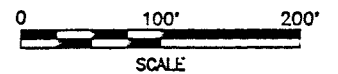
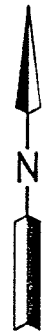

SURVEYOR'S DESCRIPTION

3.000 ACRES

Situated in the Township of Perry, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being part of the Southeast Quarter of Section 26, Township 19, Range 19 and being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a iron pin found in the southeast corner of said Southeast Quarter, said iron pin also being in the centerline of Follin Road (T.H. 120) (60 feet);

Thence N 2° 15' 00" E, 993.00 feet along said centerline of Follin Road also being the east line of said Southeast Quarter to a railroad spike set, said railroad spike being the northeast corner of a parcel of land conveyed to Danny G. Gearhart by volume 863, page 698 of Richland County deed records and the true place of beginning;

Thence N 86° 52' 41" W, 675.35 feet of which 279.00 feet is along said land of Danny G. Gearhart and 396.35 feet is along the north line of a parcel of land conveyed to William E. and Betty L. Nye by deed volume 460, page 17 to an iron pin set and passing through an iron pin set at 30.00 feet;

Thence N 2° 15' 00" E, 193.50 feet and parallel to said centerline of Follin Road to an iron pin set;

Thence S 86° 52' 41" E, 675.35 feet to a railroad spike set in said centerline also being in the east line of said southeast quarter and passing through an iron pin set at 645.35 feet;

Thence S 2° 15' 00" W, 193.50 feet along said centerline and east line to the true place of beginning and containing 3.000 acres, more or less, but subject to all legal highways and easements of record.

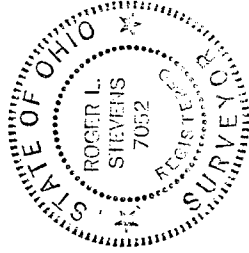

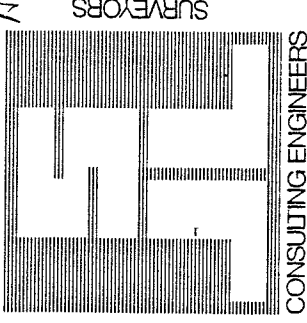
