SURVEYOR'S DESCRIPTION
FOR

JAMES D. JACKSON

1.086 Acres

Situated in the Township of Worthington, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being part of the Northeast Quarter of Section 7, Township 21, Range 17 and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin found in the northeast corner of said Northeast Quarter;

Thence S 0° 44' 20" E, 322.00 feet along the east line of said Northeast Quarter to an iron pin set in a northeast corner of a parcel of land conveyed to Edwin C. and Janet E. Griffith by volume 192, page 422 of Richland County official records, passing through the centerline of Riggle Road (T.H. 399) at 18.00 feet and passing through an iron pin set at 30.00 feet;

Thence N 89° 28' 58" W, 147.94 feet along a north line of said land of Edwin C. and Janet E. Griffith to an iron pin set;

Thence N 0° 44' 20" W, 317.61 feet and parallel to the east line of said Northeast Quarter to an iron pin set in the north line of said Northeast Quarter, passing through an iron pin set at 290.06 feet and passing through said centerline of Riggle Road at 308.11 feet;

Thence N 88° 49' 01" E, 147.91 feet along the north line of said Northeast Quarter to the place of beginning and containing 1.086 acres, more or less, but subject to all legal highways and easements of record.

Bearings are to an assumed meridian and are used to express angles only.

All iron pins set are 5/8" diameter rod with plastic cap stamped "S.J.L. INC."
