

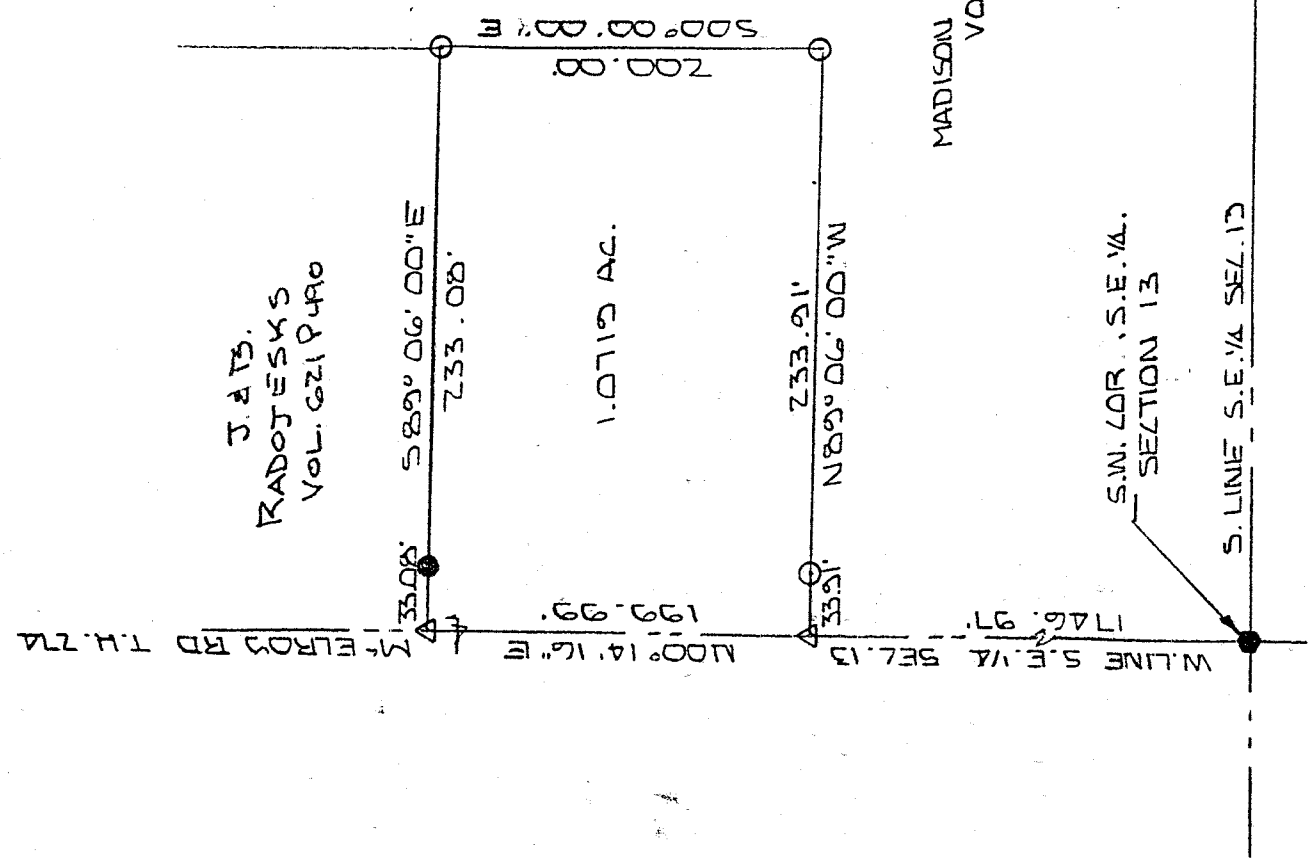
PLAT OF SURVEY FOR RON MONTGOMERY

 QUARTER SE TRILAND COUNTY, OHIO

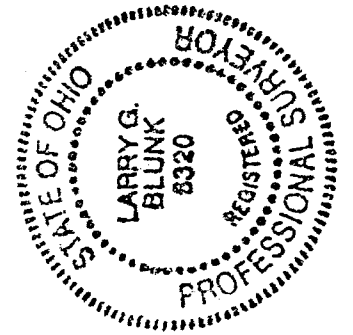
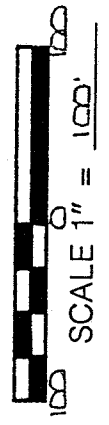



DESCRIPTION
FOR
RON MONTGOMERY

Located in the Township of Madison, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being a part of the Southeast Quarter of Section 13, Township 21, Range 18 and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a railroad spike found in the Southwest Corner of the Southeast Quarter of Section 13.

Thence N 00 degrees 14' 16" E along the west line of the Southeast Quarter of Section 13 a distance of 1746.97 feet to a pk nail set and the True Place of Beginning.

Thence continuing N 00 degrees 14' 16" E along the west line of the Southeast Quarter of Section 13, said line also being the centerline of Mc Elroy Rd. T.H. 274, a distance of 199.99 feet to a pk nail set.

Thence S 89 degrees 06' 00" E passing thru an iron pin found at 33.08 feet a total distance of 233.08 feet to an iron pin set.

Thence S 00 degrees 00' 00" E a distance of 200.00 feet to an iron pin set.

Thence N 89 degrees 06' 00" W passing thru an iron pin set at 200.00 feet a total distance of 233.91 feet to the True Place of Beginning and containing 1.0719 acres more or less but subject to all legal highways also all easements of record.
