

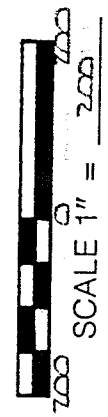
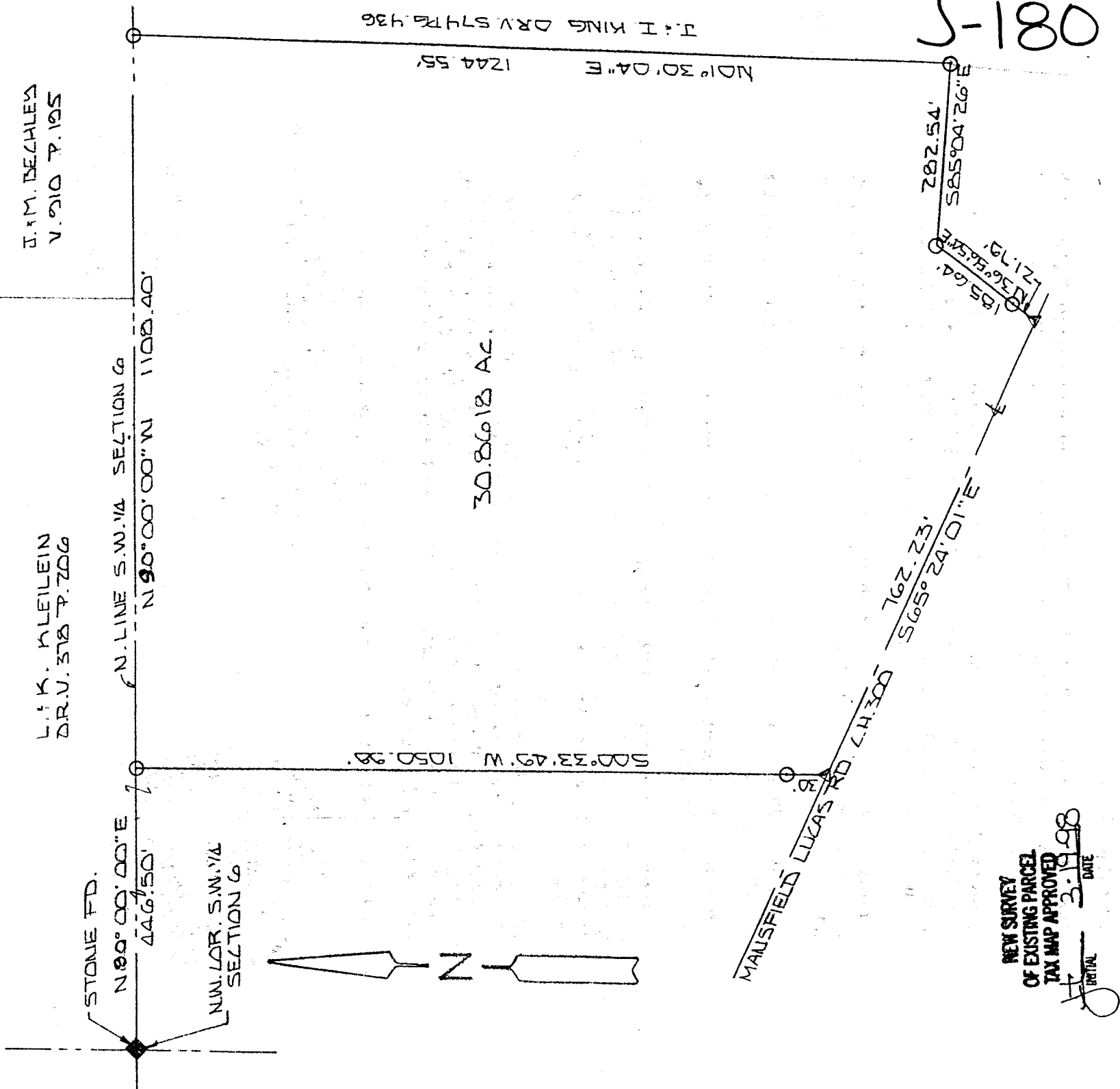

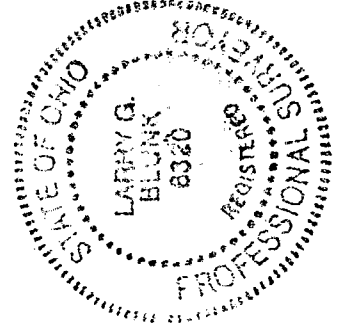

DESCRIPTION  
FOR

LEONARD E. KLEILEIN

Located in the Township of Monroe, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being a part of the Southwest Quarter of Section 6, Township 22, Range 17 and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a stone found in the Northwest Corner of the Southwest Quarter of Section 6.

Thence N 90 degrees 00' 00" E along the north line of the Southwest Quarter of Section 6 a distance of 446.50 feet to an iron pin set and the True Place of Beginning.

Thence S 00 degrees 33' 49" W passing thru an iron pin set at 1020.98 feet a total distance of 1050.98 feet to a pk nail set in the centerline of Mansfield Lucas Rd. C.H. 300.

Thence S 65 degrees 24' 01" E along the centerline of Mansfield Lucas Rd. C.H. 300 a distance of 762.23 feet to a pk nail set.

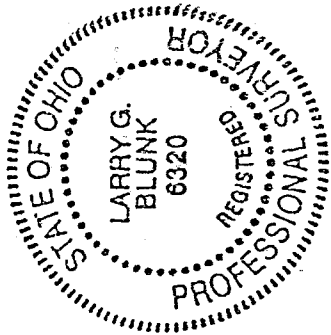
Thence N 36 degrees 56' 54" E passing thru an iron pin set at 21.79 feet a total distance of 185.64 feet to an iron pin set.

Thence S 85 degrees 04' 26" E a distance of 282.54 feet to an iron pin set.

Thence N 01 degrees 30' 04" E a distance of 1244.55 feet to an iron pin set on the north line of the Southwest Quarter of Section 6.

Thence N 90 degrees 00' 00" W along the north line of the Southwest Quarter of Section 6 a distance of 1108.40 feet to the True Place of Beginning and containing 30.8618 acres more or less but subject to all legal highways also all easements of record.
