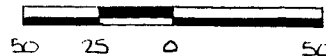
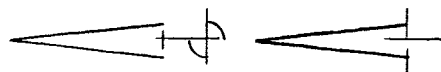

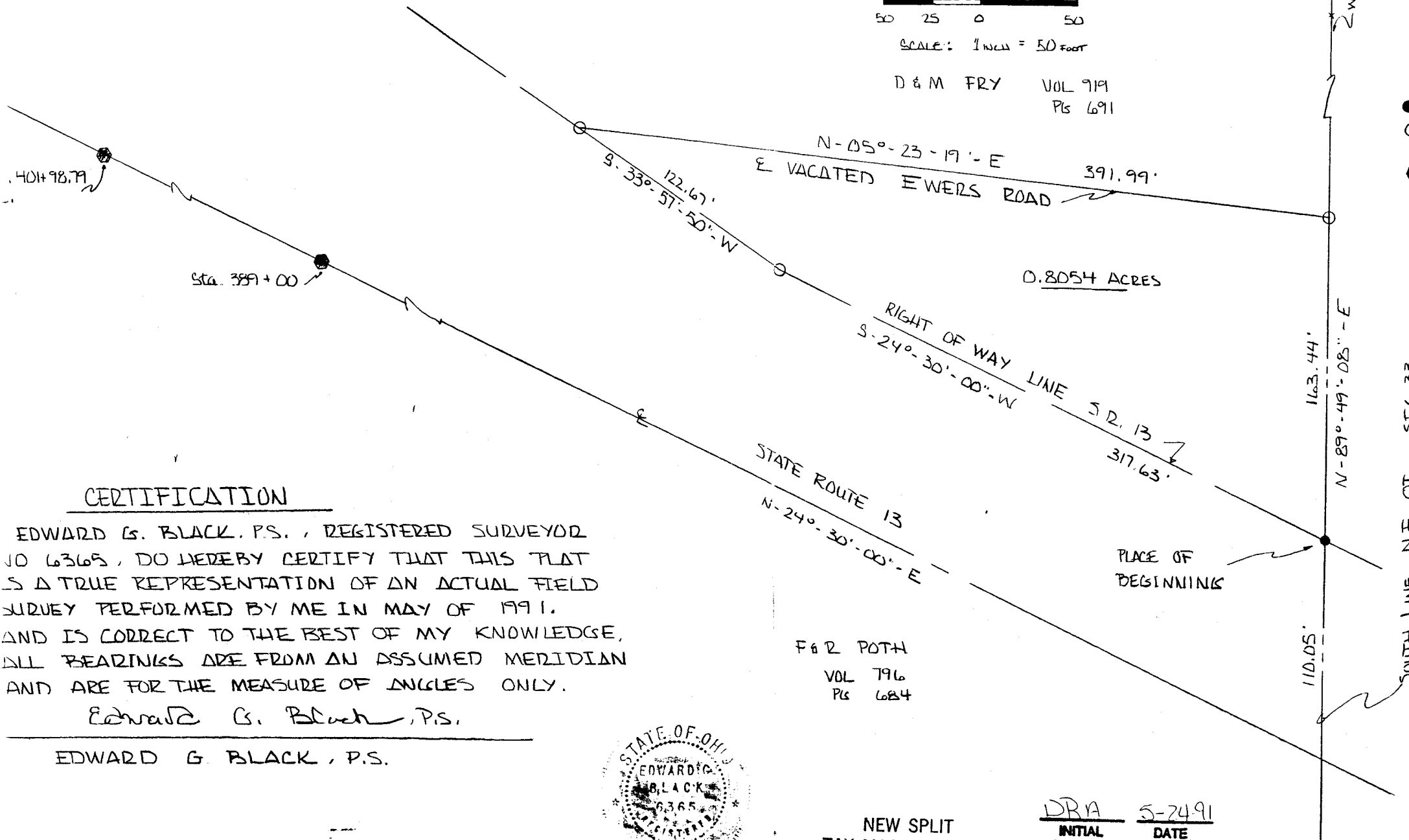

LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF 0.8054 ACRES
FOR
DARRELL FRY

BEING A PARCEL OF LAND SITUATED IN PART OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION NUMBER 33, TOWNSHIP 20 - RANGE 18, TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON, COUNTY OF RICHLAND, STATE OF OHIO AND BEING MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

BEGINNING AT AN IRON PIN FOUND AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE SOUTH LINE OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION NUMBER 33 AND THE EAST RIGHT - OF - WAY LINE OF STATE ROUTE NUMBER 13;

THENCE NORTH - 89 DEG. - 49 MIN. - 08SEC. - EAST AND ALONG SAID SOUTH LINE A DISTANCE OF ONE HUNDRED SIXTY THREE AND FOURTY FOUR HUNDREDTHS (163.44) FEET TO AN IRON PIN WITH CAP SET IN THE CENTER OF VACATED EMERS ROAD;

THENCE NORTH - 05 DEG. - 23 MIN. - 19 SEC. - EAST AND ALONG THE CENTER OF SAID VACATED ROAD A DISTANCE OF THREE HUNDRED NINETY ONE AND NINETY NINE HUNDREDTHS (391.99) FEET TO AN IRON PIN WITH CAP SET IN THE EAST RIGHT - OF - WAY LINE OF STATE ROUTE NUMBER 13;

THENCE SOUTH - 33 DEG. - 57 MIN. - 50 SEC. - WEST AND ALONG THE EAST RIGHT - OF - WAY LINE OF SAID STATE ROUTE A DISTANCE OF ONE HUNDRED TWENTY TWO AND SIXTY SEVEN HUNDREDTHS (122.67) FEET TO AN IRON PIN WITH CAP SET;

THENCE SOUTH - 24(MIN.) - 30 MIN. - 00 SEC. - WEST AND CONTINUING ALONG SAID RIGHT - OF - WAY LINE A DISTANCE OF THREE HUNDRED SEVENTEEN AND SIXTY THREE HUNDREDTHS (317.63) FEET TO AN IRON PIN FOUND AN THE PLACE OF BEGINNING.
