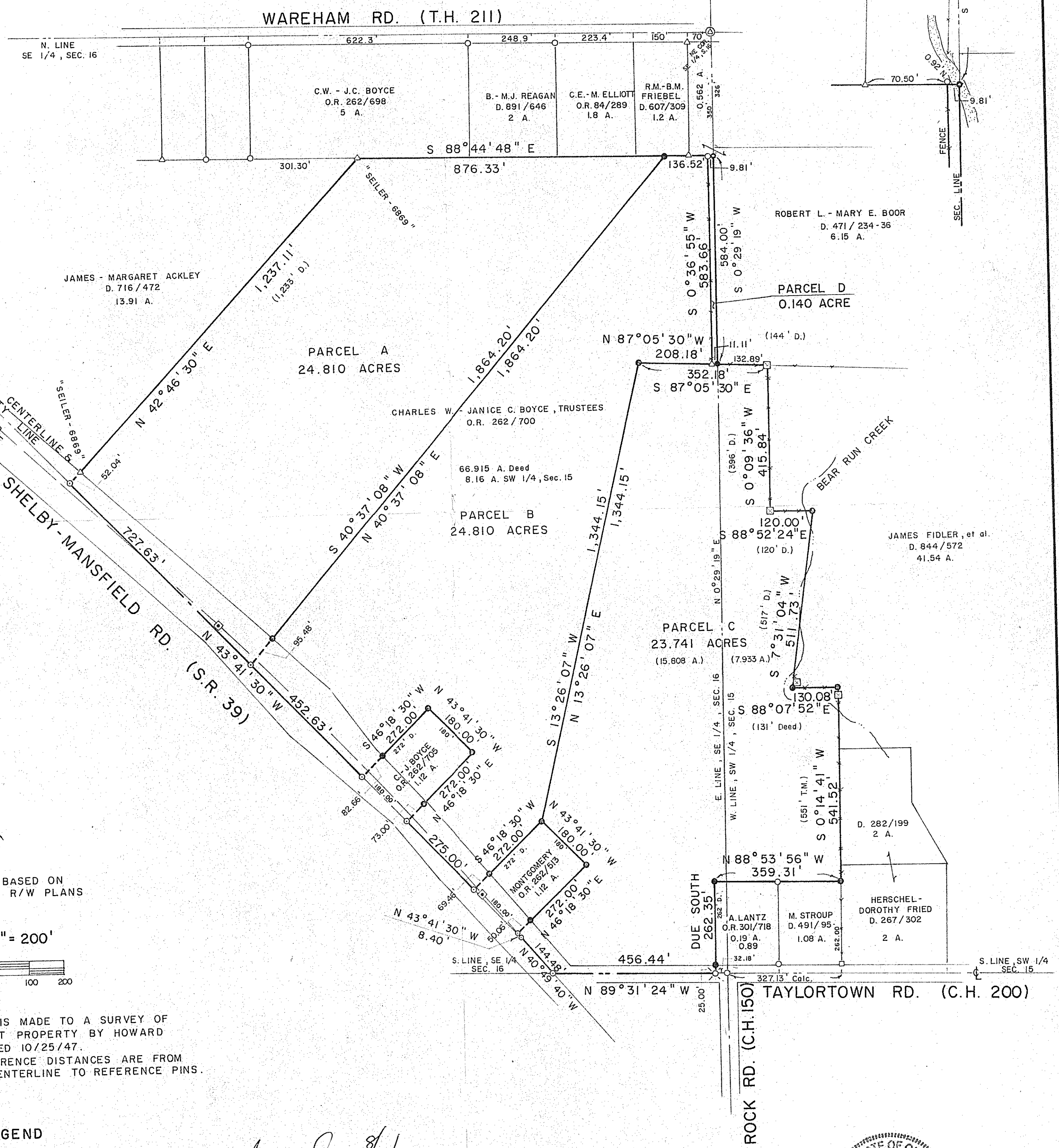
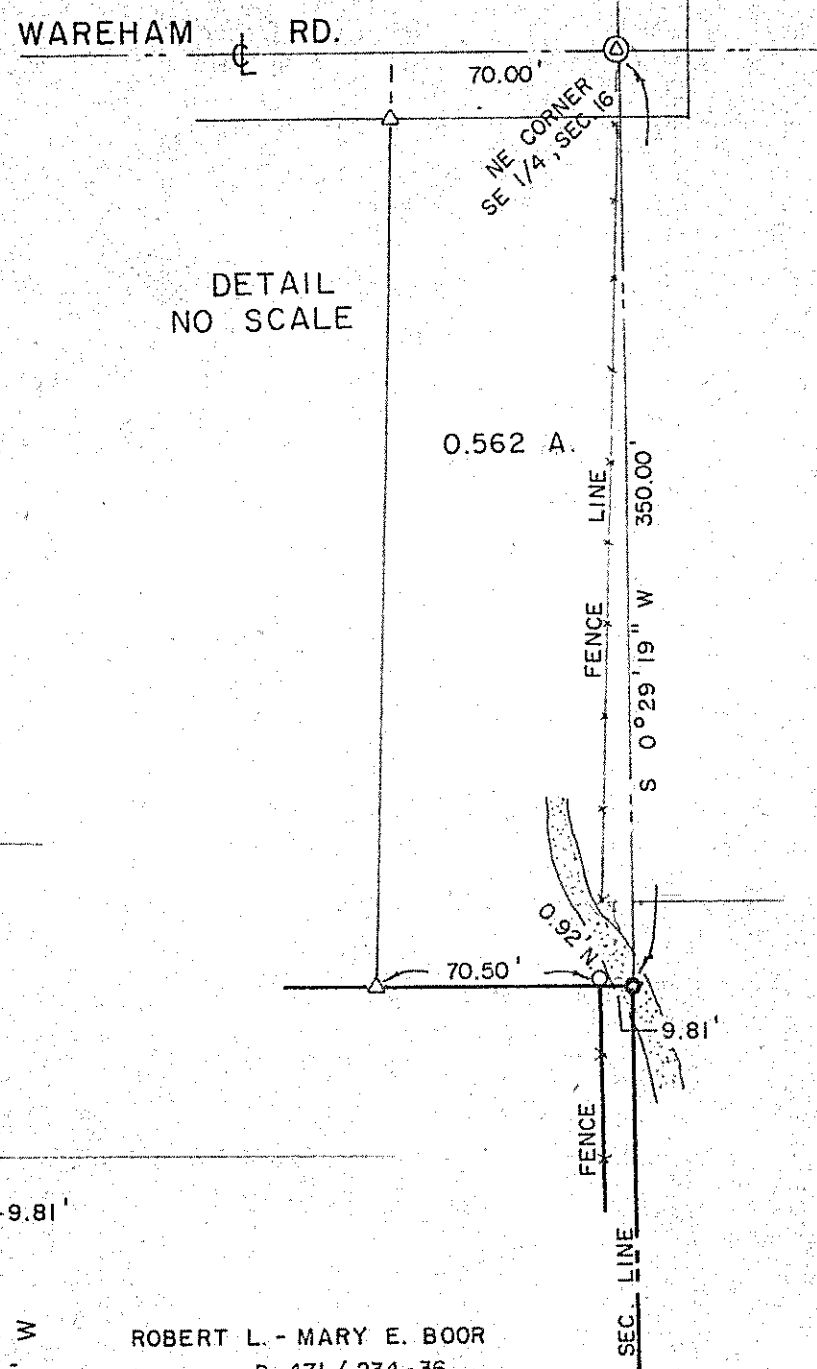
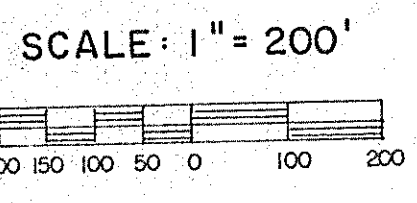


PLAT OF BOUNDARY SURVEY

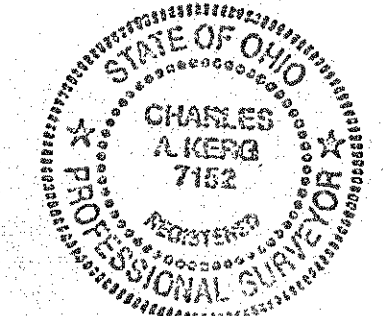
