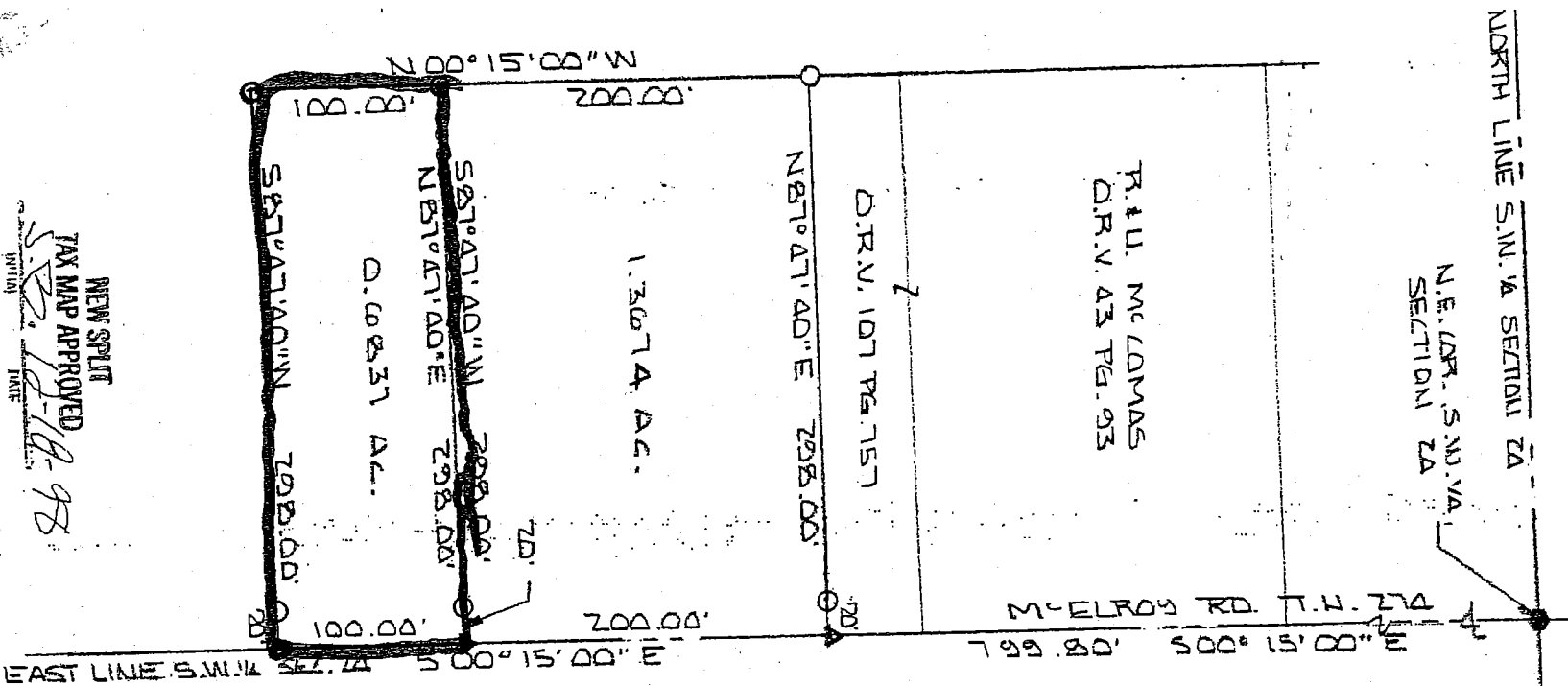

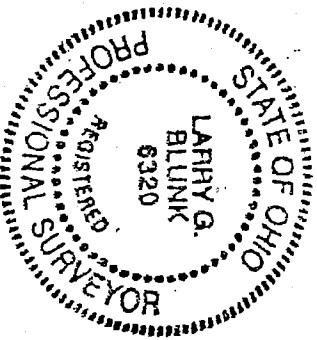

DESCRIPTION  
FOR

Located in the Township of Madison, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being a part of the Southwest Quarter of Section 24, Township 21, Range 18 and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a railroad spike found in the Northeast Corner of the Southwest Quarter of Section 24.

Thence S 00 degrees 15' 00" E along the east line of the Southwest Quarter of Section 24, said line also being the centerline of Mc Elroy Rd. T.H. 274, a distance of 999.80 feet to a pk nail set and the True Place of Beginning.

Thence continuing S 00 degrees 15' 00" E along the east line of the Southwest Quarter of Section 24, said line also being the centerline of Mc Elroy Rd. T.H. 274, a distance of 100.00 feet to an iron pin set.

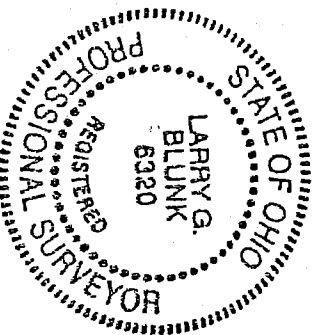
Thence S 87 degrees 47' 40" W passing thru an iron pin set at 20.00 feet a total distance of 298.00 feet to an iron pin set.

Thence N 00 degrees 15' 00" W a distance of 100.00 feet to an iron pin set.

Thence N 87 degrees 47' 40" E passing thru an iron pin set at 278.00 feet a total distance of 298.00 feet to the True Place of Beginning and containing 0.6837 acres more or less but subject to all legal highways also all easements of record.
