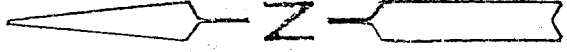
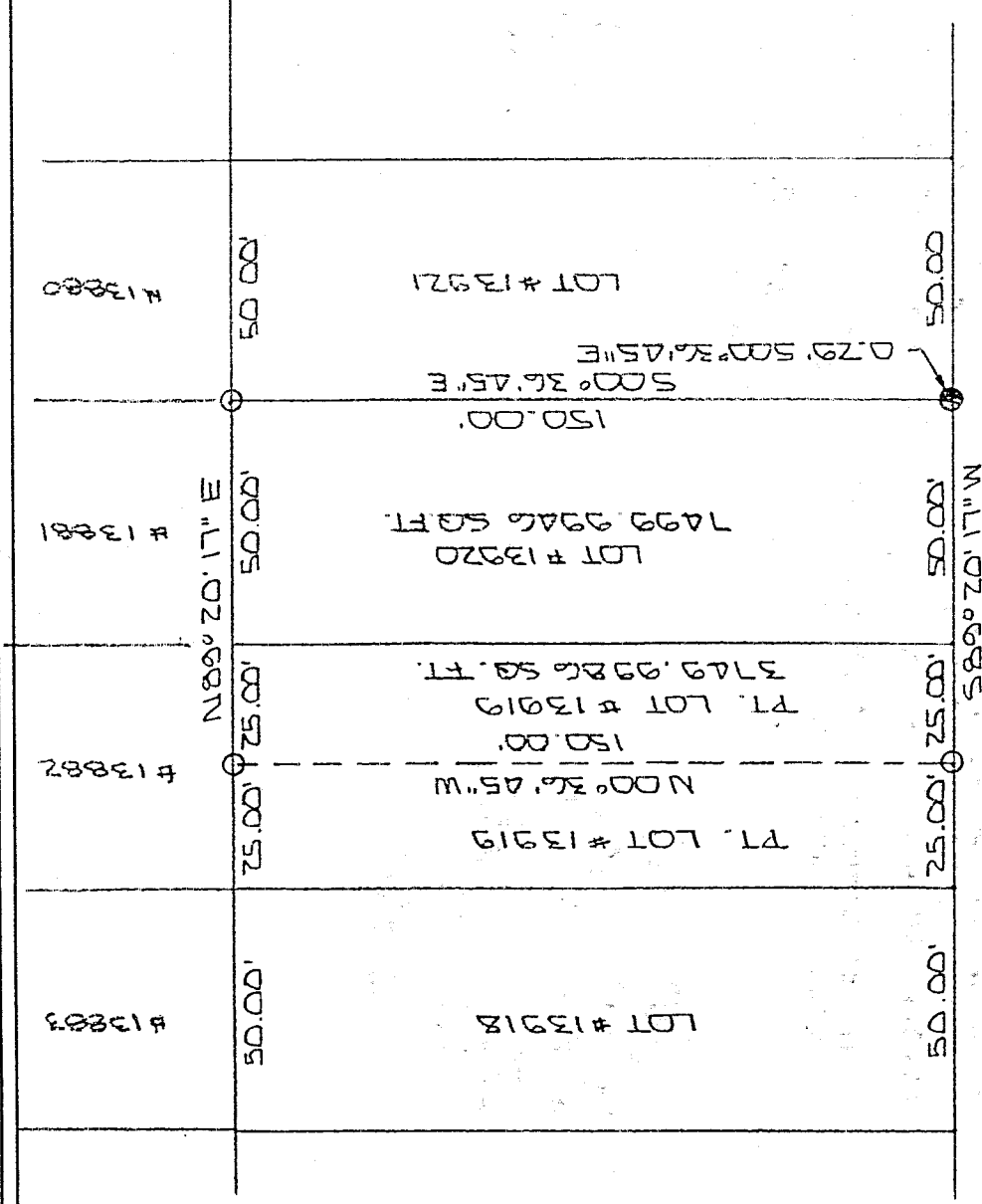


PLAT OF SURVEY FOR M. J. LORENZ

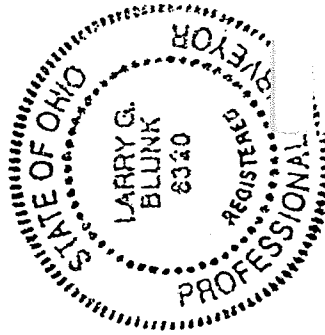
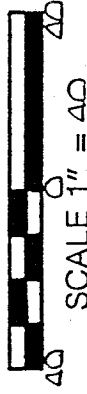

Located in the City of Mansfield, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being all of Lot Number 13920 and a part of Lot Number 13919 as recorded in Volume 15, Page 11 of the Richland County Plat Records and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the Southeast Corner of Lot Number 13920 referenced by an iron pin found, S 00 degrees 36' 45" E - 0.29 feet.

Thence S 89 degrees 20' 17" W along the south line of Lot Numbers 13920 and 13919 a distance of 75.00 feet to an iron pin set.

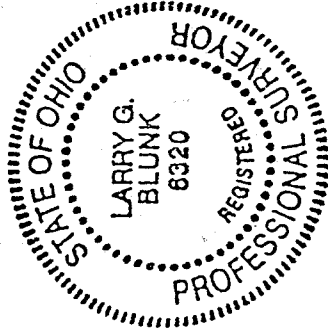
Thence N 00 degrees 36' 45" W a distance of 150.00 feet to an iron pin set on the north line of Lot Number 13919.

Thence N 89 degrees 20' 17" E along the north line of Lot Numbers 13919 and 13920 a distance of 75.00 feet to an iron pin set in the Northeast Corner of Lot Number 13920.

Thence S 00 degrees 36' 45" E along the east line of Lot Number 13920 a distance of 150.00 feet to the place of beginning and containing 11249.9932 square feet in all of which 3749.9986 square feet are in a part of Lot Number 13919 and 7499.9946 square feet are in Lot Number 13920 but subject to all legal highways also all easements of record.
