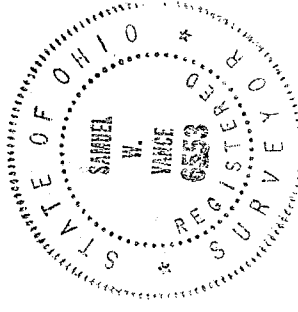
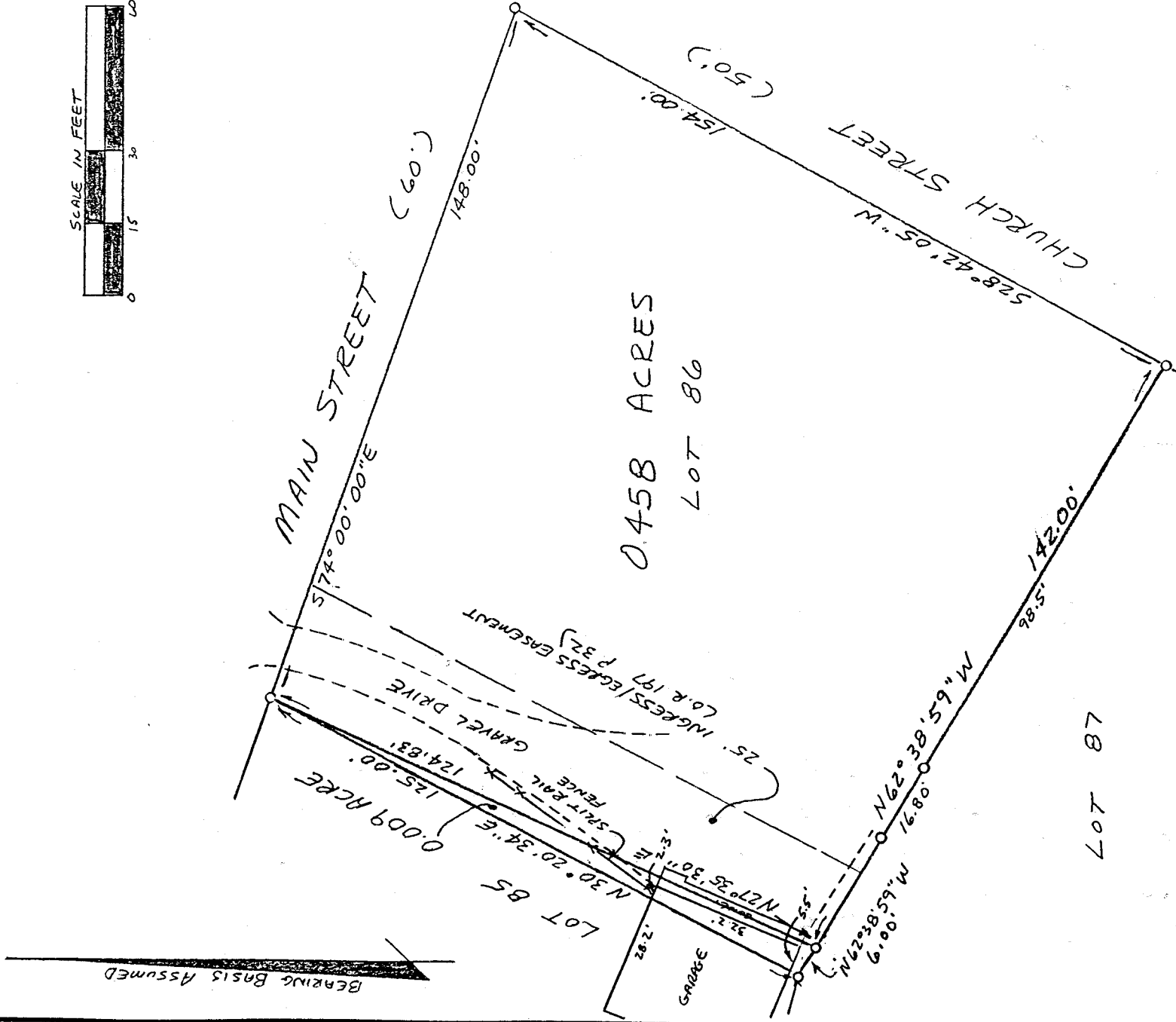

DESCRIPTION - 0.458 ACRE TRACT

Being part of Lot 86 of the Village of Shiloh, Richland County, State of Ohio and being that land of record in Deed Volume 46, Page 148 in the Richland County Recorder's Office and being more particularly described as follows;

Beginning at a 1/2 inch iron pin set at the northeast corner of Lot 86, being the intersection of the south line of Main Street (60 feet wide) with the west line of Church Street (50 feet wide);

thence from the place of beginning South 28 degrees 42 minutes 05 seconds West along the west line Church Street, the east line of Lot 86, a distance of 154.00 feet to a 1/2 inch iron pin set;

thence North 62 degrees 38 minutes 59 seconds West along the south line of Lot 86, the north line of Lot 87, a distance of 142.00 feet to (passing over 1/2 inch iron pins set at 98.50 feet and 115.30 feet) to a 1/2 inch iron pin set;

thence North 27 degrees 35 minutes 30 seconds East a distance of 124.83 feet to a 1/2 inch iron pin set on the south line of Main Street;

thence South 74 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds East along the north line of Lot 86, the south line of Main Street, a distance of 148.00 feet to the place of beginning - containing 0.458 acres, more or less.

Subject to all legal right-of-way of previous record.

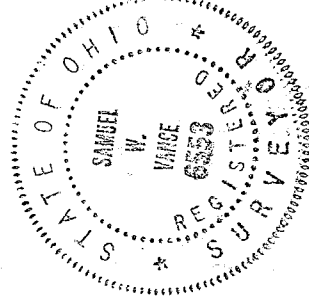

Beginning for reference at a 1/2 inch iron pin set at the northeast corner of Lot 86, being the intersection of the south line of Main Street (60 feet wide) with the west line of Church Street (50 feet wide); thence North 74 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds West along the south line of Main Street a distance of 148.00 feet to a 1/2 inch iron pin set and being the true place of beginning;

thence from the place of beginning South 27 degrees 35 minutes 30 seconds West across Lot 86 a distance of 124.83 feet to a 1/2 inch iron pin set;

thence North 62 degrees 38 minutes 59 seconds West along the south line of Lot 86, the north line of Lot 87, a distance of 6.00 feet to a 1/2 inch iron pin set;

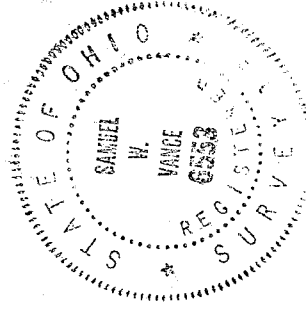
