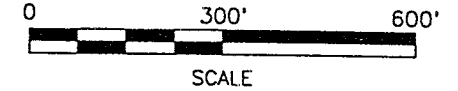
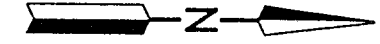


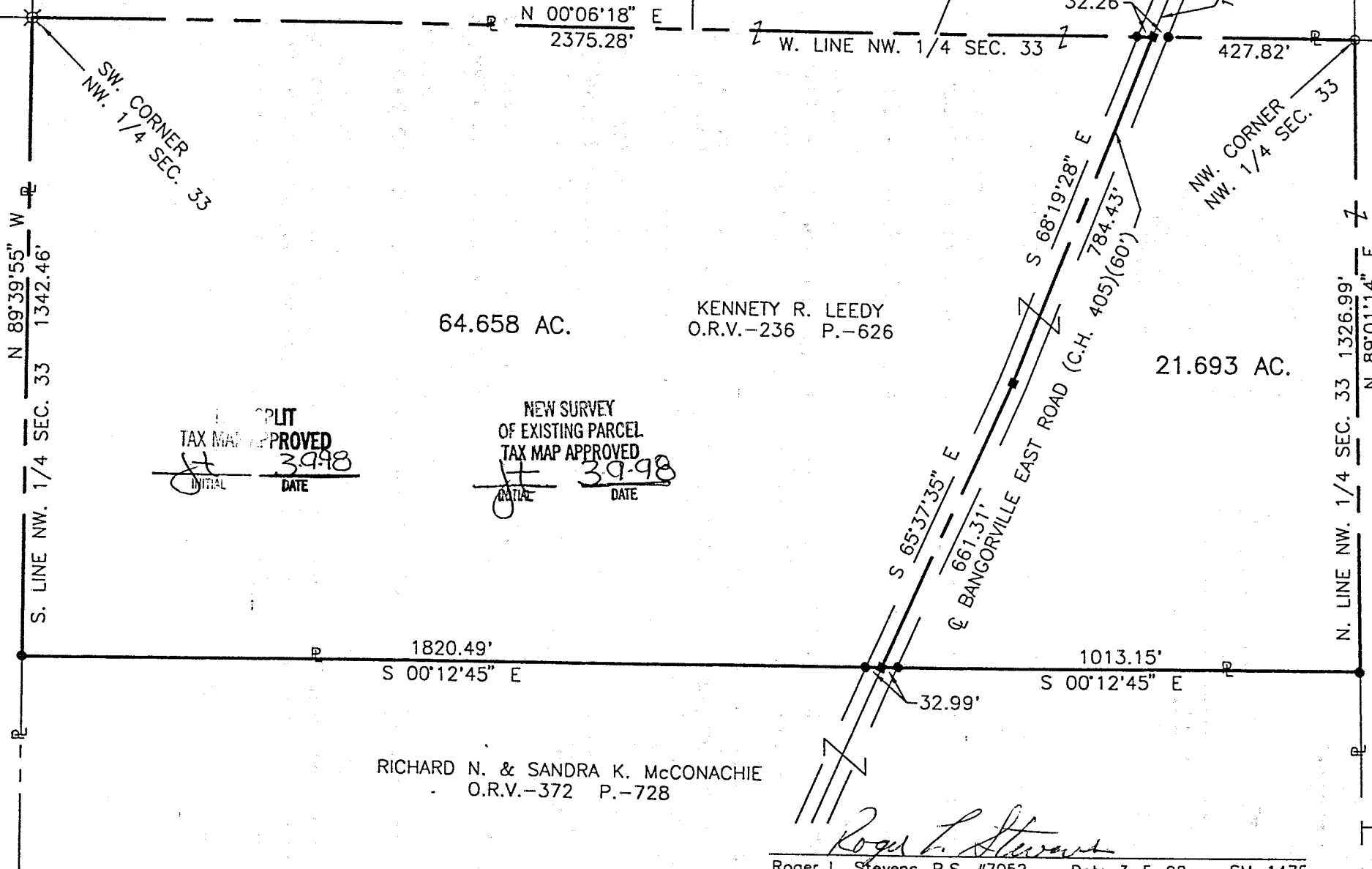

Beginning at a stone found in the southwest corner of said Northwest Quarter;

Thence N 00° 06' 18" E, 2,375.28 feet along the west line of said Northwest Quarter to a railroad spike set in the centerline of Bangorville East Road (C.H. 405) and passing through an iron pin set at 2,343.02 feet;

Thence S 68° 19' 28" E, 784.43 feet along said centerline of Bangorville East Road to a railroad spike set;

Thence S 65° 37' 35" E, 661.31 feet and continuing along said centerline of Bangorville East Road to a railroad spike set in the west line of a parcel of land conveyed to Richard N. and Sandra K. McConachie by official records volume 372, page 728;

Thence S 00° 12' 45" E, 1820.49 feet along said west line of said land of Richard N. and Sandra K. McConachie to an iron pin set in the southwest corner of said land also being in the south line of said Northwest Quarter and passing through an iron pin set at 32.99 feet;

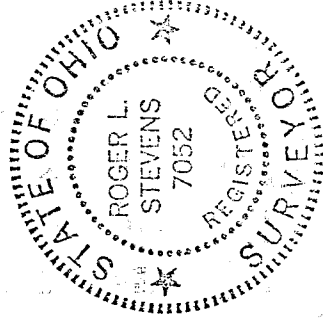
