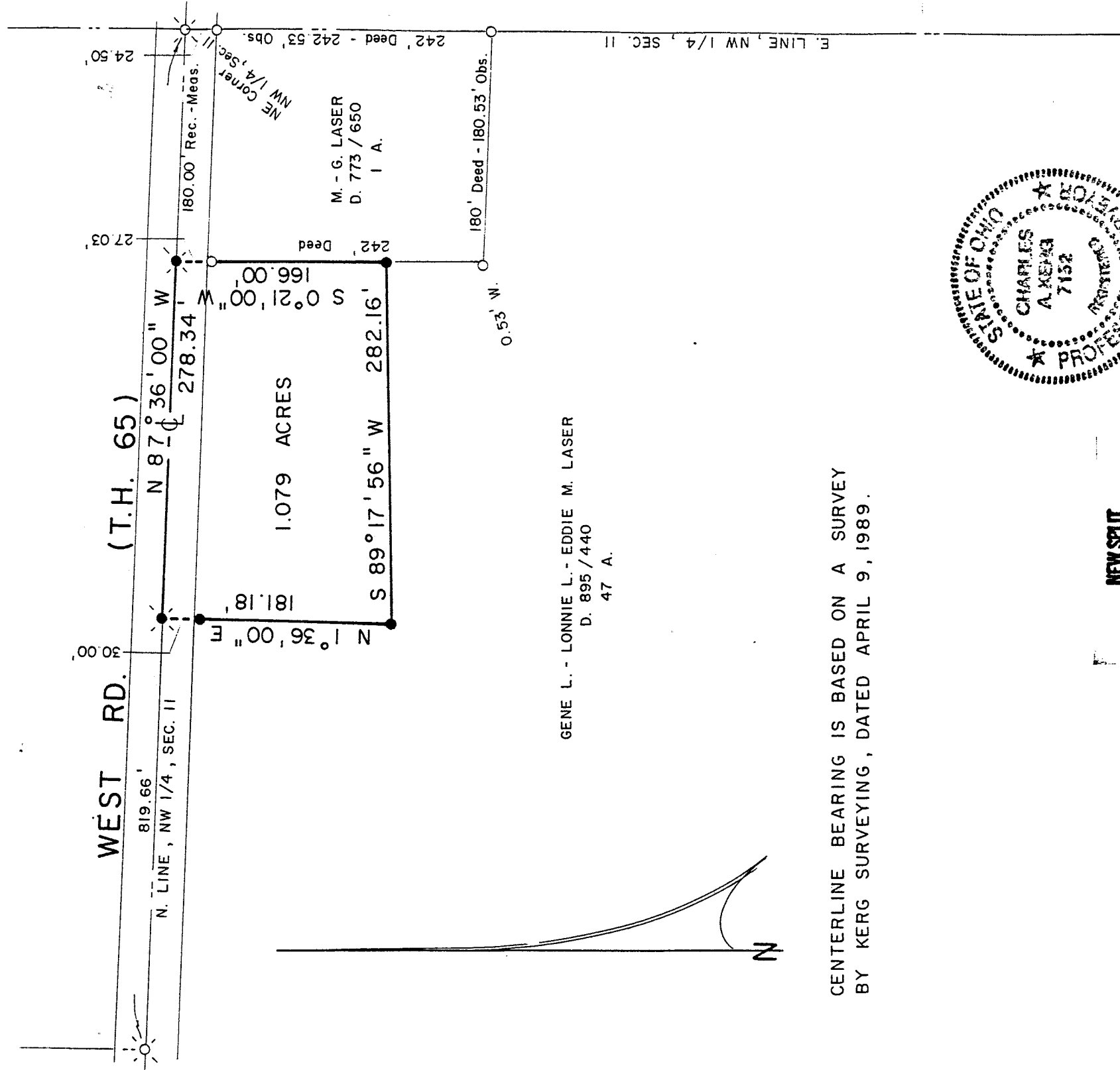


PLAT OF BOUNDARY SURVEY

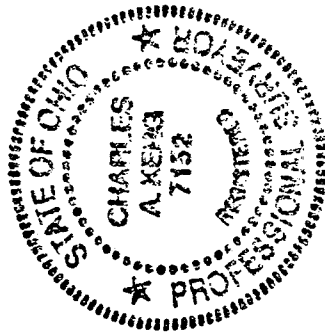

PLYMOUTH TOWNSHIP, RICHLAND COUNTY, OHIO

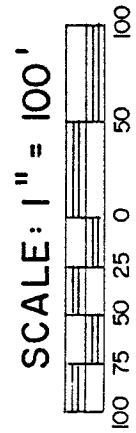

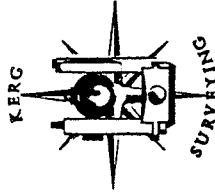

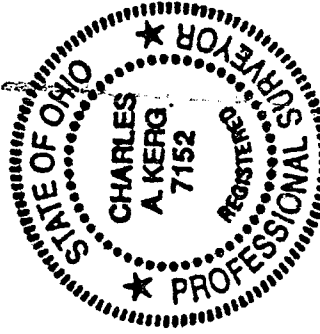
PART OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER, SECTION ELEVEN (11),
 TOWNSHIP TWENTY-TWO (22), RANGE TWENTY (20)
 PLYMOUTH TOWNSHIP, RICHLAND COUNTY, OHIO

DESCRIPTION: Being part of the Northwest Quarter of Section Eleven (11),
 Township Twenty-two (22), Range Twenty (20), Plymouth Township,
 Richland County, Ohio, and being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing for the same at a railroad spike found on the centerline of
 West Road (Township Highway 65) at the northeast corner of the Northwest
 Quarter of Section Eleven (11), said spike being the northeast corner of 1 acre
 in the name of Myron E. and Glada P. Laser per Deed Volume 773, Page 650;
 thence N 87°36'00" W a distance of 180.00 feet along said centerline and the
 north line of said quarter-section to a railroad spike set at the northwest
 corner of said 1 acre, said point being also the northeast corner of 47 acres in
 the name of Gene L., Lonnie L. and Eddie M. Laser per Deed Volume 895,
 Page 440, the real point of beginning of the parcel herein described;

- 1) thence S 0°21'00" W a distance of 166.00 feet along the west line of
 said 1 acre to an iron pin set, and passing for reference at 27.03 feet
 an iron pipe found;
- 2) thence S 89°17'56" W a distance of 282.16 feet to an iron pin set;
- 3) thence N 1°36'00" E a distance of 181.18 feet to a railroad spike set
 in West Road on the north line of said quarter-section, and passing
 for reference on line an iron pin set southerly at 30.00 feet;
- 4) thence S 87°36'00" E a distance of 278.34 feet along said section
 line to the real point of beginning of the parcel herein described
 and containing 1.079 acres, more or less, but subject to all legal
 easements and public rights-of-way now on record. All iron pins set are 5/8"
 in diameter with caps stamped "C.KERG, RLS 7152". The centerline bearing
 is based on a survey by Kerg Surveying, dated April 9, 1989.
