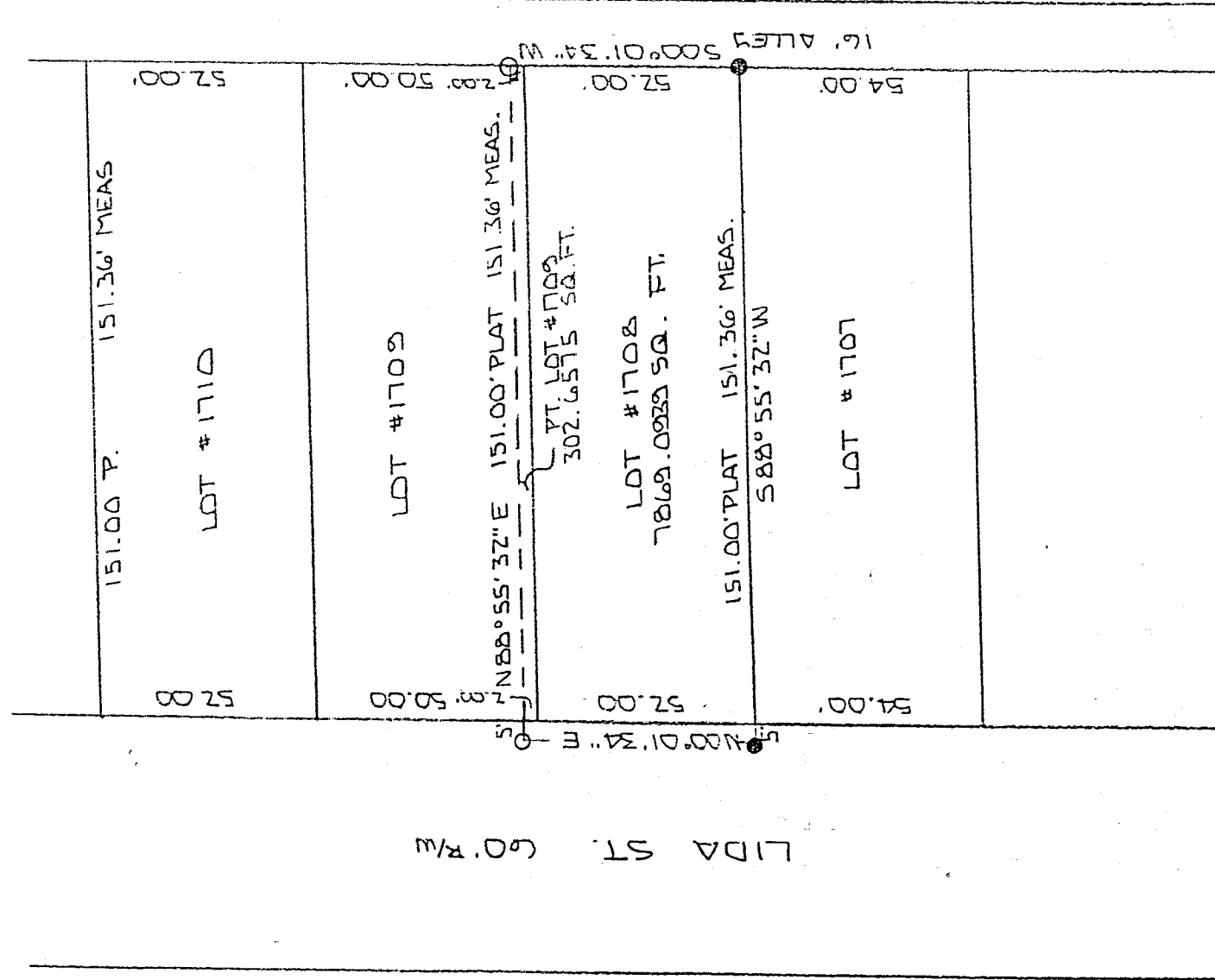

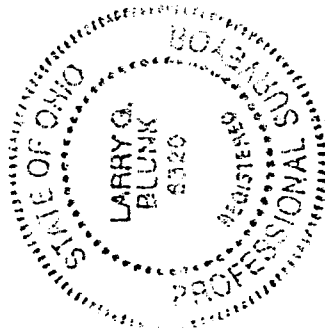
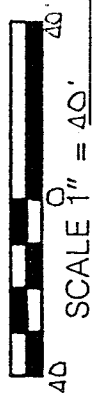

Located in the City of Mansfield, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being all of Lot Number 1708 and a part of Lot Number 1709 as recorded in Volume 2-3, Page 23 of the Richland County Plat Records and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the Southwest Corner of Lot Number 1708 referenced by an iron pin found that is 5.00 feet S 88 degrees 55' 32" W of the Southwest Corner of Lot Number 1708.


Thence N 00 degrees 01' 34" E along the west line of Lot Number 1708 and 1709 a distance of 54.00 feet to a point referneced by an iron pin that is set 5.00 feet S 88 degrees 55' 32" W of said point.

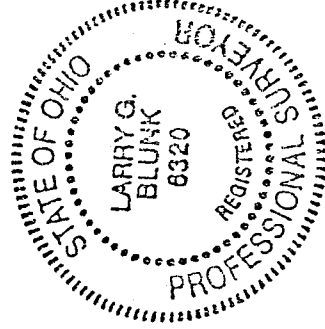
Thence N 88 degrees 55' 32" E a distance of 151.36 feet to an iron pin set on the east line of Lot Number 1709.

Thence S 00 degrees 01' 34" W along the east line of Lot Number 1709 and 1708 a distance of 54.00 feet to an iron pin found in the Southeast Corner of Lot Number 1708.

Thence S 88 degrees 55' 32" W along the south line of Lot Number 1708 a distance of 151.36 feet to the place of beginning containing 8171.7514 square feet in all of which 7869.0939 square feet is in Lot Number 1708 and 302.6575 square feet is in a part of Lot Number 1709 but subject to all legal highways also all easements of record.
