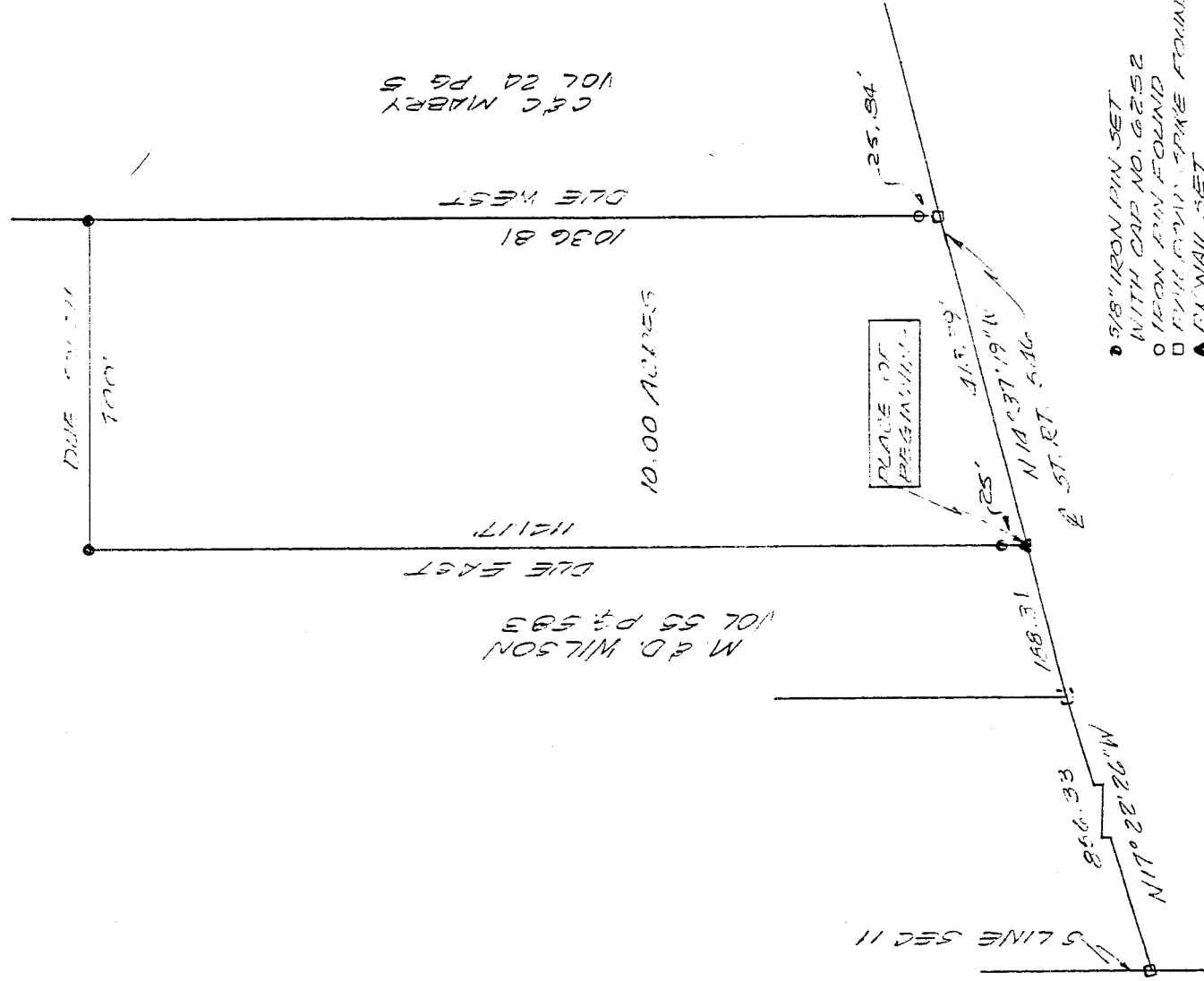

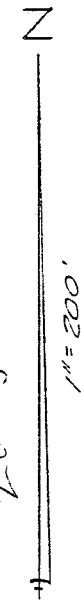

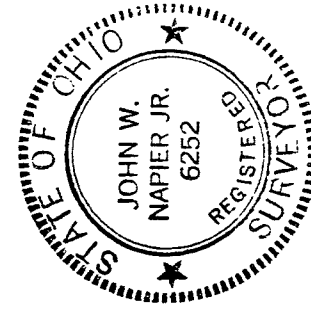

BEING A PART OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 11, TWP. 19,  
R-10 OF PERRY TOWNSHIP, RICHLAND COUNTY, OHIO AND MORE

PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

COMMENCING AT A RAILROAD SPIKE FOUND AT THE INTERSECTION OF  
STATE ROUTE #546 AND THE SOUTH LINE OF SECTION 11; THENCE  
NORTH 17 DEGREES 22 MINUTES 26 SECONDS WEST, 856.53 FEET  
ALONG THE CENTERLINE OF STATE ROUTE #546 TO A RAILROAD SPIKE  
FOUND; THENCE NORTH 14 DEGREES 37 MINUTES 19 SECONDS WEST,  
188.34 FEET ALONG THE CENTER OF STATE ROUTE #546 TO A NAIL  
SET BEING THE TRUE PLACE OF BEGINNING;

THENCE CONTINUING NORTH 14 DEGREES 37 MINUTES 19 SECONDS  
WEST, 413.39 FEET ALONG THE CENTER OF STATE ROUTE #546 TO A  
SPIKE FOUND;

THENCE DUE WEST, 1036.81 FEET PASSING AN IRON PIN FOUND AT  
25.84 FEET ALONG A LINE COMMON WITH C. & C. MABRY TO AN IRON
