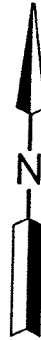
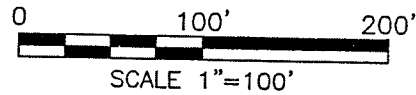

**SURVEYOR'S DESCRIPTION FOR  
TRACEY R. WILSON**

**2.831 Acres**

Situated in the Township of Worthington, County of Richland, State of Ohio, being part of the Southeast Quarter of Section 8, Township 21, Range 17 and being more particularly described as follows:

**Commencing** at railroad spike found in the intersection of the west line of said Southeast Quarter and the centerline of Hagerman Road (T.H. 387);

Thence southeasterly along said centerline of Hagerman Road (T.H. 387) on a curve to the left having a radius of 363.78 feet, an arc length of 92.75 feet, a delta angle of  $14^{\circ} 36' 28''$ , a chord length of 92.50 feet and a chord bearing of  $S 66^{\circ} 45' 04'' E$  to a railroad spike found;

Thence  $S 74^{\circ} 03' 19'' E$ , 407.23 feet and continuing along said centerline of Hagerman Road (T.H. 387) to a railroad spike found;

Thence  $S 65^{\circ} 07' 11'' E$ , 494.95 feet and continuing along said centerline of Hagerman Road (T.H. 387) to a point being the southeasterly corner of a parcel of land conveyed to John E. and Kimberly K. Hildreth by official records volume 33, page 651, said point being the **true place of beginning**;

Thence with the following **FOUR** courses:

- 1) **N 03° 15' 48" E, 466.32 feet** along the east line of said land of John E. and Kimberly K. Hildreth to an iron pin found in the northeast corner of said land, said iron pin also being in a south line of a parcel of land conveyed to Michael E. and Linnea K. Blake by official records volume 27, page 117 and passing through an iron pin found at 26.72 feet;
- 2) **N 89° 35' 10" E, 270.76 feet** along said south line of said land of Michael E. and Linnea K. Blake to an iron pin found in an interior corner of said land;
- 3) **S 09° 55' 44" W, 568.45 feet** along a westerly line of said land of Michael E. and Linnea K. Blake to a point being a southwesterly corner of said land, said point also being in said centerline of Hagerman Road (T.H. 387) and passing through an iron pin set at 554.19 feet;
- 4) **N 65° 07' 11" W, 219.67 feet** along said centerline of Hagerman Road (T.H. 387) to the **true place of beginning** and containing **2.831 acres**, more or less, and subject to all legal highways and easements of record.

Bearings are to an assumed meridian and are used to express angles only.

All iron pins set are 5/8" diameter reinforcing rod with plastic cap stamped "STEVENS 7052".
