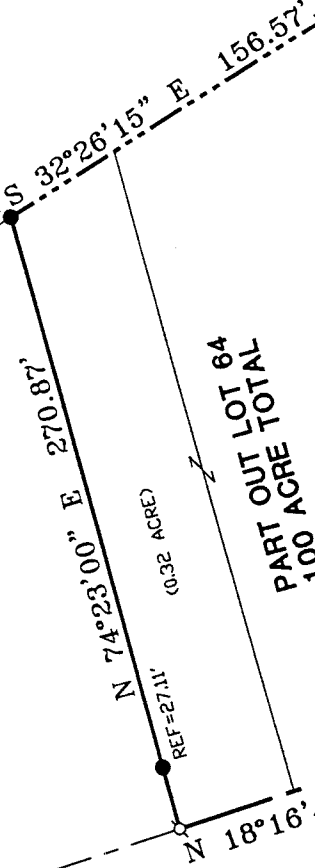

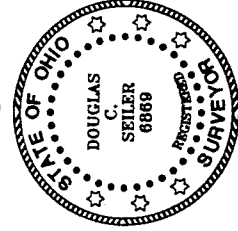

## SURVEY DESCRIPTION

GRANTOR: TROY TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES

GRANTEE: VILLAGE OF LEXINGTON, OHIO

PARCEL "B"

PART OF OUT LOT 64  
VILLAGE OF LEXINGTON, OHIO

Situated in the Village of Lexington, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being a part of Out Lot #64 in said Village, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at an iron pin found and accepted as marking the point of intersection of the north line of the Southeast Quarter of Section 24, Troy Township, Township 20 N, Range 19 W, with the westerly line of the Richland County Bikeway; Thence, South 32 degrees 26 minutes 15 seconds East with said westerly line, a distance of 271.60 feet to a railroad spike set, the place of beginning of the parcel herein described;

Thence, continuing South 32 degrees 26 minutes 15 seconds East with said westerly line, a distance of 117.70 feet to an iron pin set;

Thence, South 73 degrees 43 minutes 48 seconds West, passing through an iron pin set for reference at 228.39 feet, a total distance of 258.39 feet to a PK spike set on the centerline of Mill Street;

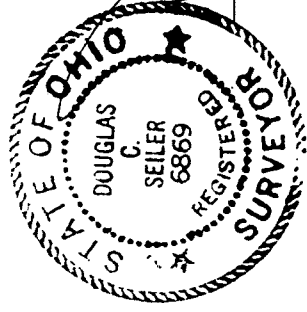
Thence, North 18 degrees 16 minutes 47 seconds West with said centerline, a distance of 114.58 feet to a PK spike set marking the southwest corner of a parcel currently owned by Baker Coal & Builders Supplies, Inc. (deed reference: Volume 449, page 285), the same being the northwest corner of a parcel currently owned by the Troy Township Trustees (deed reference: Volume 493, page 232);

Thence, North 74 degrees 05 minutes 42 seconds East with the line common to the afore mentioned parties, passing through a railroad spike set for reference at 30.00 feet, a total distance of 229.63 feet to the place of beginning, containing 0.64 of an acre, according to survey by Douglas C. Seiler, Professional Surveyor #6869 on March 27, 2000, but subject to the right of way of Mill Street.

Iron pins set are 5/8" rods with caps stamped "SEILER 6869".
