Situated in the Township of Plymouth, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being part of the Southwest quarter of Section 30, T-23, R-19 and being more fully described as follows:

Commencing at an existing railroad spike at the intersection of the North line of the Southwest quarter of Section 30 with the centerline of Township Highway 185 (Shoup Road, also being the East line of the Southwest quarter of Section 30);

thence running South 01 deg. 30 min. 00 sec. West along the centerline of Township Highway 185 for 769.52 feet to an existing railroad spike and the place of beginning;

thence continuing South 01 deg. 30 min. 00 sec. West along said centerline for 200.00 feet to a railroad spike set;

thence turning and running North 87 deg. 48 min. 00 sec. West for 436.00 feet to a 5/8 inch rebar set;

thence turning and running North 01 deg. 30 min. 00 sec. East for 200.00 feet to a 5/8 inch rebar set;

thence turning and running South 87 deg. 48 min. 00 sec. East for 436.00 feet to the place of beginning.

All 5/8 inch rebars set have a plastic cap stamped "PS 7016".
