DESCRIPTION

BEING A PART OF THE SOUTH WEST QUARTER OF SECTION 18, TOWNSHIP 23, RANGE 17, MIFFLIN TOWNSHIP, RICHLAND COUNTY, OHIO AND MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

BEGINNING AT AN IRON PIN FOUND AT THE SOUTH WEST CORNER OF THE SOUTH WEST QUARTER AS REFERENCED ABOVE;

THENCE N 00° 01' 13" W, ALONG THE WEST LINE OF THE QUARTER REFERENCED ABOVE A DISTANCE OF 130.00 FEET TO AN IRON PIN FOUND, SAID POINT BEING THE TRUE PLACE OF BEGINNING FOR THE PARCEL HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED;

THENCE CONTINUING N 00° 01' 13" W A DISTANCE OF 140.00 FEET TO AN IRON PIN FOUND;


THENCE N 88° 26' 48" E A DISTANCE OF 193.90 FEET TO A RAILROAD SPIKE FOUND ON THE CENTERLINE OF WOODCREST DRIVE, SAID POINT REFERENCED BY AN IRON PIN FOUND S 88° 26' 48" W AT A DISTANCE OF 25.00 FEET;

THENCE S 00° 00' 58" E ALONG AND WITH THE CENTERLINE OF WOODCREST DRIVE A DISTANCE OF 140.00 FEET TO A RAILROAD SPIKE FOUND, SAID POINT REFERENCED BY AN IRON PIN FOUND S 88° 26' 48" W AT A DISTANCE OF 23.29 FEET;
