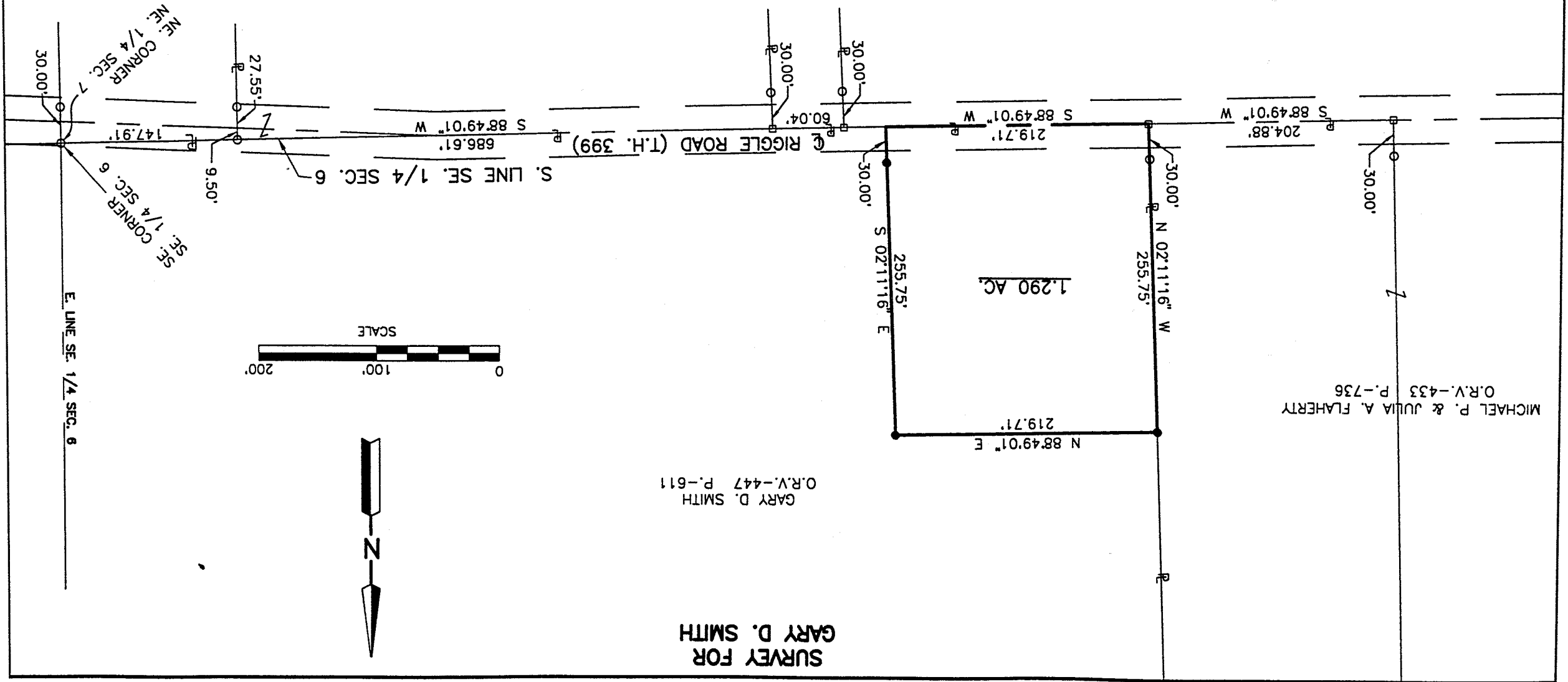

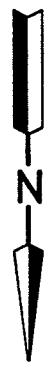
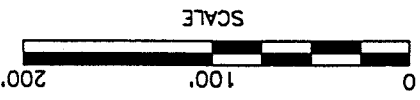

**SURVEYOR'S DESCRIPTION

**1.029 Acres**

Situated in the Township of Worthington, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being part of the Southeast Quarter of Section 6, Township 21, Range 17 and being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at an iron pin found in the southeast corner of said Southeast Quarter;

Thence S 88° 49' 01" W, 686.61 feet along the south line of said Southeast Quarter also being along the centerline of Riggle Road (T.H. 399) to a point, said point being referenced by an iron pin set N 02° 11' 16" W, 30.00 feet from said point and being the true place of beginning;

Thence continuing S 88° 49' 01" W, 219.71 feet along said south line and said centerline of Riggle Road to a railroad spike found in the southeast corner of a parcel of land conveyed to Michael P. and Julia A. Flaherty by official records volume 433, page 736;

Thence N 02° 11' 16" W, 255.75 feet along the east line of said land of Michael P. and Julia A. Flaherty to an iron pin set and passing through an iron pin found at 30.00 feet;

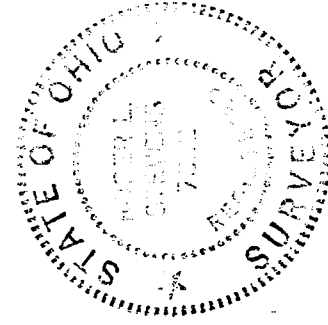
Thence N 88° 49' 01" E, 219.71 feet to an iron pin set;


Thence S 02° 11' 16" E, 255.75 feet to the true place of beginning and containing 1.290 acres, more or less, and subject to all legal highways and easements of record.

All iron pins set are 5/8" diameter rod with plastic cap stamped "STEVENS 7052".
