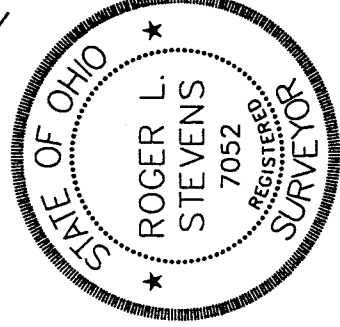
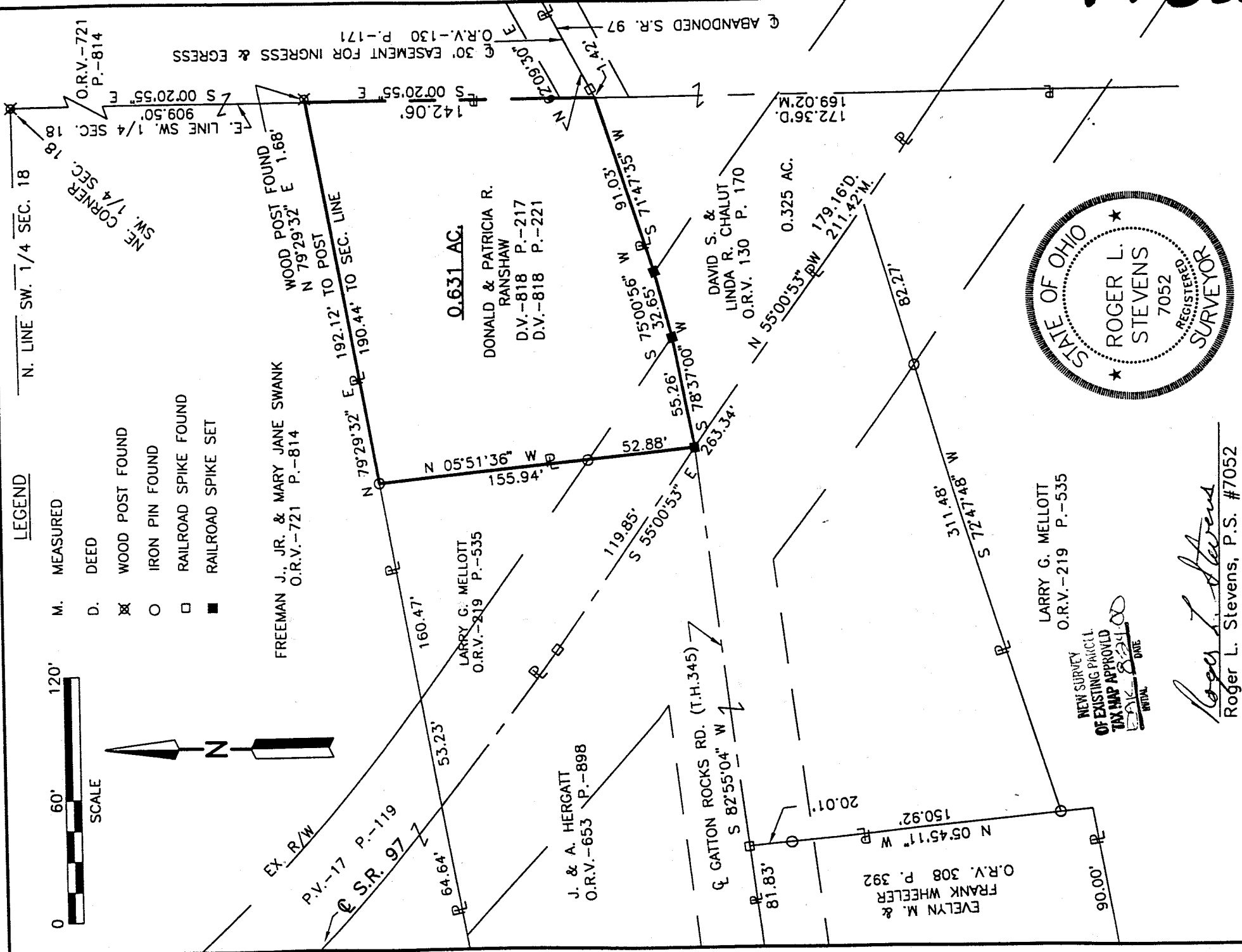
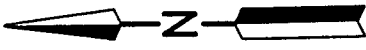

**SURVEYOR'S DESCRIPTION FOR
DAVID S. & LINDA R. CHALUT**

0.631 Acres

Situated in the Township of Worthington, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being part of the Southwest Quarter of Section 18, Township 21, Range 17 and being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a wood post found in the northeast corner of said Southwest Quarter;

Thence S 00° 20' 55" E, 909.50 feet along the east line of said Southwest Quarter to a point being in a southeast corner of a parcel of land conveyed to Freeman J., Jr. and Mary Jane Swank by official records volume 721, page 814, said point also being referenced by a wood post found N 79° 29' 32" E, 1.68 feet from said point and being the true place of beginning;

Thence S 00° 20' 55" E, 142.06 feet along said east line of said Southwest Quarter to a point being the northeast corner of a parcel of land conveyed to David S. and Linda R. Chalut by official records volume 130, page 170, said point also being in the abandoned centerline of S.R. 97 and being referenced by a railroad spike found N 62° 09' 30" E, 1.42 feet from said point;

Thence S 71° 47' 35" W, 91.03 feet along the north line of said land of David S. and Linda R. Chalut also being along said abandoned centerline of S.R. 97 to a railroad spike set;

Thence S 75° 00' 56" W, 32.65 feet and continuing along said north line of said land of David S. and Linda R. Chalut also being along said abandoned centerline of S.R. 97 to a railroad spike set;

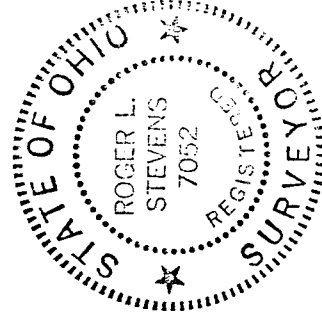
Thence S 78° 37' 00" W, 55.26 feet and continuing along said north line of said land of David S. and Linda R. Chalut also being along said abandoned centerline of S.R. 97 to a railroad spike set in the centerline of S.R. 97, said railroad spike also being in the southeast corner of a parcel of land conveyed to Larry G. Mellott by official records volume 219, page 535;


Thence N 05° 51' 36" W, 155.94 feet along the east line of said land of Larry G. Mellott to an iron pin found in the northeast corner of said land, said iron pin also being in the south line of aforementioned land of Freeman J., Jr. and Mary Jane Swank and passing through an iron pin found at 52.88 feet;

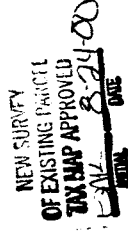
