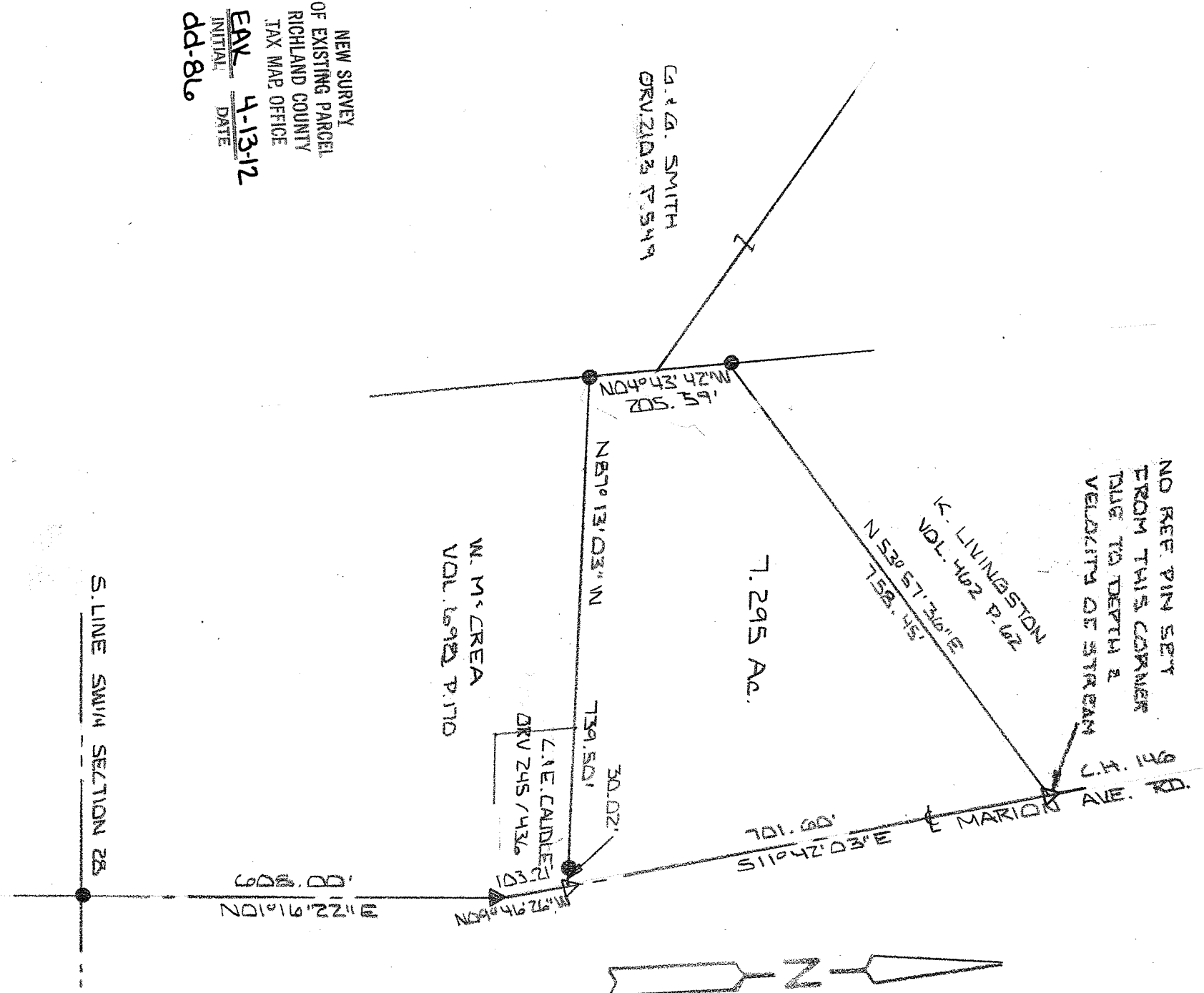


PLAT OF SURVEY FOR JOSEPH HOLOMUZKI

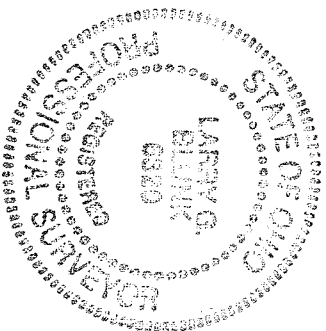

**DESCRIPTION
FOR
JOSEPH HOLOMUZKI**

Located in the Township of Springfield, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being a part of the Southwest Quarter of Section 28, Township 21, Range 19 and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin found on the south line of the Southwest Quarter of Section 28 with its intersection with the centerline of Marion Avenue Rd. C.H. 146.

Thence N 01 degrees 16' 22" E along the centerline of Marion Avenue Rd. C.H. 146 a distance of 608.00 feet to a pk nail found.

Thence N 09 degrees 46' 26" W along the centerline of Marion Avenue Rd. C.H. 146 a distance of 103.21 feet to a 2" mag nail set and the True Place of Beginning.


Thence N 87 degrees 13' 03" W passing thru an iron pin found at 30.02 feet a total distance of 739.50 feet to an iron pin found.

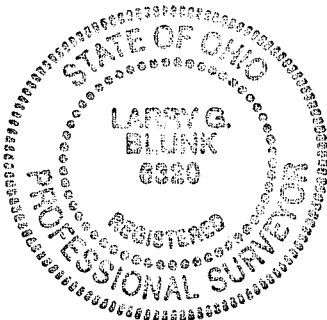
Thence N 04 degrees 43' 42" W a distance of 205.59 feet to an iron pin found.

Thence N 53 degrees 57' 36" E a distance of 758.45 feet to a 2" mag nail set in the centerline of Marion Avenue Rd. C.H. 146.

Thence S 11 degrees 42' 03" E along the centerline of Marion Avenue Rd. C.H. 146 a distance of 701.60 feet to the True Place of Beginning and containing 7.295 acres more or less but subject to all legal highways also all easements of record.

Basis of Bearings: Bearings are to an assumed azimuth and are used to denote angles only.
