

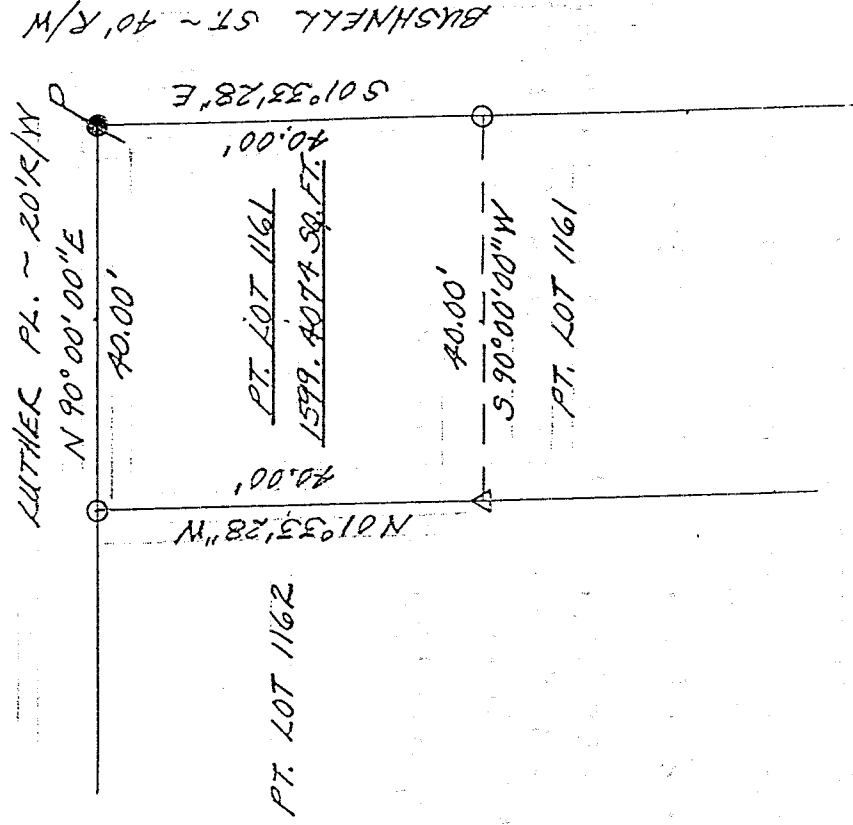
PLAT SURVEY FOR JOSEPH BURNS

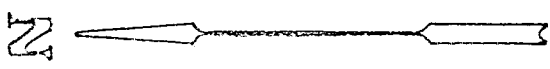

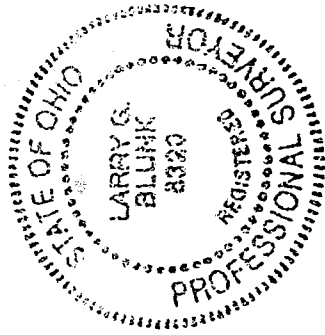

Located in the City of Mansfield, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being a part of Lot Number 1161 as recorded in Volume 2-3, Page 26 of the Richland County Plats Records and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin set in the Northwest Corner of Lot Number 1161.

Thence N 90 degrees 00' 00" E along the north line of Lot Number 1161 a distance of 40.00 feet to a power pole in the Northeast Corner of Lot Number 1161.

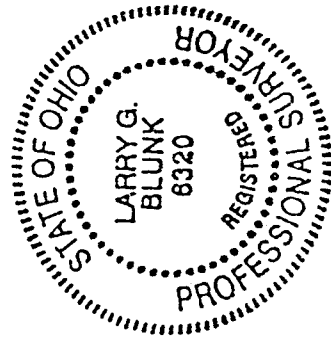
Thence S 01 degrees 33' 28" E along the east line of Lot Number 1161 a distance of 40.00 feet to an iron pin set.

Thence S 90 degrees 00' 00" W a distance of 40.00 feet to a pk nail set in a tree on the west line of Lot Number 1161.

Thence N 01 degrees 33' 28" W along the west line of Lot Number 1161 a distance of 40.00 feet to the place of beginning and containing 1599.4074 square feet but subject to all legal highways also all easements of record.
