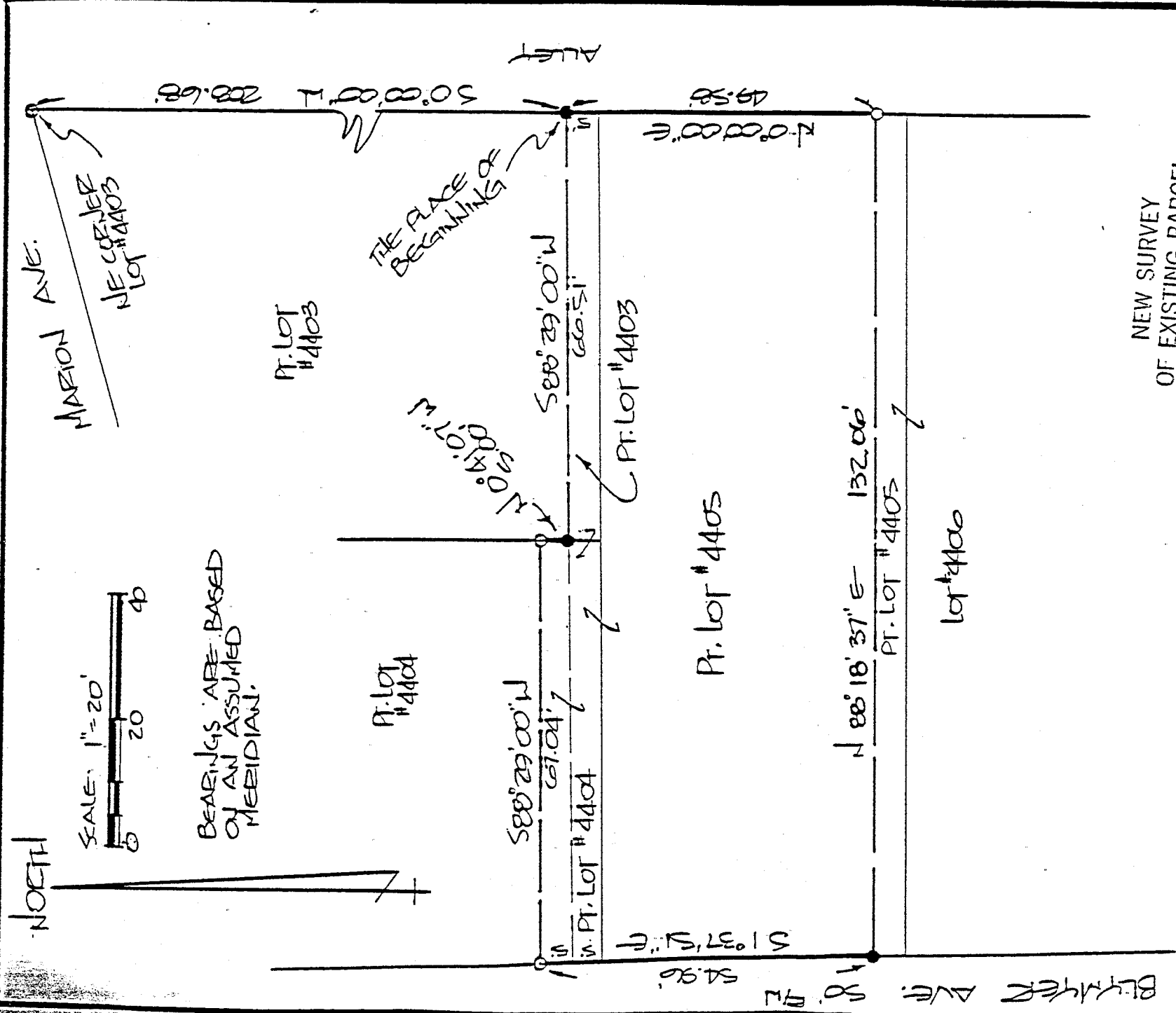

S U R V E Y D E S C R I P T I O N

Situated in the City of Mansfield, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being a part of Lot #4403, a part of Lot #4404, and a part of Lot #4405 of the consecutively numbered lots in said City (Plat reference: Volume 1, page 6), more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at an iron pin found marking the northeast corner of said Lot #4403; Thence, South 0 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds West with the east line of said lot, a distance of 208.68 feet to an iron pin set, the place of beginning;

Thence, South 88 degrees 29 minutes 00 seconds West a distance of 66.51 feet to an iron pin set;

Thence, North 0 degrees 41 minutes 07 seconds West a distance of 5.00 feet to an iron pin found;

Thence, South 88 degrees 29 minutes 00 seconds West a distance of 67.04 feet to an iron pin found on the west line of said Lot #4404;

Thence, South 1 degree 37 minutes 51 seconds East with said west line, and the southerly prolongation thereof, a distance of 54.96 feet to an iron pin set;

Thence, North 88 degrees 18 minutes 37 seconds East a distance of 132.06 feet to an iron pin found on the east line of said Lot #4405;

Thence, North 0 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds East with said east line, and the northerly prolongation thereof, a distance of 49.58 feet to the place of beginning, according to survey by Douglas C. Seiler, Professional Surveyor #6869 on May 17, 1993.

Bearings are based on an assumed meridian and are intended to be used for angular determination only.

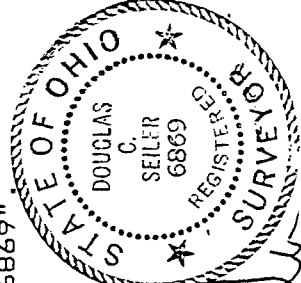
Iron pins set are 5/8" rods with caps stamped "SEILER 6869"
