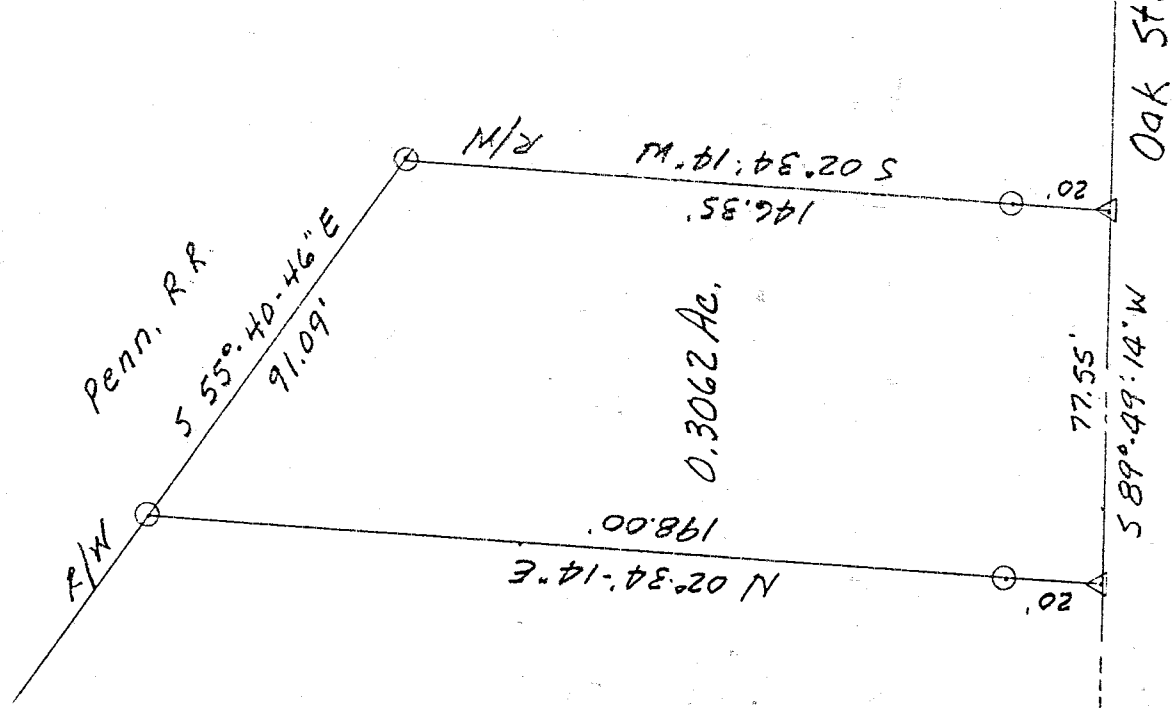
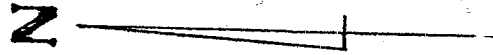


PLAT SURVEY FOR N 4 J. Keising

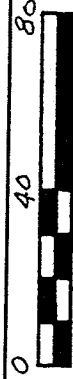

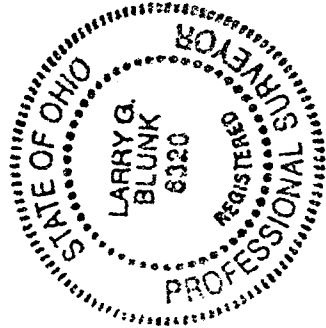

Located in the City of Mansfield, Township of Madison, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being a part of the Northwest Quarter of Section 26, Township 21, Range 18 and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin set in the Southwest Corner of the Northwest Quarter of Section 26.

Thence N 89 degrees 49' 14" E along the south line of the Northwest Quarter of Section 26, said line also being the centerline of Oak St., a distance of 1544.00 feet to a pk nail set and the True Place of Beginning.

Thence N 02 degrees 34' 14" E passing thru an iron pin set at 20.00 feet a total distance of 198.00 feet to an iron pin set on the southerly right-of-way of the Penn. Railroad.

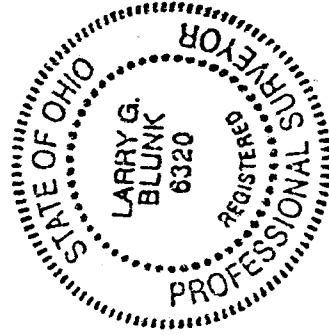
Thence S 55 degrees 40' 46" E along the southerly right-of-way of the Penn. Railroad a distance of 91.09 feet to an iron pin set.

Thence S 02 degrees 34' 14" W passing thru an iron pin set at 126.35 feet a total distance of 146.35 feet to a pk nail set on the south line of the Northwest Quarter of Section 26, said line also being the centerline of Oak St..

Thence S 89 degrees 49' 14" W along the south line of the Northwest Quarter of Section 26, said line also being the centerline of Oak St., a distance of 77.55 feet to the True Place of Beginning and containing 0.3062 acres more or less but subject to all legal highways also all easements of record.
