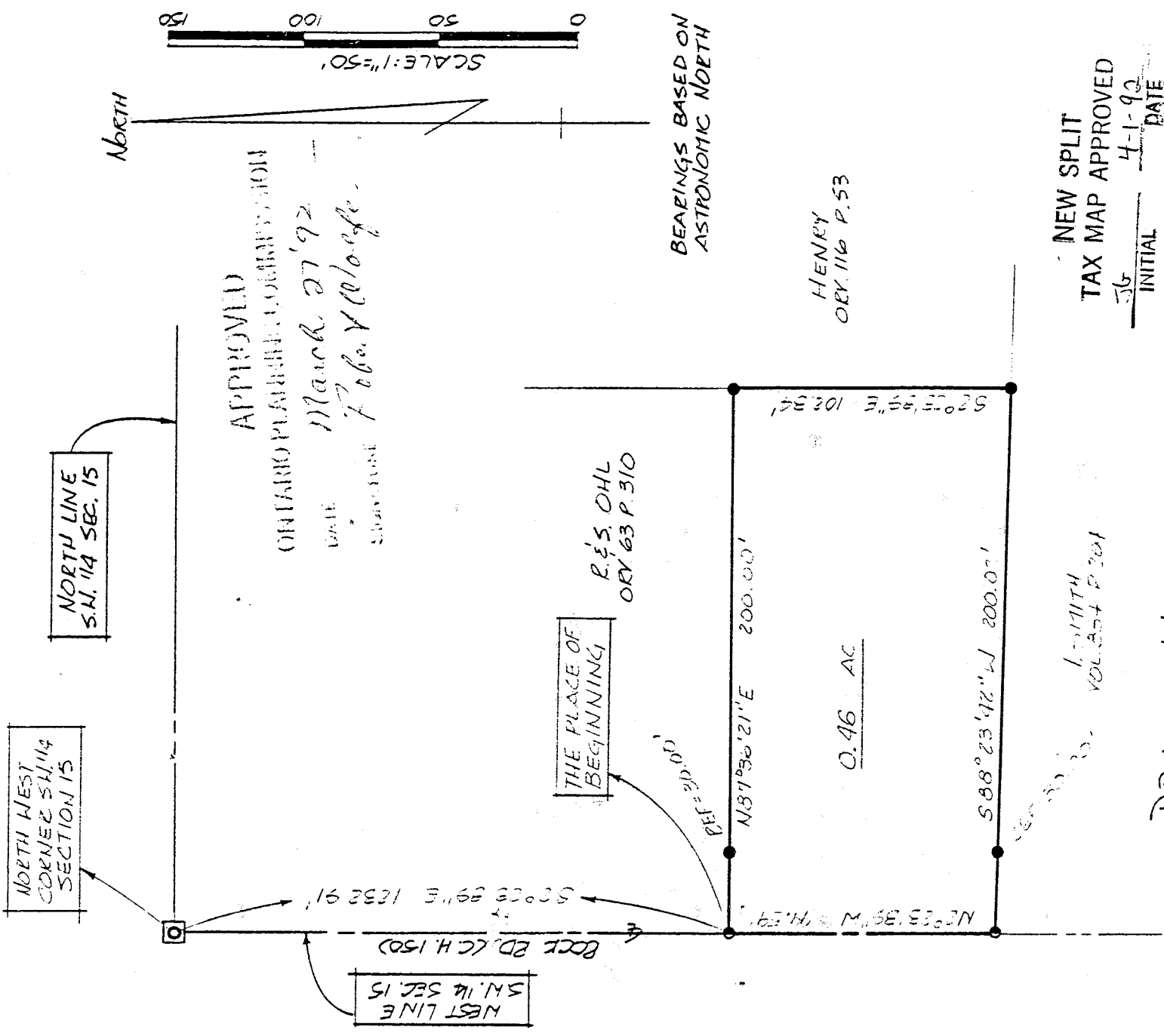

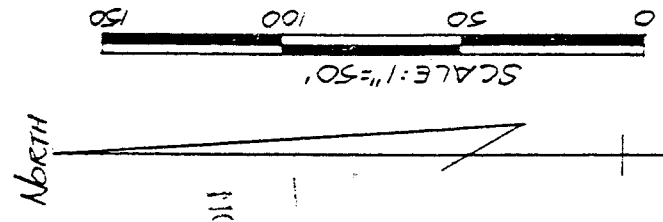

SURVEY DESCRIPTION

Situated in the Village of Ontario, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being a part of the Southwest Quarter of Section 15, Township 21 North, Range 19 West, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a rail road spike found and accepted as marking the northwest corner of said quarter; Thence, South 2 degrees 23 minutes 39 seconds East with the west line of said quarter, the same being the centerline of Rock Road (County Highway 150), a distance of 1232.91 feet to a PK spike set, the place of beginning;

Thence, North 87 degrees 36 minutes 21 seconds East, passing through an iron pin set for reference at 30.00 feet, a total distance of 200.00 feet to an iron pin set;

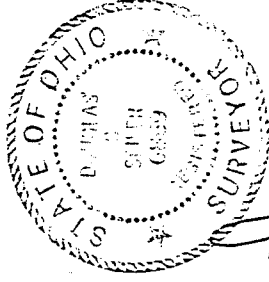
Thence, South 2 degrees 23 minutes 39 seconds East a distance of 102.34 feet to an iron pin set;

Thence, South 88 degrees 23 minutes 42 seconds West, passing through an iron pin set for reference at 170.02 feet, a total distance of 200.02 feet to a PK spike set on said west line and said centerline;

Thence, North 2 degrees 23 minutes 39 seconds West with said west line and said centerline, a distance of 99.57 feet to the place of beginning, containing 0.46 of an acre, according to survey by Douglas C. Seiler, Professional Surveyor #6869 on June 4, 1991, but subject to the right of way of Rock Road.

Iron pins set are 5/8" rods with caps stamped "SEILER 6869".

Bearings are based on Astronomic North.
