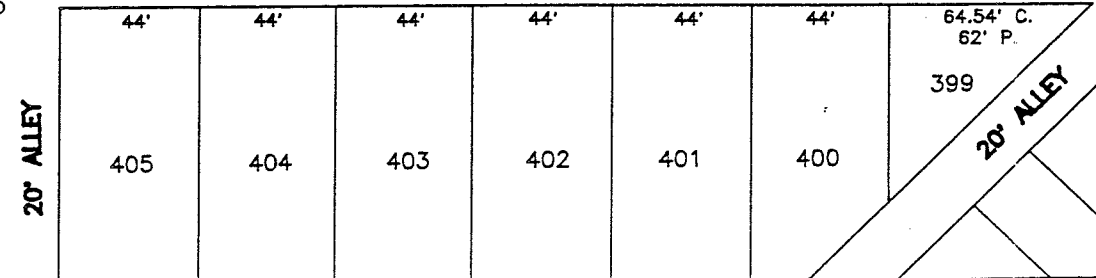
NEW SURVEY OF EXISTING PARCEL TAX MAP APPROVED

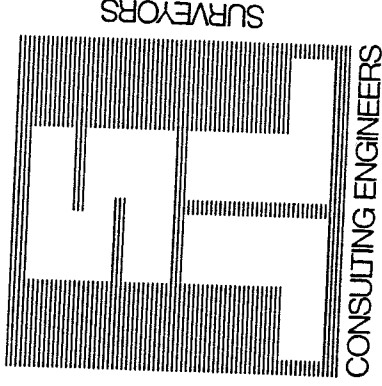

Situated in the Village of Butler, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being all of lot numbers 370 and 371 of the consecutively numbered lots in said village also being lot numbers 370 and 371 of A.M. Stewart's Third Addition to Butler as recorded in volume 9, page 10 of Richland County plat records and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin found in the northwesterly corner of said lot number 371, said iron pin also being in the intersection of the easterly line of Fifth Avenue (50') and the southerly line of Henry Street (60');

Thence N 71° 04' 19" E, 121.84 feet along the northerly line of said lot number 371 also being the said southerly line of Henry Street to an iron pin set in the northeasterly corner of said lot number 371, said iron pin also being in the westerly line of an alley 20 feet in width;

Thence S 19° 46' 49" E, 97.60 feet along the easterly line of said lot numbers 371 and 370 also being along the westerly line of said 20 foot alley to and iron pin set in the southeasterly corner of said lot number 370;

Thence S 71° 04' 19" W, 121.84 feet along the southerly line of said lot number 370 to an iron pin set in the southwesterly corner of said lot, said iron pin also being in said easterly line of Fifth Avenue;

Thence N 19° 46' 49" W, 97.60 feet along the westerly line of lot numbers 370 and 371 also being said easterly line of Fifth Avenue to the place of beginning and containing 11,890 square feet, more or less, but subject to all legal highways and easements of record.

Thence N 71° 04' 19" E, 121.84 feet along the northerly line of said lot number 369 to and iron pin set in the northeasterly corner of said lot, said iron pin also being in the westerly line of an alley 20 feet in width;
