

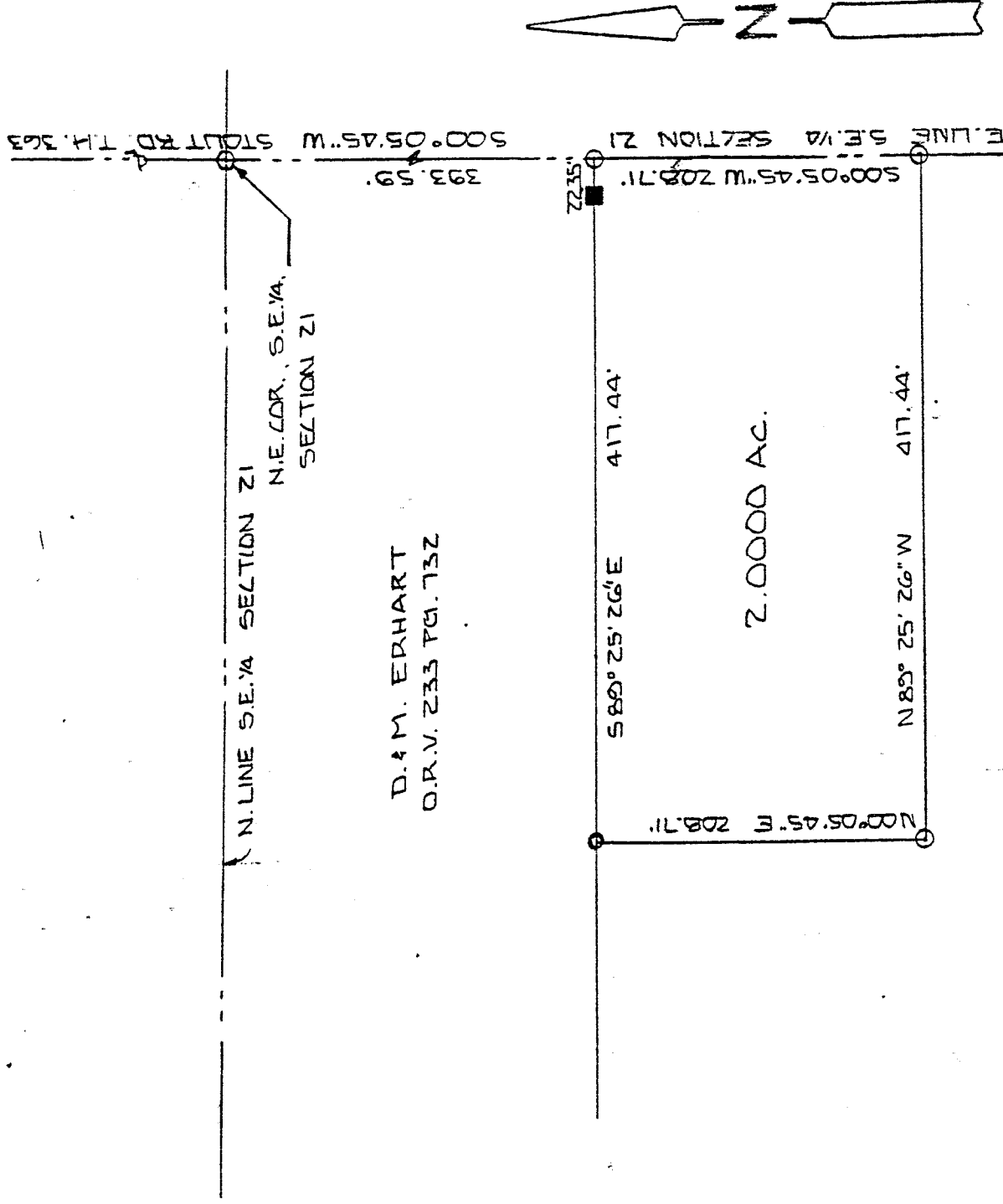
# PLAT OF SURVEY FOR D. & C. KEISER

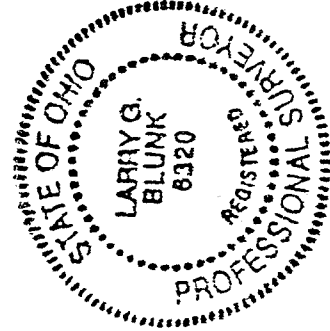

DESCRIPTION  
FOR

D. & C. KEISER

Located in the Township of Monroe, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being a part of the Southeast Quarter of Section 21, Township 22, Range 17 and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a railroad spike set in the Northeast Corner of the Southeast Quarter of Section 21.

Thence S 00 degrees 05' 45" W along the east line of the Southeast Quarter of Section 21, said line also being the centerline of Stout Rd. T.H. 363, a distance of 393.59 feet to an iron pin set and the True Place of Beginning.

Thence continuing S 00 degrees 05' 45" W along the east line of the Northeast Quarter of Section 21, said line also being the centerline of Stout Rd. T.H. 363, a distance of 208.71 feet to an iron pin set.

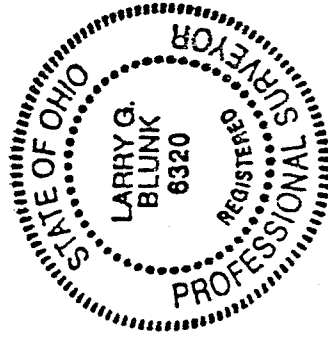
Thence N 89 degrees 25' 26" W a distance of 417.44 feet to an iron pin set.

Thence N 00 degrees 05' 45" E a distance of 208.71 feet to an iron pin set.

Thence S 89 degrees 25' 26" E passing thru a fence post found at 395.09 feet a total distance of 417.44 feet to the True Place of Beginning and containing 2.0000 Acres more or less but subject to all legal highways also all easements of record.
