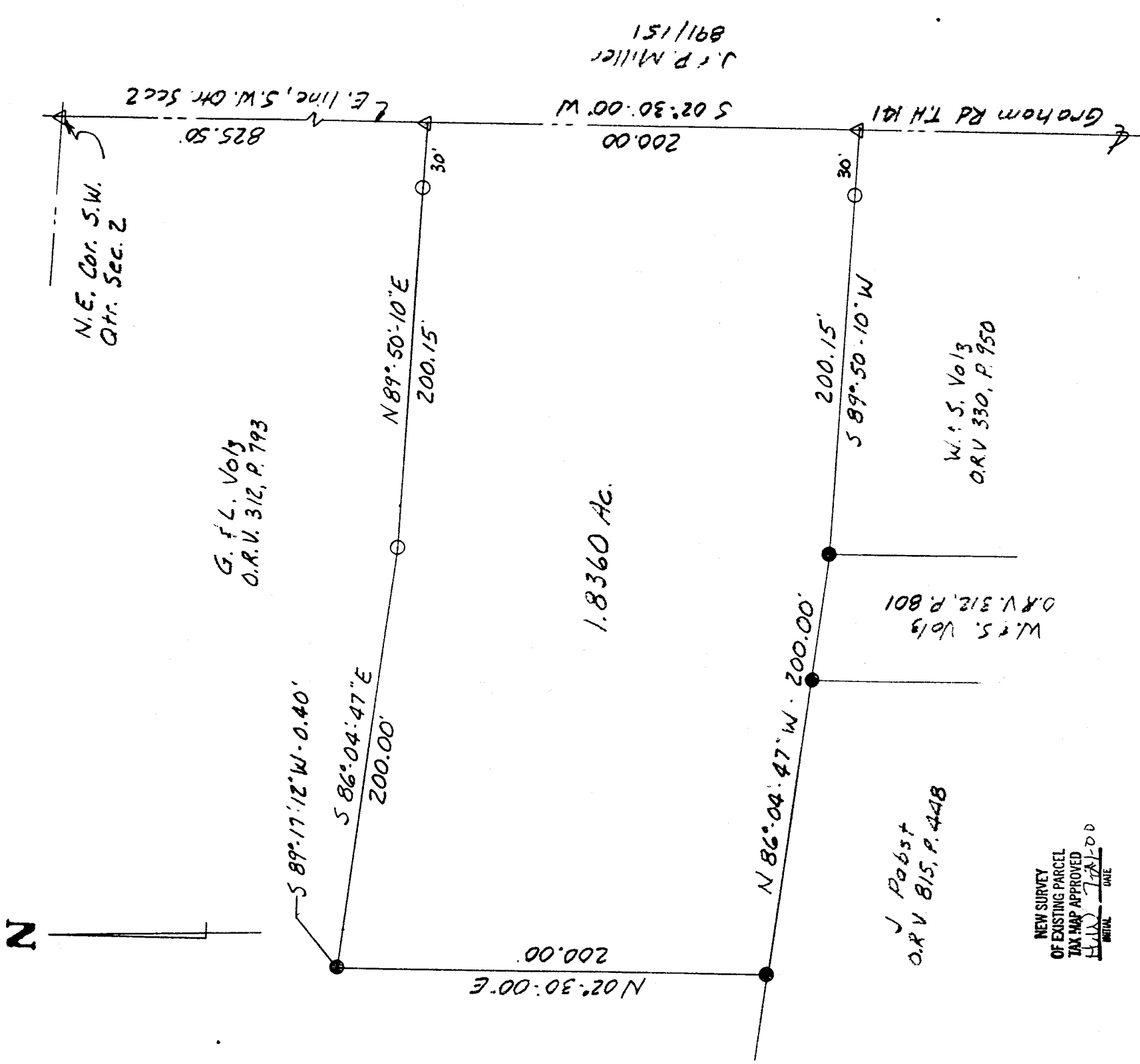


PLAT OF SURVEY FOR Gerald E. Teetrick

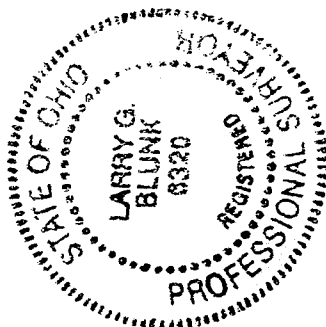

DESCRIPTION

FOR

GERALD E. TEETRICK

Located in the Township of Troy, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being a part of the Southwest Quarter of Section 2, Township 20, Range 19 and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a pk nail set in the Northeast Corner of the Southwest Quarter of Section 2.

Thence S 02 degrees 30' 00" W along the east line of the Southwest Quarter of Section 2, said line also being the centerline of Graham Rd. T.H. 141, a distance of 825.50 feet to a pk nail set and the True Place of Beginning.

Thence continuing S 02 degrees 30' 00" W along the east line of the Southwest Quarter of Section 2, said line also being the centerline of Graham Rd. T.H. 141, a distance of 200.00 feet to a pk nail set.

Thence S 89 degrees 50' 10" W passing thru an iron pin set at 30.00 feet a total distance of 200.15 feet to an iron pin found.

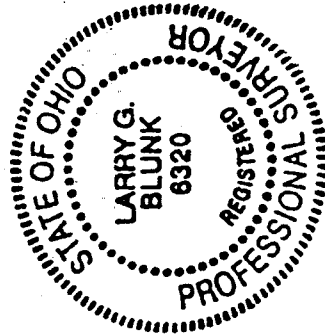
Thence N 86 degrees 04' 47" W a distance of 200.00 feet to an iron pin found.

Thence N 02 degrees 30' 00" E a distance of 200.00 feet, referenced by an iron pin found S 89 degrees 17' 12" W - 0.40 feet.

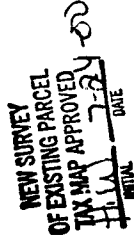
Thence S 86 degrees 04' 47" E a distance of 200.00 feet to an iron pin set.

Thence N 89 degrees 50' 10" E passing thru an iron pin set at 170.15 feet a total distance of 200.15 feet to the True Place of Beginning and containing 1.8360 acres more or less but subject to all legal highways also all easements of record.
