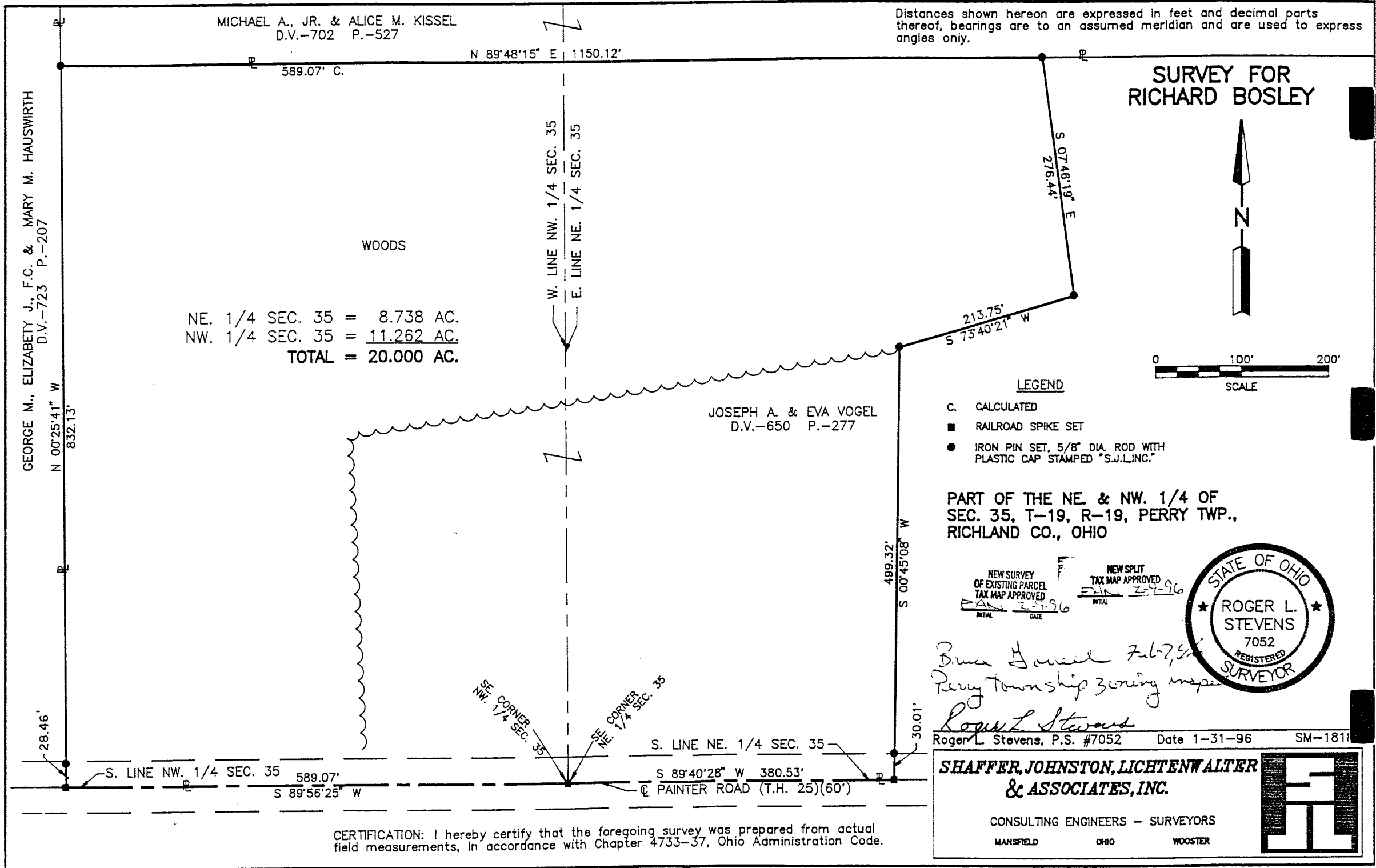


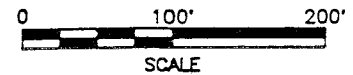

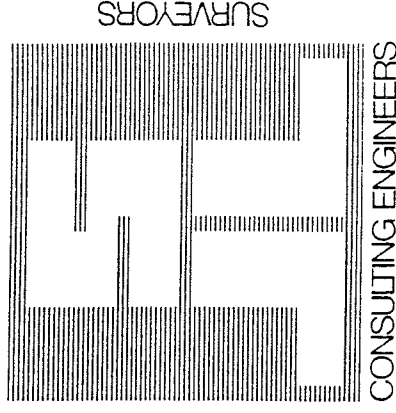

20.000 Acres

Situated in the Township of Perry, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being part of the Northeast and Northwest Quarters of Section 35, Township 19, Range 19 and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a railroad spike set in the southeast corner of said Northwest Quarter, said iron pin also being in the centerline of Painter Road (T.H. 25) (60 feet);

Thence S 89° 56' 25" W, 589.07 feet along the south line of said Northwest Quarter also being said centerline of Painter Road to a railroad spike set in the southeast corner of a parcel of land conveyed to George M., Elizabeth J., F.C. and Mary M. Hauswirth by volume 723, page 207 of Richland County deed records;

Thence N 00° 25' 41" W, 832.13 feet along the east line of said land of George M., Elizabeth J., F.C. and Mary M. Hauswirth to an iron pin set in the southwest corner of a parcel of land conveyed to Michael A., Jr. and Alice M. Kissel by deed volume 702, page 527 and passing through an iron pin set at 28.46 feet;

Thence N 89° 48' 15" E, 1,150.12 feet along the south line of said land of Michael A., Jr. and Alice M. Kissel to an iron pin set;

Thence S 07° 46' 19" E, 276.44 feet to an iron pin set;

Thence S 73° 40' 21" W, 213.75 feet to an iron pin set;

Thence S 00° 45' 08" W, 499.32 feet to a railroad spike set in the south line of said Northeast Quarter also being said centerline Painter Road and passing through an iron pin set at 469.31 feet;

Thence S 89° 40' 28" W, 380.53 feet along said south line and said centerline to the place of beginning and containing 20.000 acres, more or less, of which 8.738 acres lies in the Northeast Quarter of Section 35 and 11.262 acres lies in the Northwest Quarter of section, 35 but subject to all legal highways and easements of record.

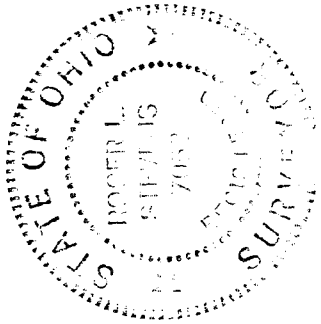
