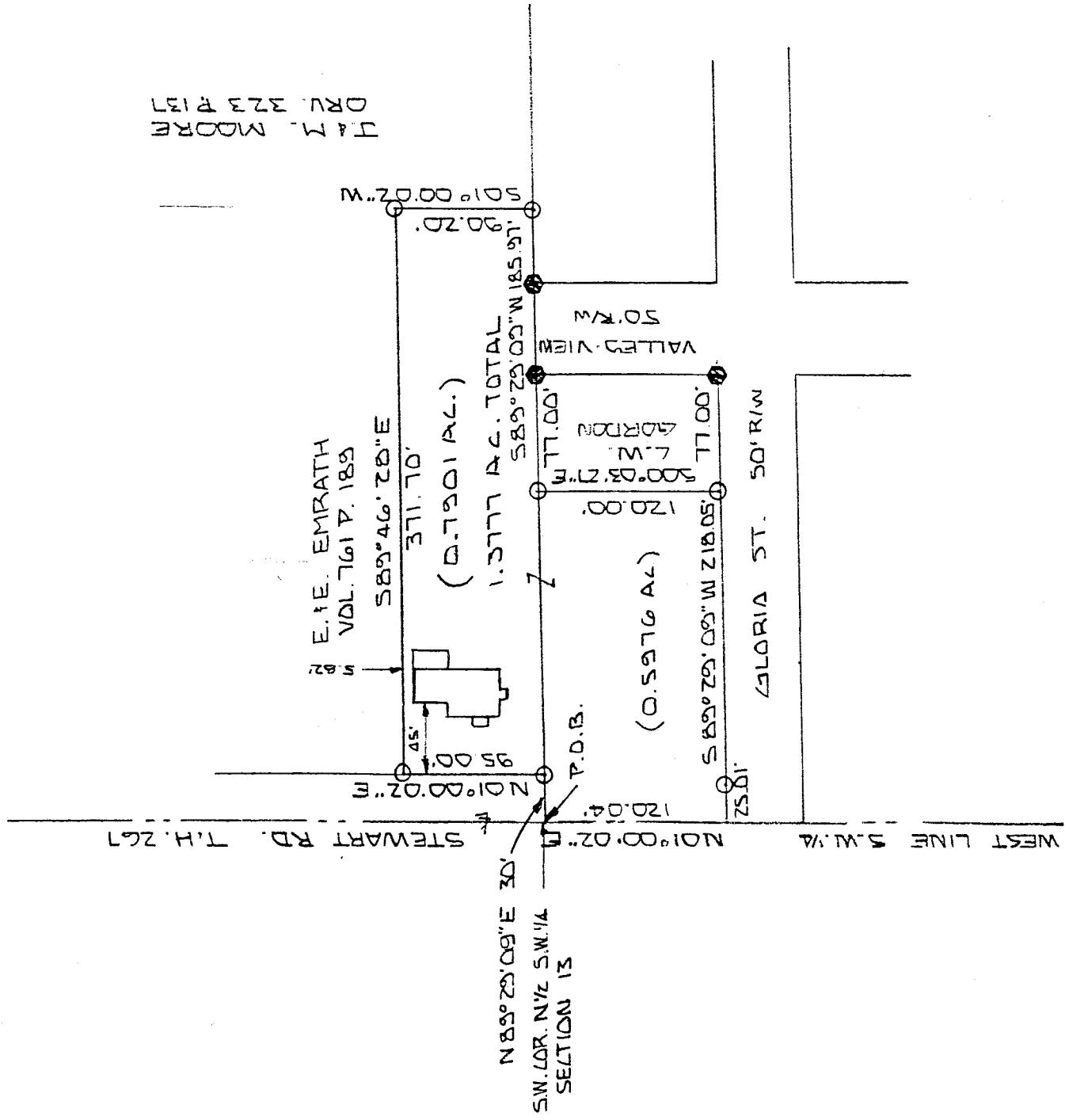

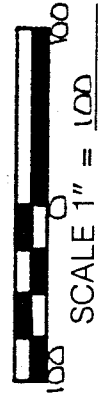
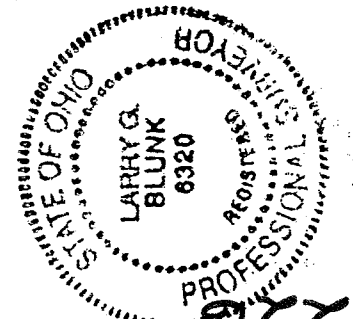

DESCRIPTION
FOR
JAMES HOWARD

Located in the Township of Madison, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being a part of the Southwest Quarter of Section 13, Township 21, Range 18 and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the Southwest Corner of the North Half of Section 13, referenced by an iron pin set N 89 degrees 29' 09" E, 30.00 feet.

Thence N 89 degrees 29' 09" E a distance of 30.00 feet to an iron pin set.

Thence N 01 degrees 00' 02" E a distance of 95.00 feet to an iron pin set.

Thence S 89 degrees 46' 28" E a distance of 371.70 feet to an iron pin set.

Thence S 01 degrees 00' 02" W a distance of 90.20 feet to an iron pin set.

Thence S 89 degrees 29' 09" W a distance of 185.97 feet to an iron pin set.

Thence S 00 degrees 03' 27" E a distance of 120.00 feet to an iron pin set.

Thence S 89 degrees 29' 09" W passing thru an iron pin set at 193.04 feet a total distance of 218.05 feet to a point on the west line of the Southwest Quarter of Section 13.

Thence N 01 degrees 00' 02" E along the west line of the Southwest Quarter of Section 13, said line also being the centerline of Stewart Rd. T.H. 267 a distance of 120.04 feet to the place of beginning and containing 1.3777 acres more or less but subject to all legal highways also all easements of record.
