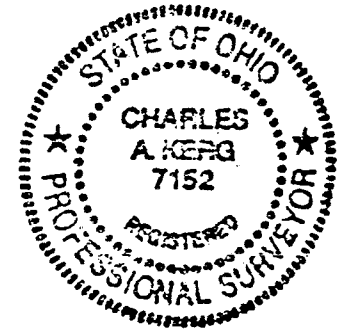

DESCRIPTION: Being a part of the Southwest Quarter of Section Thirty-four (34), Township Twenty-three (23), Range Nineteen (19), Cass Township, Richland County, Ohio, and being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing for the same at a 6" wood post found at the southwest corner of the Southwest Quarter of Section Thirty-four (34), said post being also the southwest corner of 58.729 acres in the name of Helen M. Myers per Official Record Volume 63, Page 588; thence S 87°47'25" E a distance of 615.10 feet along the south line of said quarter-section (south line of said 58.729 acres) to a point on the centerline of Plymouth-Springmill Road (County Highway 191), said point being referenced by an iron pin monument box found S 11°22'24" E at a distance of 1.90 feet, said point being the real point of beginning of the parcel herein described;

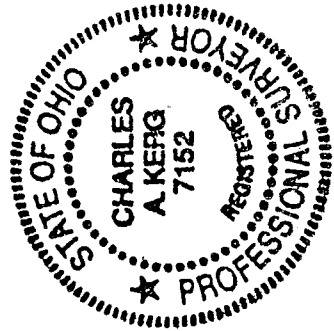

- 2) thence S 87° 23' 14" E a distance of 483.70 feet to a survey spike set on the centerline of Plymouth-Springmill Road (County Highway 191) at the southeast corner of said 2.62 acres, and passing for reference an iron pipe found westerly at a distance of 30.95 feet;

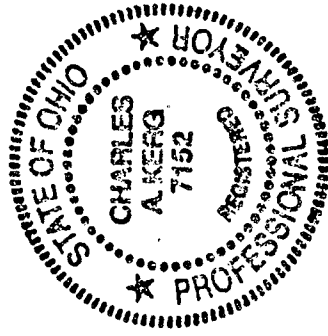
