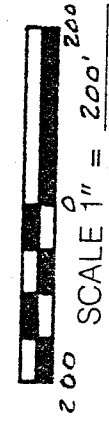
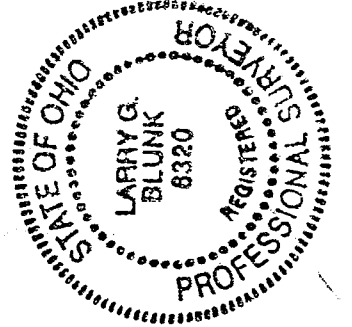
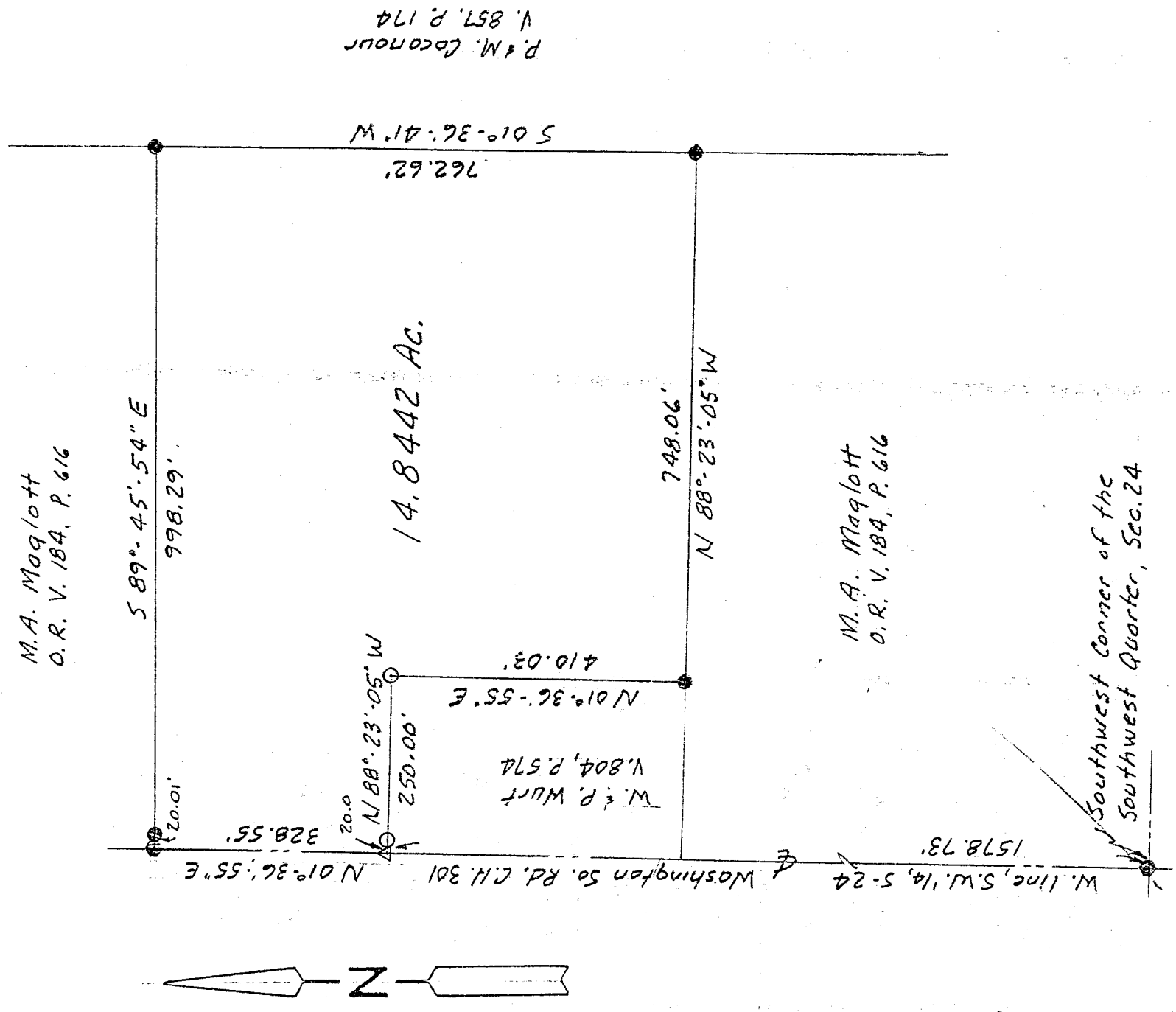
PLAT OF SURVEY FOR W. & P. Wurt

Located in the Township of Washington, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being a part of the Southwest Quarter of Section 24, Township 20, Range 18 and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a railroad spike found in the Southwest Corner of the Southwest Quarter of Section 24.

Thence N 01 degrees 36' 55" E along the west line of the Southwest Quarter of Section 24, said line also being the centerline of Washington South Rd. C.H. 301, a distance of 1578.73 feet to a pk nail set and the True Place of Beginning.

Thence continuing N 01 degrees 36' 55" E along the west line of the Southwest Quarter of Section 24, said line also being the centerline of Washington South Rd. C.H. 301, a distance of 328.55 feet to a railroad spike found.

Thence S 89 degrees 45' 54" E passing thru an iron pin found at 20.01 feet a total distance of 998.29 feet to an iron pin found.

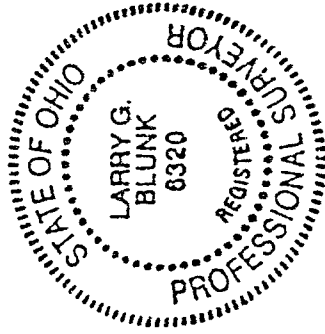
Thence S 01 degrees 36' 41" W a distance of 762.62 feet to an iron pin found.
