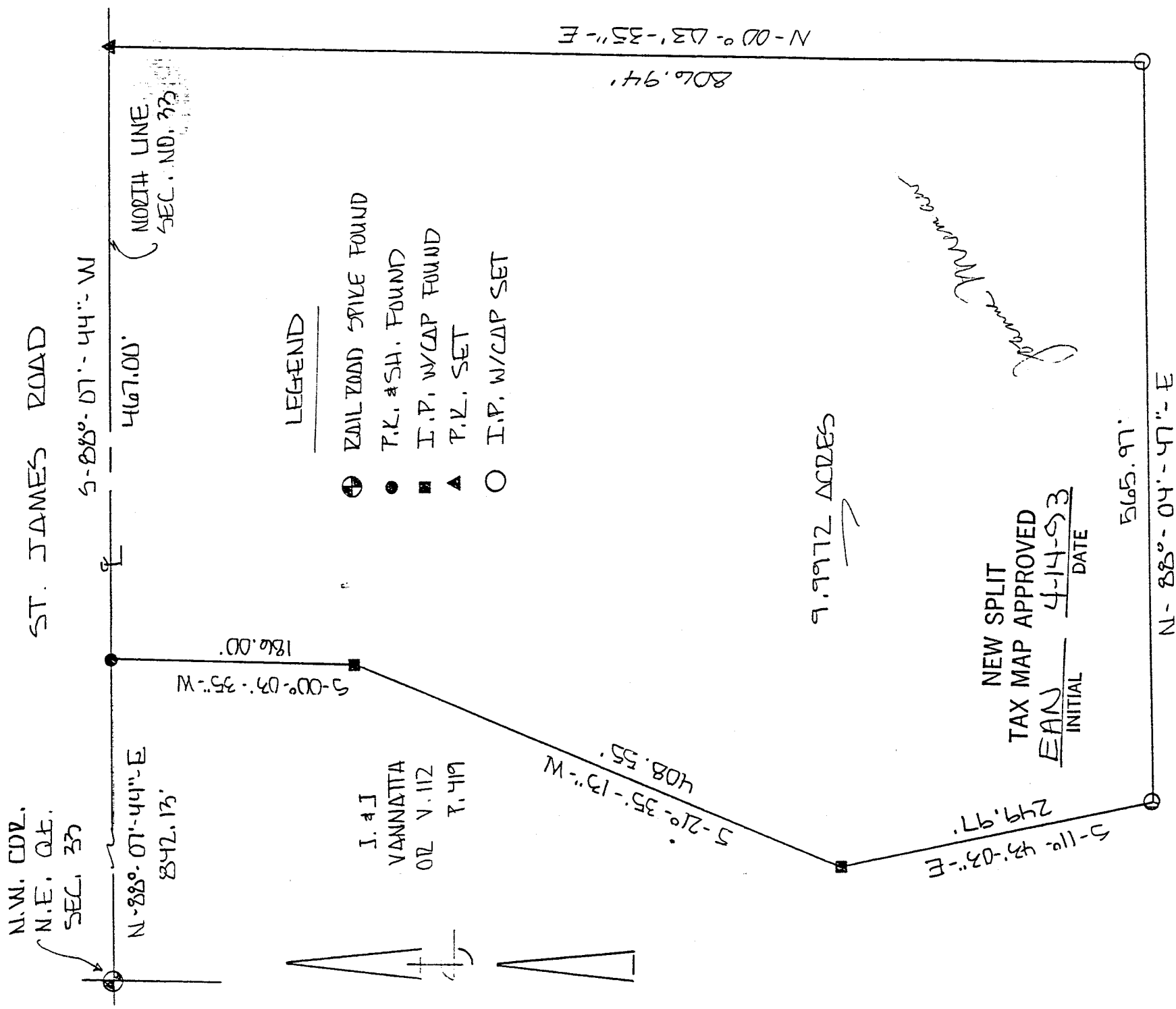
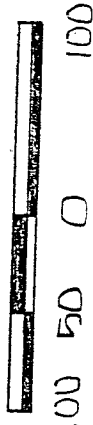

COMMENCING AT A RAILROAD SPIKE FOUND IN THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION NUMBER 33, THENCE NORTH - 88 DEG. - 07 MIN. - 44 SEC. - EAST AND ALONG THE NORTH LINE OF SAID NORTHEAST QUARTER AND ST. JAMES ROAD, A DISTANCE OF EIGHT HUNDRED FORTY TWO AND THIRTEEN HUNDREDTHS (842.13) FEET TO A P.K. NAIL WITH SHINER FOUND AND THE PLACE OF BEGINNING;

THENCE SOUTH - 00 DEG. - 03 MIN. - 35 SEC. - WEST AND ALONG THE EAST LINE OF LANDS DEEDED TO J. & J. VANNATTA IN DEED O.R. VOL. 112 - PG. 419, A DISTANCE OF ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY SIX (186.00) FEET TO AN IRON PIN WITH CAP FOUND;

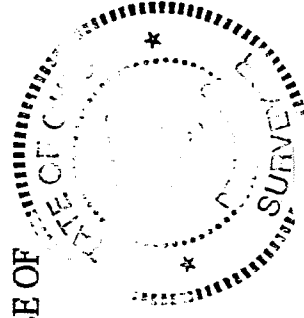
