Situated in the Township of Jefferson, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being part of the Southeast Quarter of Section 6, Township 19, Range 18 and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin set in the southeast corner of said Southeast Quarter;

Thence N 89° 49' 06" W, 512.50 feet along the south line of said Southeast Quarter, of which the west 60.00 feet is also along the centerline of Bellville-Johnsville Road (C.H. 31)(60 feet), to a railroad spike set;

Thence N 00° 10' 54" E, 108.88 feet to an iron pin set and passing through an iron pin set at 30.00 feet;

Thence S 89° 49' 06" E, 403.08 feet to an iron pin set;

Thence N 00° 05' 51" W, 901.26 feet to an iron pin set;

Thence N 88° 15' 32" W, 363.01 feet to an iron pin set in the southeast corner of a parcel of land conveyed to Dale S. and Darla K. Myers by deed volume 890, page 78;

Thence N 33° 32' 20" E, 561.76 feet along the easterly line of said land of Dale S. and Darla K. Myers to an iron pin set in the northeast corner of said land, said iron pin also being in the south line of a parcel of land conveyed to Linda J. Kopina by volume 439, page 822 of Richland County official records;

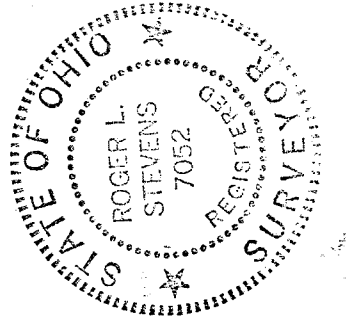


