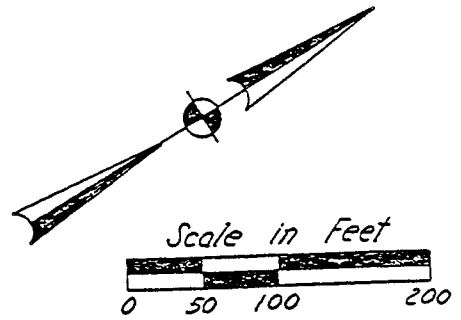


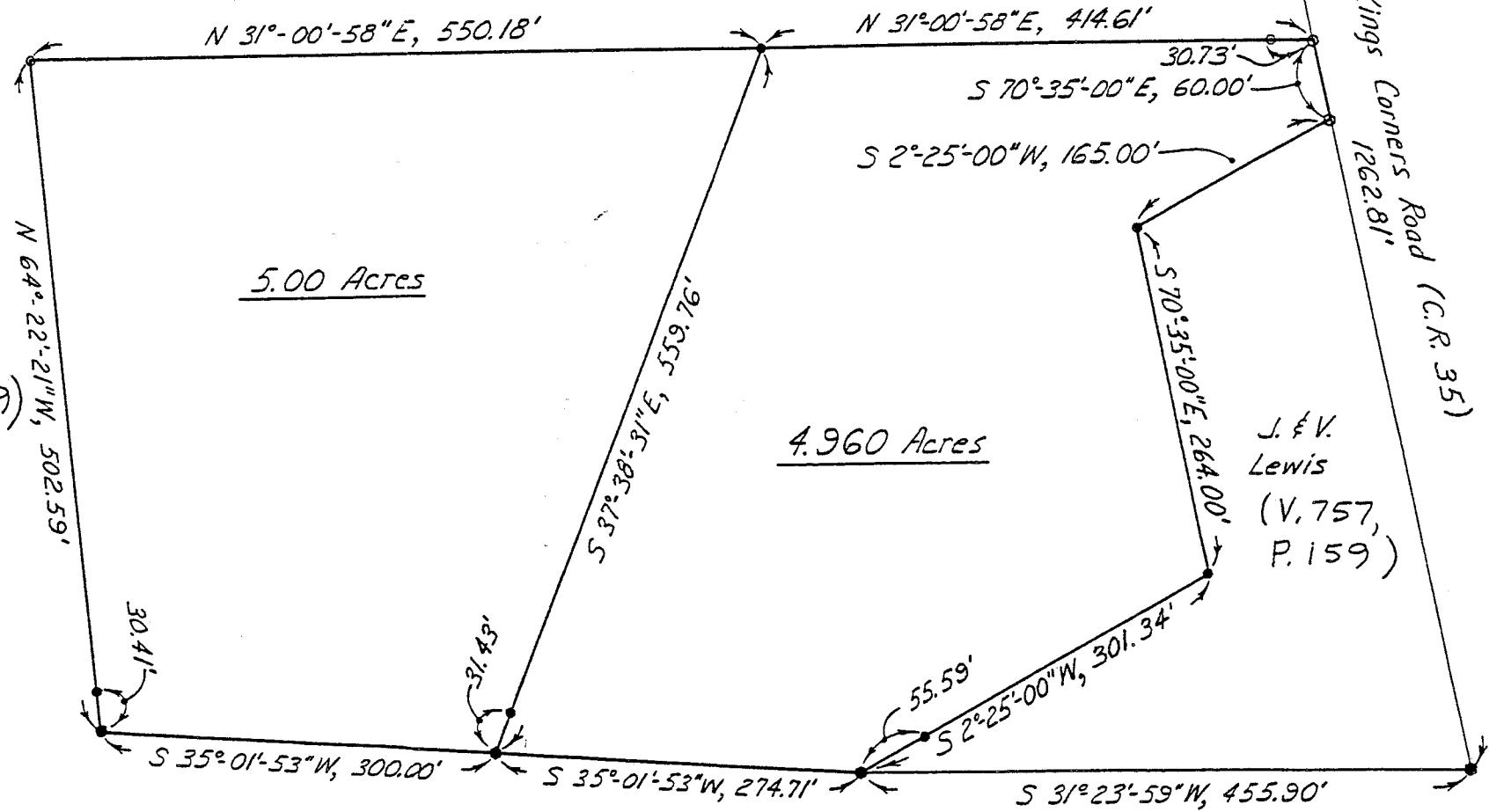

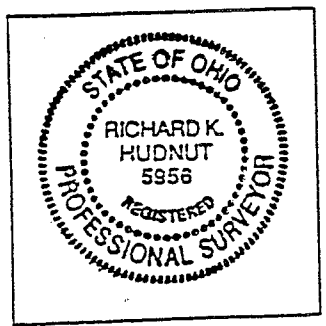
Sec. Line

Thence South 31°-23'-59" West in and along U.S. 42 (Delaware Road) a distance of 455.90 feet to a railroad spike set, said spike referenced by an iron pin set North 2°-25'-00" East a distance of 55.59 feet, said spike being the true place of beginning for the parcel of land herein to be conveyed:

Thence South 35°-01'-53" West in and along U.S. 42 (Delaware Road) a distance of 274.71 feet to a railroad spike set, said spike referenced by an iron pin set, North 37°-38'-31" West a distance of 31.43 feet;

Thence North 37°-38'-31" West a distance of 559.76 feet to an iron pin set;

Thence North 31°-00'-58" East along the east line of lands now or formerly owned by T.L. Dowel a distance of 414.61 feet to a railroad spike found;

Thence South 70°-35'-00" East along the center of Kings Corners Road a distance of 60.00 feet to a railroad spike found;

Thence South 2°-25'-00" West along the west line of lands now or formerly owned by J. & V. Lewis a distance of 165.00 feet to an iron pin set;

Thence South 70°-35'-00" East along the south line of the J. & V. Lewis land a distance of 264.00 feet to an iron pin set;

Thence South 2°-25'-00" West along the J. & V. Lewis land a distance of 301.34 feet to the true place of beginning.
