Situated in the Township of Jefferson, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being part of the Southwest Quarter of Section 19, Township 19, Range 18 and being more particularly described follows:

Commencing at an railroad spike found in the northeast corner of said Southwest Quarter, said railroad spike also being in the centerline of Darlington East Road (T.H. 27) (60');

Thence S 89° 38' 38" W, 2,168.87 feet along the north line of said Southwest Quarter also being said centerline of Darlington East Road to an iron pin set in the northeast corner of a parcel of land conveyed to Allen Earl and Hope Lothery by volume 299, page 773 of Richland County official records;

Thence S 74° 33' 20" W, 472.94 feet along the southerly line of said land of Allen Earl and Hope Lothery also being said centerline of Darlington East Road to a railroad spike set, said railroad spike being the true place of beginning;

Thence S 0° 44' 22" E, 330.79 feet to an iron pin set in the north line of a parcel of land conveyed to Robert M. and Pamela A. Thomas by official records volume 27, page 201 and passing through an iron pin set at 27.32 feet;

Thence S 88° 57' 18" W, 139.22 feet to a railroad spike set in the west line of said Southwest Quarter also being the centerline of Clever Road (T.H. 129) (60') and passing through an iron pin found at 114.22 feet;

Thence N 0° 44' 22" W, 295.00 feet along said west line and said centerline of Clever Road to a railroad spike set in the southwest corner of aforementioned land of Allen Earl and Hope Lothery;

Thence N 74° 33' 20" E, 143.93 feet along the southerly line of said land of Allen Earl and Hope Lothery to the true place of beginning and containing 1.000 acres, more or less, but subject to all legal highways and easements of record.

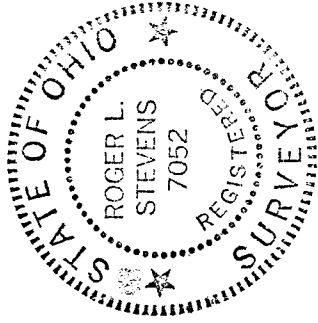
