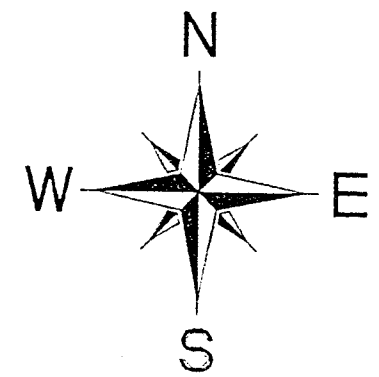
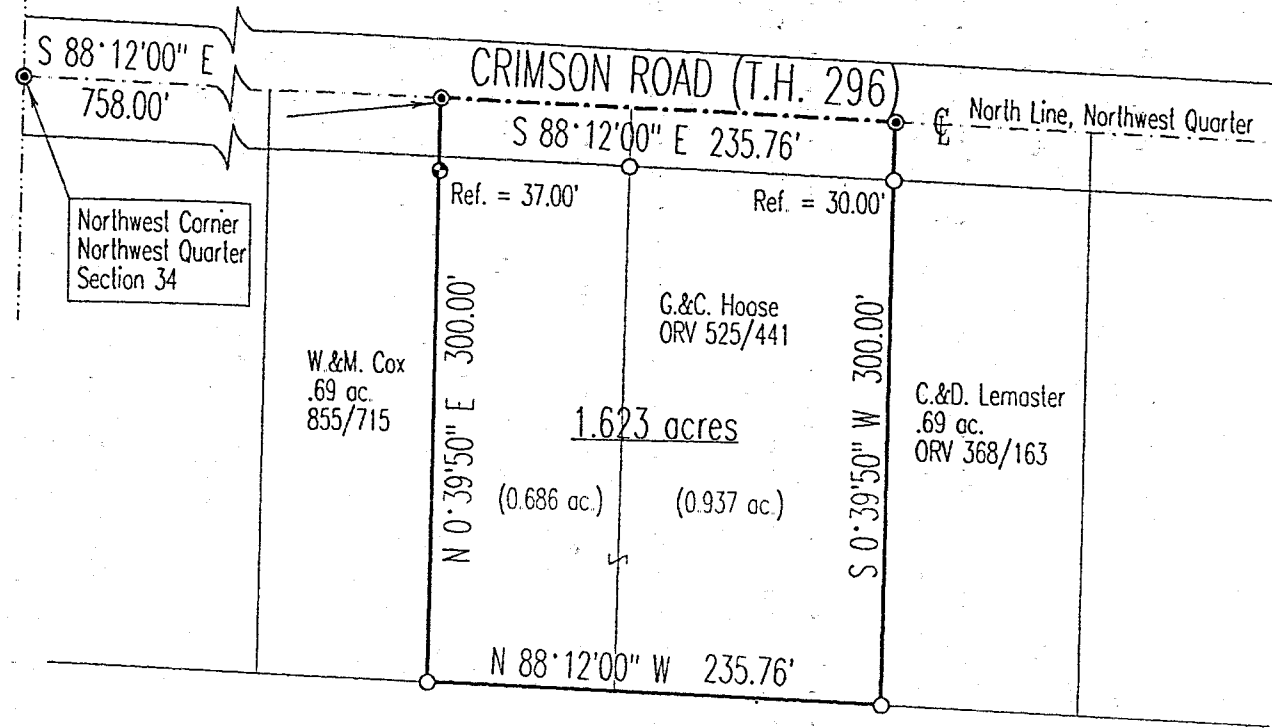


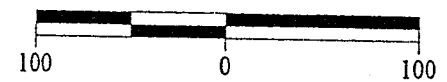

Richland County, Ohio



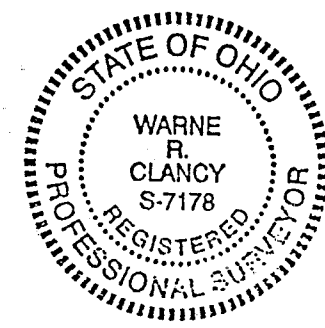

SURVEY DESCRIPTION

PART NORTHWEST QUARTER, SECTION 34
MIFFLIN TOWNSHIP, T-23, R-17
RICHLAND COUNTY, OHIO

Situated in the Township of Mifflin, County of Richland, State of Ohio, and being a part of the Northwest Quarter of Section 34 of Township 23, Range 17, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing for the same at a PK spike set marking the northwest corner of said northwest quarter; Thence, South 88 degrees 12 minutes 00 seconds East with the north line of said quarter, the same being the centerline of Crimson Road (T.H. 296), a distance of 758 feet to a PK spike set marking the northeast corner of an existing .69 acre parcel owned by W.&M. Cox (855/715), the Place of Beginning;

Thence, continuing with said north quarter and centerlines South 88 degrees 12 minutes 00 seconds East, a distance of 235.76 feet to a PK spike set marking the northwest corner of an existing .69 acre parcel owned by C.&D. Lemaster (ORV 368/163);

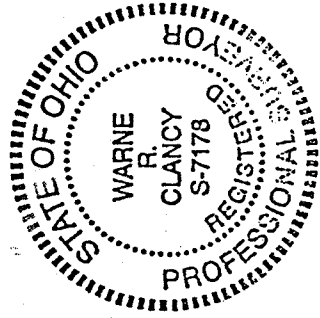
Thence, South 00 degrees 39 minutes 50 seconds West with the west line of said .69 acres, passing an iron pin found for reference at 30.00 feet, a distance of 300.00 feet to an iron pin found on the north line of an existing 8.29 acre parcel owned by D.&S. Phillips (723/607);

Thence, North 88 degrees 12 minutes 00 seconds West with said north line, a distance of 235.76 feet to an iron pin found marking the southeast corner of said .69 acre Cox parcel;

Thence, North 00 degrees 39 minutes 50 seconds East with the east line of said Cox parcel, passing an iron pin set for reference at 263.00 feet, a distance of 300.00 feet to the Place of Beginning, containing 1.623 acres according to survey by Warne R. Clancy, Professional Surveyor #7178, on December 8, 1997.

Iron pins set are #5 rebars with caps stamped "CLANCY 7178".

Bearings are based on an assumed meridian.
