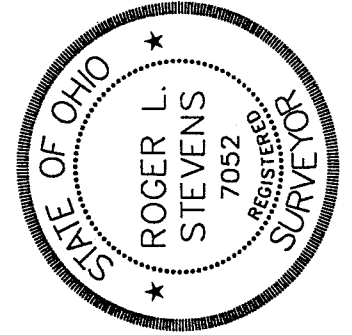
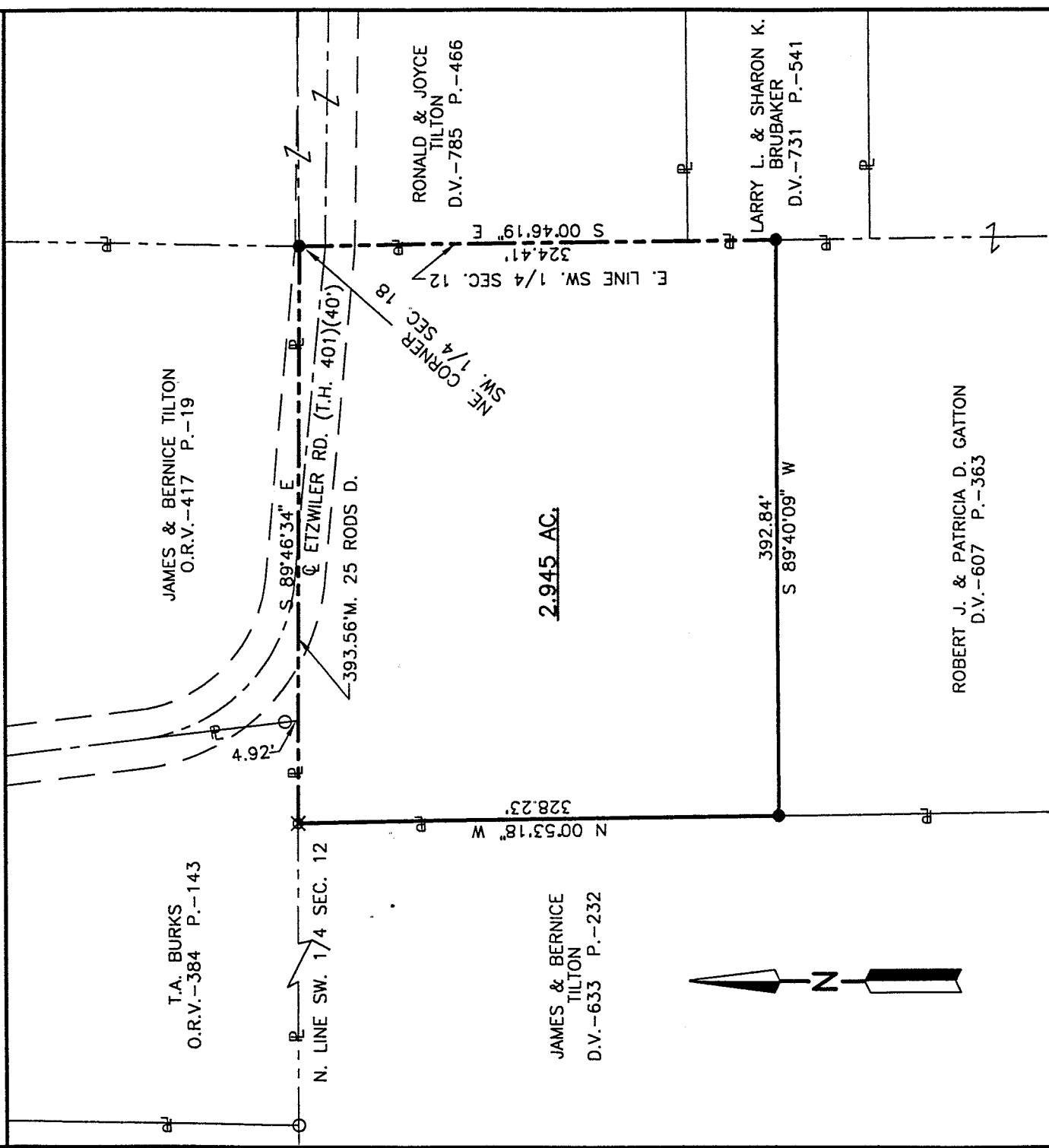

**2.945 Acres**

Situated in the Township of Jefferson, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being part of the Southwest Quarter of Section 12, Township 19, Range 18 and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin set in the northeast corner of said Southwest Quarter;

Thence S 00° 46' 19" E, 324.41 feet along the east line of said Southwest Quarter to an iron pin set;

Thence S.89° 40' 09" W, 392.84 feet to an iron pin set in the east line of a parcel of land conveyed to James and Bernice Tilton by deed volume 633, page 232;

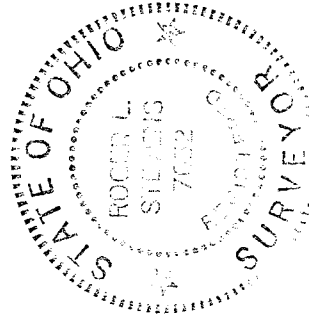
Thence N 00° 53' 18" W, 328.23 feet along said east line of said land of James and Bernice Tilton to a stone found in the northeast corner of said land, said stone also being in the north line of said Southwest Quarter;


Thence S 89° 46' 34" E, 393.56 feet to the place of beginning and containing 2.945 acres, more or less, and subject to all legal highways and easements of record.;

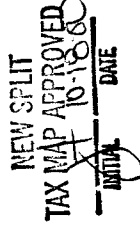
Bearings are to an assumed meridian and are used to express angles only.
