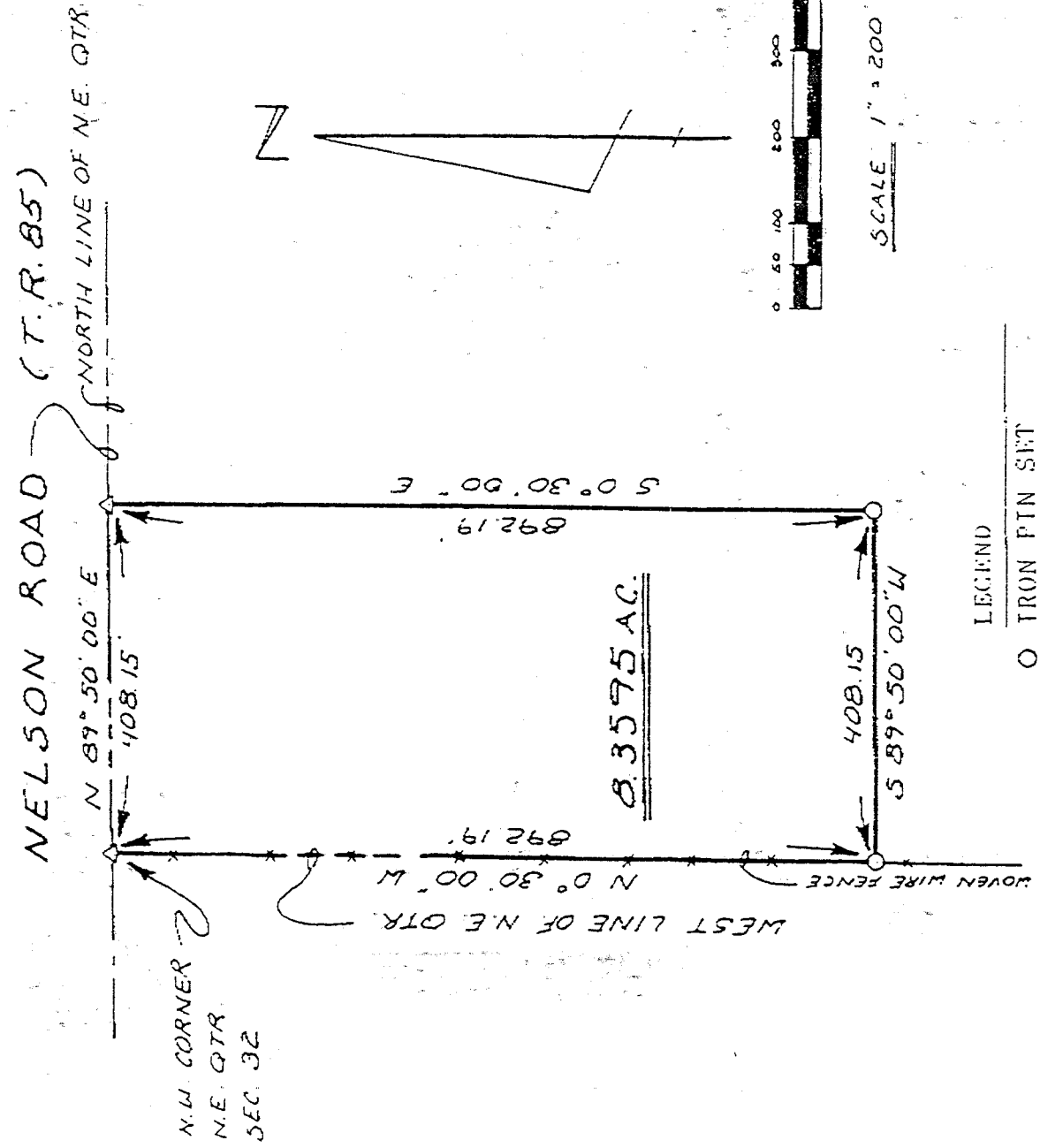


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PLAT OF SURVEY FOR HENRY COBLENTZ

RICHLAND COUNTY, OHIO

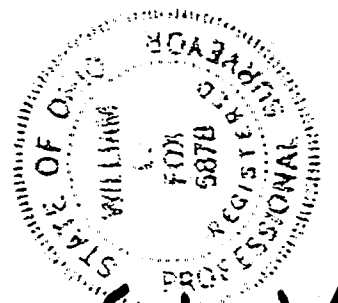


LEGEND

Situated in the Township of Butler, County of Richland and State of Ohio and also known as being a part of the Northeast Quarter of Section 32, Township 25, Range 17, and more fully described as follows:

Commencing at a railroad spike set at the Northwest corner of the Northeast Quarter of Section 32, and in the center of Nelson Road, said spike also being the TRUE PLACE OF BEGINNING.

thence North 89° 50' 00" East, along the North line of said Northeast Quarter and the center of Nelson Road, 408.15 feet to a railroad spike set;

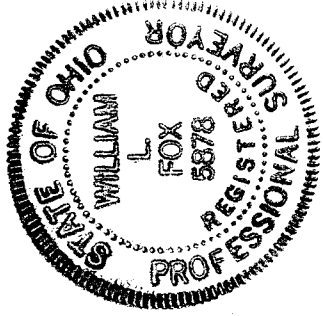
thence South 0° 30' 00" East, 892.19 feet to an iron pin set;

thence South 89° 50' 00" West, 408.15 feet to an iron pin set on the West line of the Northeast Quarter adjacent to a woven wire fence;

thence North 0° 30' 00" West, along said West line and said woven wire fence, 892.19 feet to the TRUE PLACE OF BEGINNING containing 8.3595 acres of land but subject to all legal highways and easements of record.
