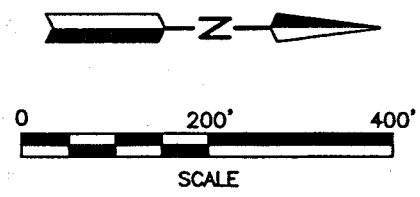

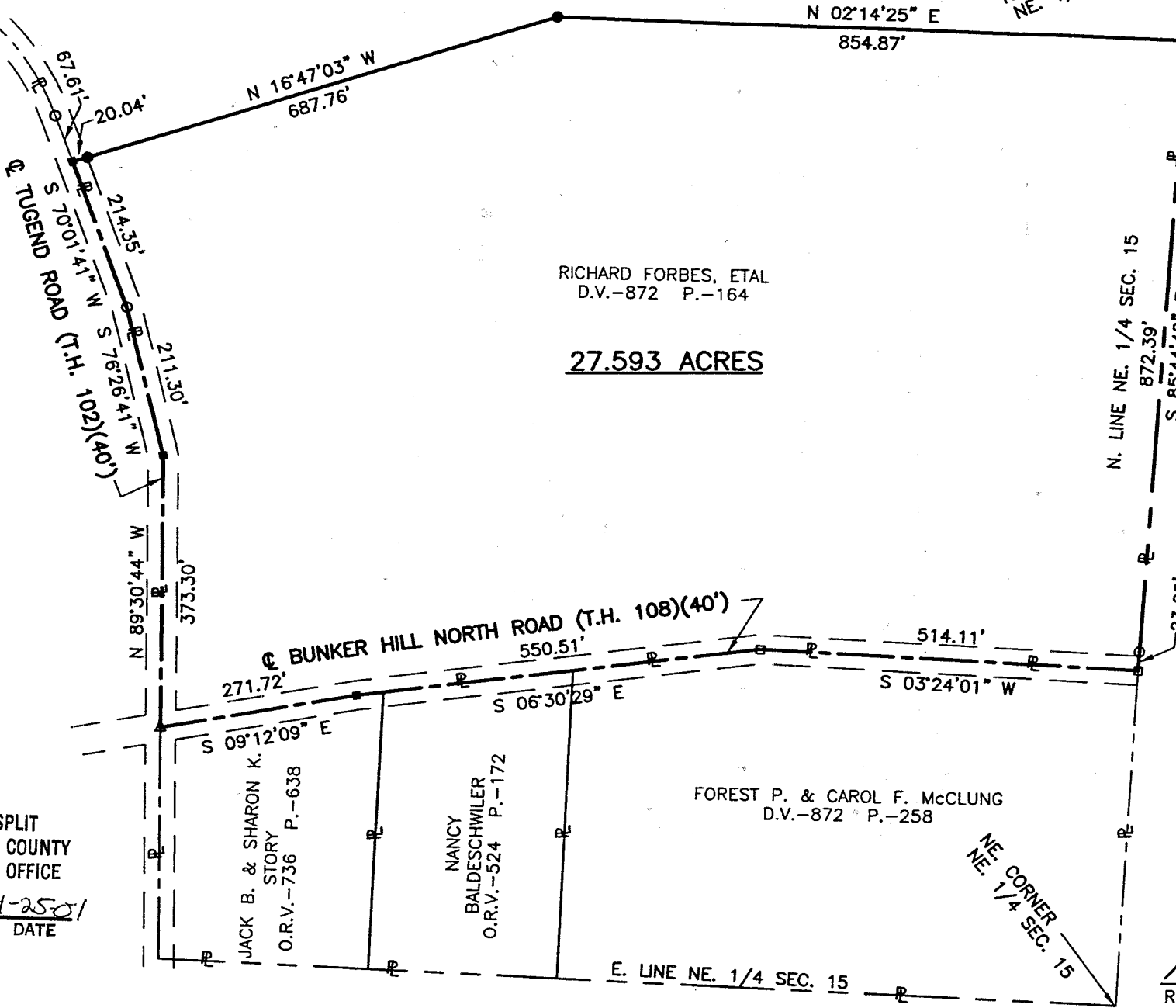

**SURVEYOR'S DESCRIPTION FOR  
LARRY SMITH**

Situated in the Township of Worthington, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being part of the Northeast Quarter of Section 15, Township 21, Range 17 and being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at an iron pin found in the northwest corner of said Northeast Quarter;

Thence S 85° 44' 42" E, 1,292.80 feet along the north line of said Northeast Quarter to an iron pin set, said iron pin being the true place of beginning;

Thence continuing S 85° 44' 42" E, 872.39 feet along the north line of said Northeast Quarter to a railroad spike found in the centerline of Bunker Hill North Road (C.H. 108) and passing through an iron pin found at 849.39 feet;

Thence S 03° 24' 01" W, 514.11 feet along said centerline of Bunker Hill North Road to a railroad spike found;

Thence S 06° 30' 29" E, 550.51 feet and continuing along said centerline of Bunker Hill North Road to a railroad spike set;

Thence S 09° 12' 09" E, 271.72 feet and continuing along said centerline of Bunker Hill North Road to a P.K. nail found in the centerline of Tugend Road (T.H. 102);

Thence N 89° 30' 44" W, 373.30 feet along said centerline of Tugend Road to a railroad spike set;

Thence S 76° 26' 41" W, 211.30 feet and continuing along said centerline of Tugend Road to an iron pin found;

Thence S 70° 01' 41" W, 214.35 feet and continuing along said centerline of Tugend Road to railroad spike set;

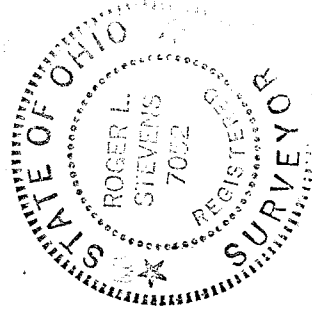
Thence N 16° 47' 03" W, 687.76 feet to an iron pin set and passing through an iron pin set at 20.04 feet;

Thence N 02° 14' 25" E, 854.87 feet to the true place of beginning and containing 27.593 acres, more or less, and subject to all legal highways and easements of record.

Bearings are to an assumed meridian and are used to express angles only.

All iron pins set are 5/8" diameter reinforcing rod with plastic cap stamped "STEVENS 7052".
