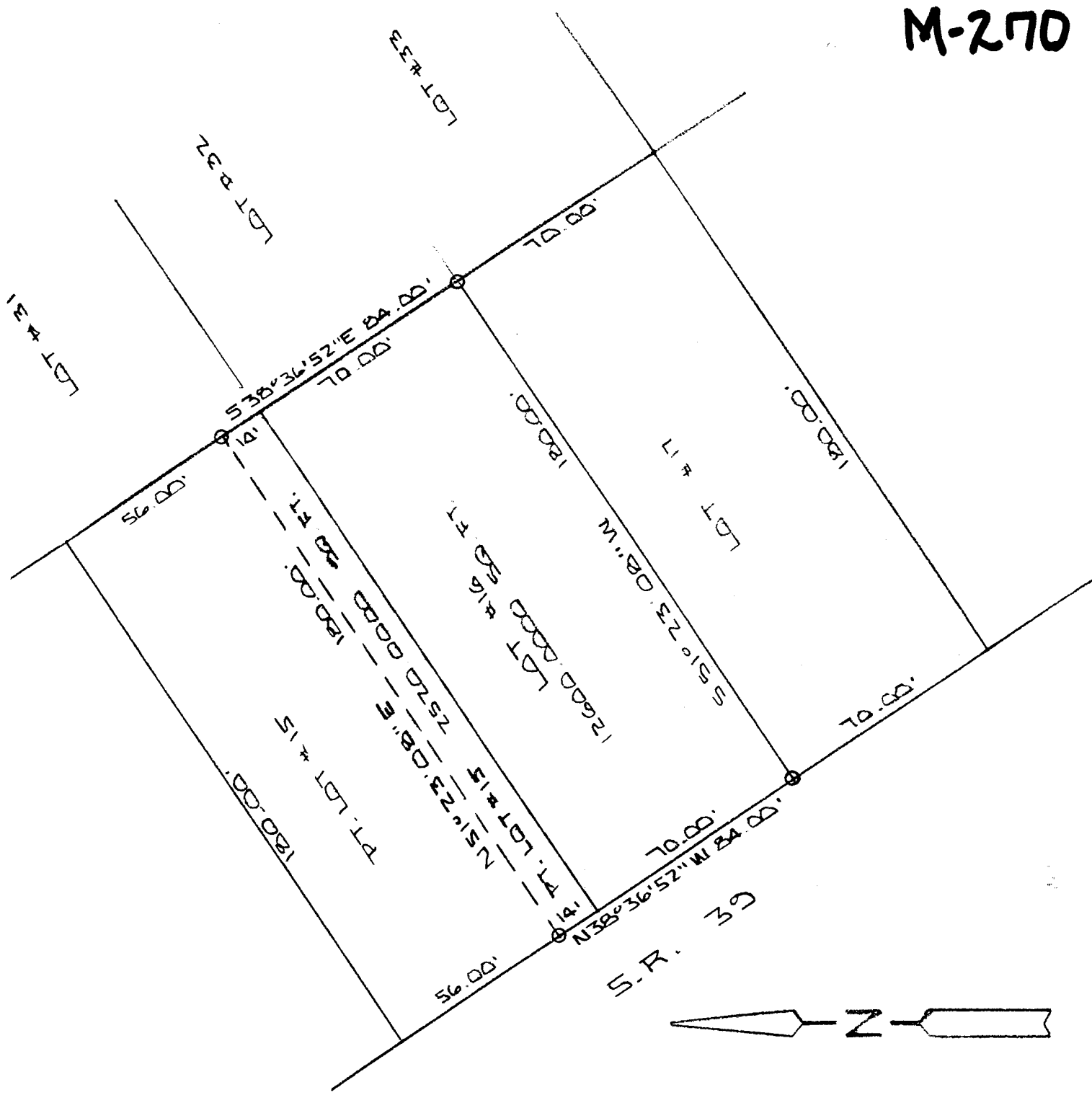


# PLAT OF SURVEY FOR MERVIN SHAFFNER

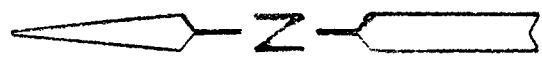

DESCRIPTION  
FOR  
MERVIN SHAFFNER

Located in the Township of Madison, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being a part of the Northwest Quarter of Section 25, Township 21, Range 18 and being all of Lot Number 16 and a part of Lot Number 15 of Green Ridge No. 1 Allotment as recorded in Volume 18, Page 63 of the Richland County Plat Records and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin set in the Southwest Corner of Lot Number 16.

Thence N 38 degrees 36' 52" W along the west line of Lot Numbers 16 and 15 a distance of 84.00 feet to an iron pin set.

Thence N 51 degrees 23' 08" E a distance of 180.00 feet to an iron pin set on the east line of Lot Number 15.

Thence S 38 degrees 36' 52" E along the east line of Lot Numbers 15 and 16 a distance of 84.00 feet to an iron pin set in the Southeast Corner of Lot Number 16.

Thence S 51 degrees 23' 08" W along the south line of Lot Number 16 a distance of 180.00 feet to the place of beginning and containing 15120.0000 square feet in all of which 2520.0000 square feet are in a part of Lot Number 15 and 12600.0000 square feet are in Lot Number 16 but subject to all legal highways also all easements of record.

Basis of Bearings: Bearings are to an assumed azimuth and are used to denote angles only.
