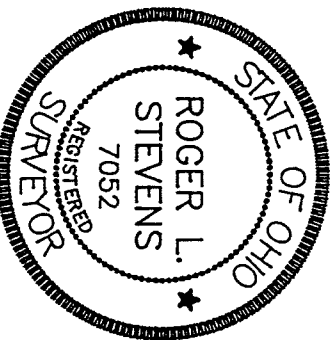
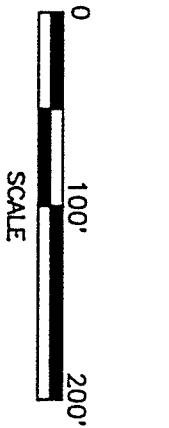

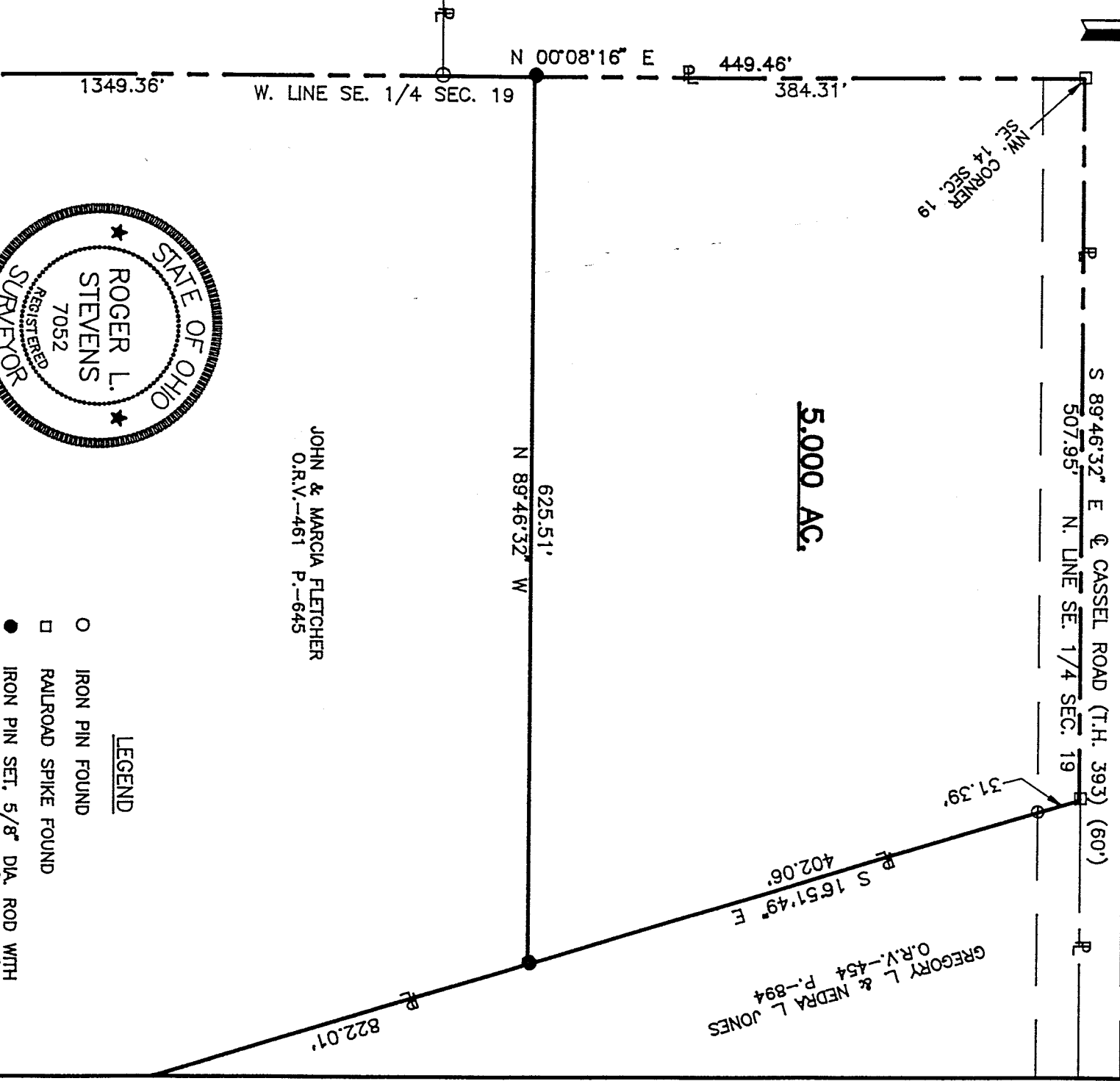

5.000 Acres

Situated in the Township of Worthington, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being part of the Southeast Quarter of section 19, Township 21, Range 17 and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a railroad spike set in the northwest corner of said Southeast Quarter, said railroad spike also being in the centerline of Cassel Road (T.H. 393) (60');

Thence S 89° 46' 32" E, 507.95 feet along the north line of said Southeast Quarter also being said centerline of Cassel Road to a railroad spike found in the northwest corner of a parcel of land conveyed to Gregory L. and Nedra L. Jones by volume 454, page 894 of Richland County official records;

Thence S 16° 51' 49" E, 402.06 feet along the westerly line of said land of Gregory L. and Nedra L. Jones to an iron pin set and passing through an iron pin found at 31.39 feet;

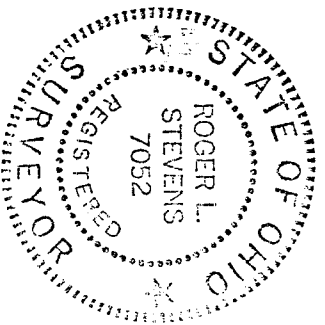
Thence N 89° 46' 32" W, 625.51 feet to an iron pin set in the west line of said Southeast Quarter;


Thence N 00° 08' 16" E, 384.31 feet along said west line of said Southeast Quarter to place of beginning and containing 5.000 acres, more or less, but subject to all legal highways and easements of record.
