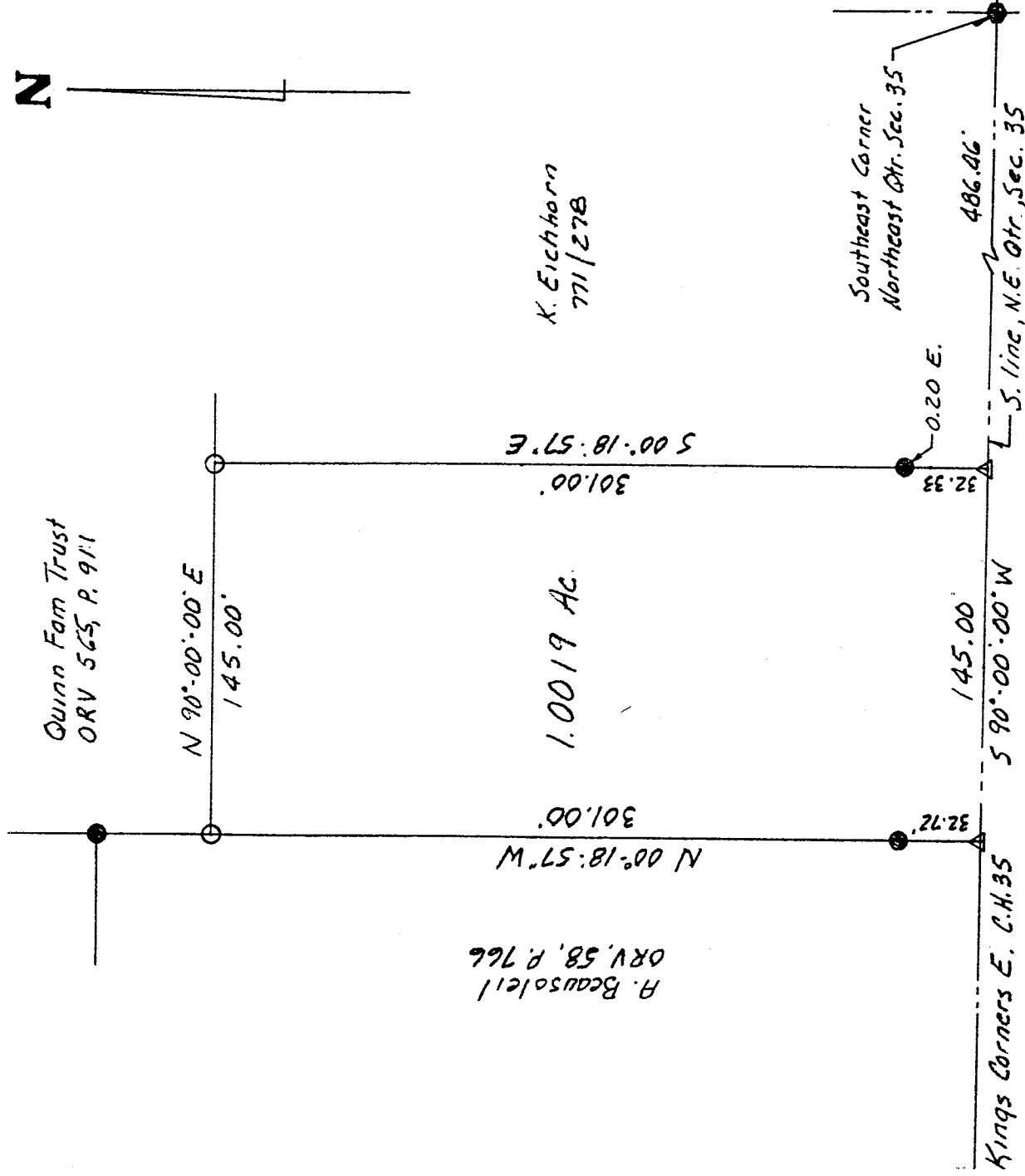


# PLAT OF SURVEY FOR Clarence E. & Karen V. Ellis

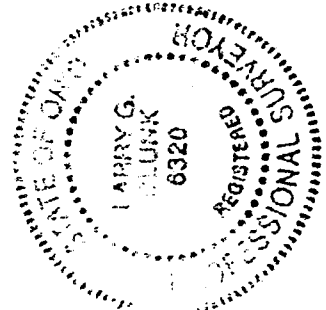

FOR  
CLARENCE E. AND KAREN V. ELLIS

Located in the Township of Troy, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being a part of the Northeast Quarter of Section 35, Township 20, Range 19 and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a railroad spike found in the Southeast Corner of the Northeast Quarter of Section 35.

Thence S 90 degrees 00' 00" W along the south line of the Northeast Quarter of Section 35, said line also being the centerline of Kings Corners East Rd. C.H. 35, a distance of 486.46 feet to a pk nail set and the True Place of Beginning.

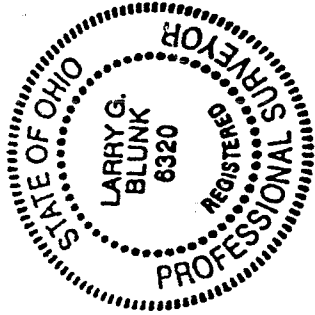
Thence continuing S 90 degrees 00' 00" W along the south line of the Northeast Quarter of Section 35, said line also being the centerline of Kings Corners Rd. C.H. 35, a distance of 145.00 feet to a pk nail set.

Thence N 00 degrees 18' 57" W passing thru an iron pin found at 32.72 feet a total distance of 301.00 feet to an iron pin set.

Thence N 90 degrees 00' 00" E a distance of 145.00 feet to an iron pin set.

Thence S 00 degrees 18' 57" E passing thru an iron pin found at 268.67 feet and 0.20 feet east a total distance of 301.00 feet to the True Place of Beginning and containing 1.0019 acres more or less but subject to all legal highways also all easements of record.
