

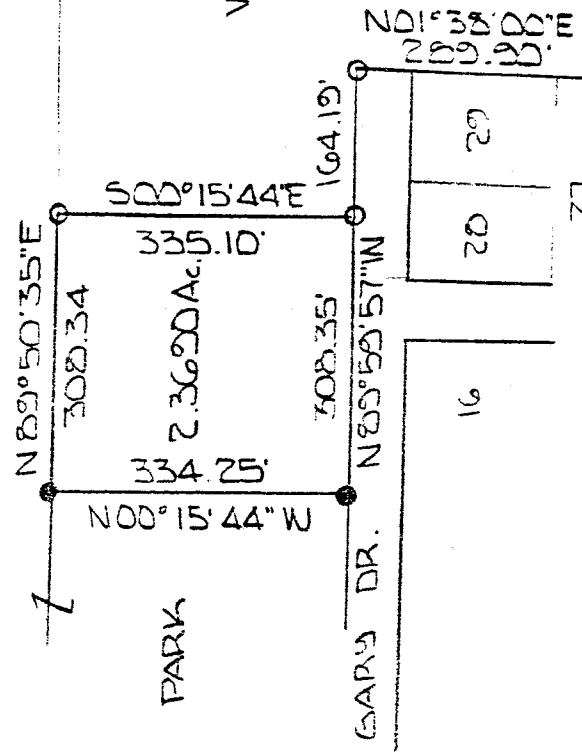

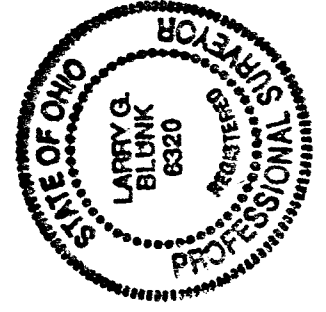
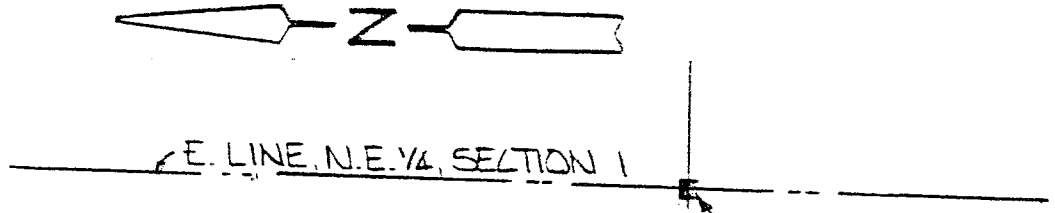

FOR
HAROLD WILSON

Located in the Township of Washington, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being a part of the Northeast Quarter of Section 1, Township 20, Range 18 and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a fence post found in the Southeast Corner of the Northeast Quarter of Section 1.

Thence S 89 degrees 42' 48" W along the south line of the Northeast Quarter of Section 1 a distance of 629.06 feet to an iron pin set.

Thence N 01 degrees 38' 00" E a distance of 289.90 feet to an iron pin set.

Thence N 89 degrees 59' 57" W along the north right-of-way line of Gary Dr. a distance of 164.19 feet to an iron pin set and the True Place of Beginning.

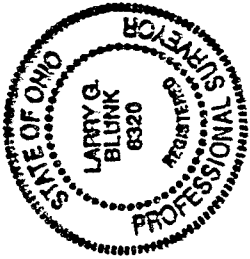
Thence continuing N 89 degrees 59' 57" W along the north right-of-way line of Gary Dr. a distance of 308.35 feet to an iron pin found.

Thence N 00 degrees 15' 44" W a distance of 334.25 feet to an iron pin found.

Thence N 89 degrees 50' 35" E a distance of 308.34 feet to an iron pin set.

Thence S 00 degrees 15' 44" E a distance of 335.10 feet to the True Place of Beginning and containing 2.3690 acres more or less but subject to all legal highways also all easements of record.
