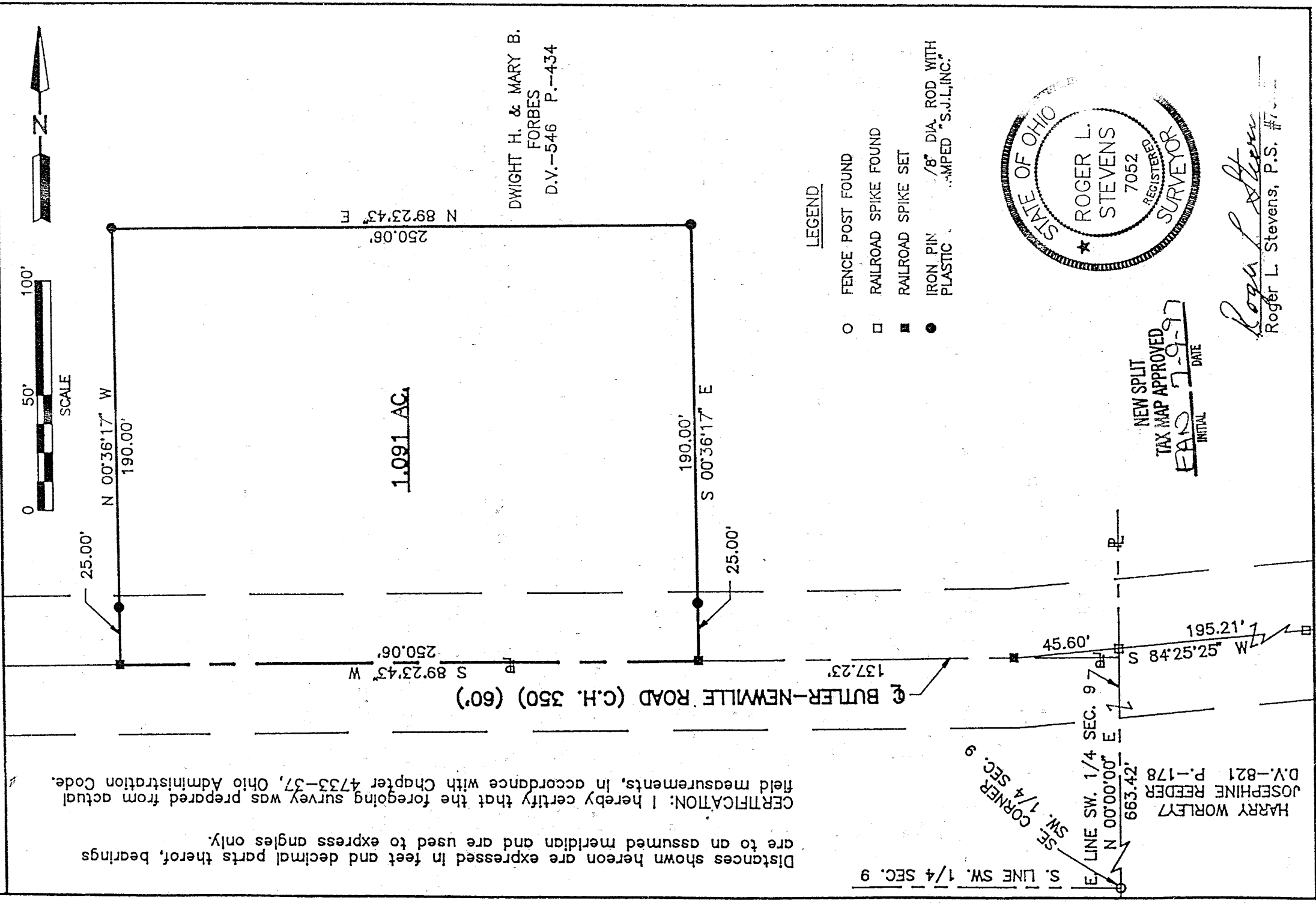

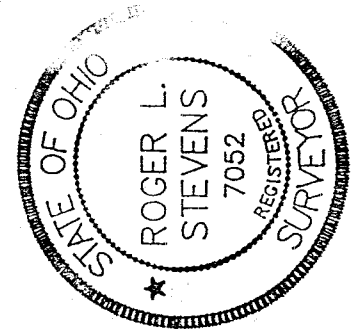

1.091 Acres

Situated in the Township of Worthington, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being part of the Southwest Quarter of Section 9, Township 21, Range 17, and being more particularly described as follows:  
Commencing at a fence post found in the southeast corner of said southwest Quarter;

Thence N 00° 00' 00" E, 663.42 feet along the east line of said Southwest Road (C.H. 350)(60 feet);

Thence S 84° 25' 25" W, 45.60 feet along said centerline of Butler-Newville Newville Road to a railroad spike set;

Thence S 89° 23' 43" W, 137.23 feet and continuing along said centerline of Butler-Newville Road to a railroad spike set, being the true place of beginning;

Thence continuing S 89° 23' 43" W, 250.06 feet along said centerline a railroad spike set;

Thence N 00° 36' 17" W, 190.00 feet to an iron pin set and passing through an iron pin set at 25.00 feet;

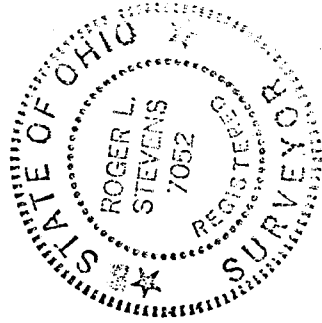
Thence N 89° 23' 43" E, 250.06 feet to an iron pin set and passing through an iron pin set at 25.00 feet;

Thence S 00° 36' 17" E, 190.00 feet to the true place of beginning, passing through an iron pin set at 165.00 feet and containing 1.091 acres, more or less, but subject to all legal highways and easements of record.

Bearings are to an assumed meridian and are used to express angles only.
