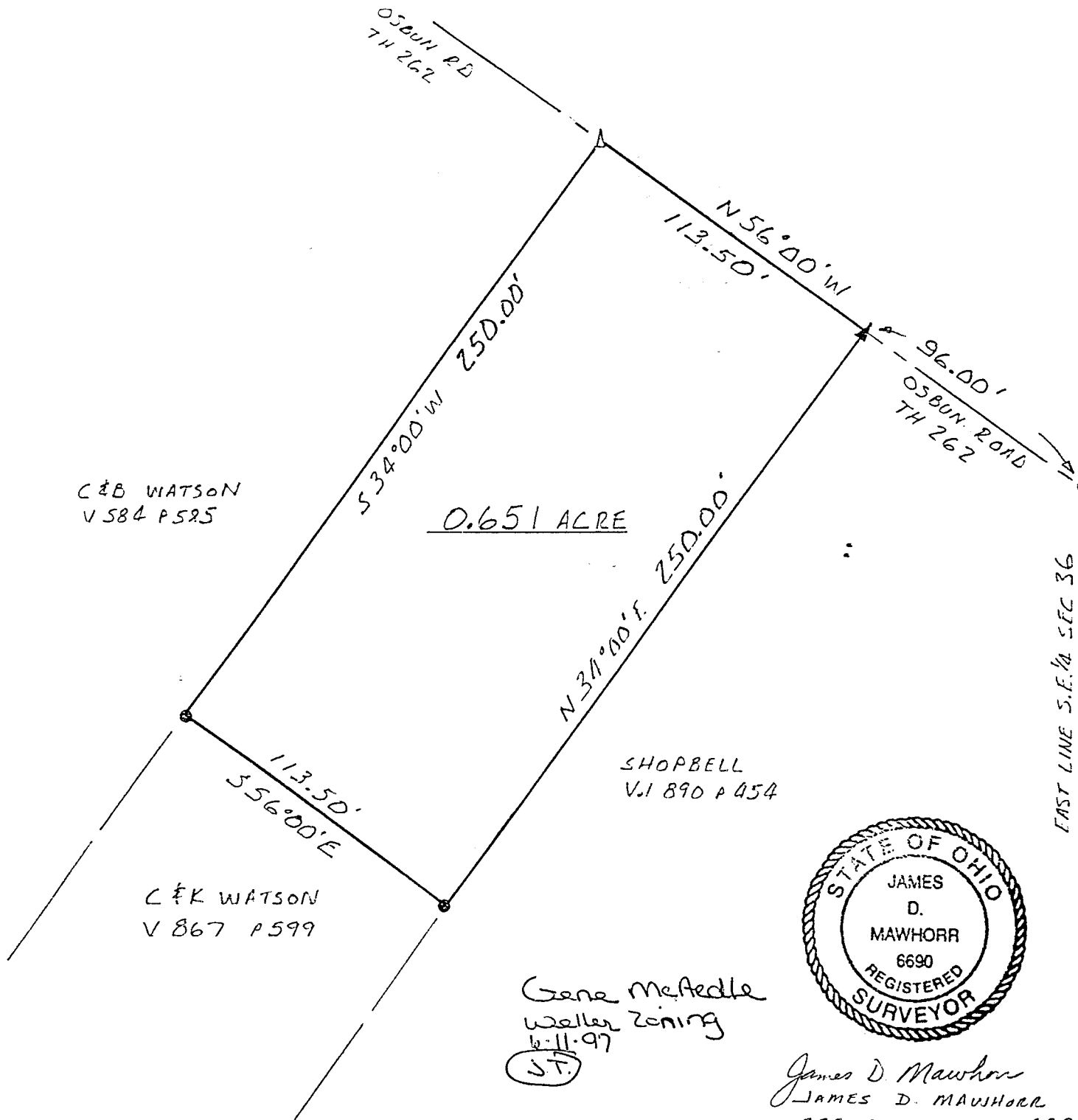

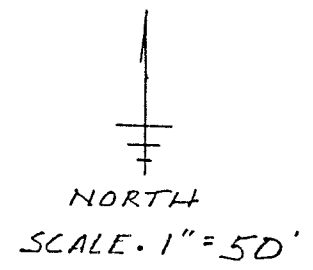

Legal Description
0.651 Acres C & K Watson

Situated in the Township of Weller, County of Richland, State of Ohio, and known as being part of the Southeast Quarter of Section 36, Township 22, Range 18, and more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at an iron pin found at the intersection of the centerline of Osbun Road (T.H.262) and the East line of the Southeast Quarter of Section 36, thence North 56 deg. 00 min. West along the center of Osbun Road a distance of 96.00 feet to a P.K. nail set which is the True Place of Beginning;

thence continuing North 56 deg. 00 min. West a distance of 113.50 feet to a railroad spike found;

thence South 34 deg. 00 min. West a distance of 250.00 feet to an iron pin set;

thence South 56 deg. 00 min. East a distance of 113.50 feet to an iron pin set;

thence North 34 deg. 00 min. East a distance of 250.00 feet to the True Place of Beginning, containing 0.651 acres of land, more or less, but subject to all legal highways and easements of record.

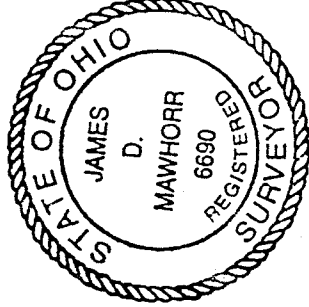
