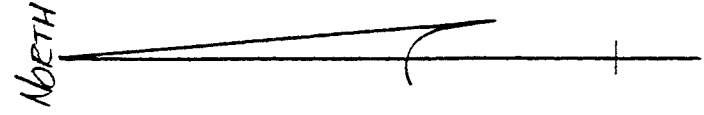

SURVEY DESCRIPTION

Part West ½, NW ¼ Section 22
Springfield Township
Village of Ontario, Ohio

Situated in the Village of Ontario, County of Richland, State of Ohio, and being a part of the West Half of the Northwest Quarter of Section 22, Township 21 North, Range 19 West, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a railroad spike found and accepted as marking the southeast corner of said Half Quarter Section, the same being the southeast corner of an existing 1.226 acre parcel currently owned by the Village of Ontario (Deed reference: O.R.V. 78, page 572); Thence, South 89 degrees 27 minutes 20 seconds West with the south line of said parcel, a distance of 40.00 feet to an iron pin found and accepted as marking the southwest corner thereof; Thence, North 00 degrees 54 minutes 03 seconds West with the west line of said parcel, a distance of 637.83 feet to an iron pin set, the place of beginning;

Thence, continuing with said west line, North 00 degrees 54 minutes 03 seconds West, a distance of 150.00 feet to an iron pin set;

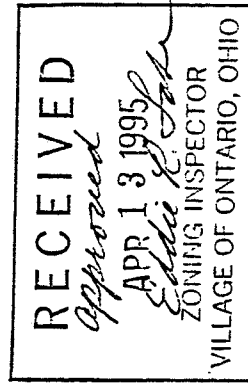
Thence, South 89 degrees 05 minutes 57 seconds West, a distance of 300.00 feet to an iron pin set;

Thence, South 00 degrees 54 minutes 03 seconds East, a distance of 150.00 feet to an iron pin set;

Thence, North 89 degrees 05 minutes 57 seconds East, a distance of 300.00 feet to the place of beginning, containing 1.033 acres according to survey by Douglas C. Seiler on March 24, 1995.

Iron pins set are 5/8" rods with caps stamped "SEILER 6869".

Bearings are based on ORV 78, page 572, and are intended to be used for angular determination only.
