



SURVEY DESCRIPTION PARCEL "A"

PART OF THE NE QUARTER OF SECTION 3 WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP RICHLAND COUNTY, OHIO

Situated in the Township of Washington, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being a part of the Northeast quarter of Section 3 of Township 20 North, Range 18 West, and being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at an iron pin found marking the point of intersection of the centerline of Hull Road (T.H. 316) and the centerline of Woodville Road (T.H. 308); Thence, South 01 degree 35 minutes 41 seconds East with the centerline of Woodville Road, 243.89 feet to a point being referenced by an iron pin found on a bearing of South 88 degrees 54 minutes 51 seconds West and at a distance of 30.00 feet, said point being the southeast corner of a parcel currently owned by T.L. & S.L. Clark (O.R.V. 2675, Page 830) and being the place of beginning of the parcel herein described:

Thence, continuing South 01 degree 35 minutes 41 seconds East with said centerline 217.98 feet to a point referenced by an iron pin found on a bearing of South 88 degrees 20 minutes 12 seconds West and at a distance of 39.72 feet, said point being the northeast corner of a parcel currently owned by D.A. Hooks & L.J. Trifiletti (O.R.V. 234, Page 866);

Thence, South 88 degrees 20 minutes 12 seconds West with the north line of said Hooks and Trifiletti parcel passing through said iron pin found 298.69 fee to an iron pin found on the northwest corner of said parcel;

Thence, South 03 degrees 48 minutes 42 seconds West with the west line of said parcel 201.16 feet to an iron pin found on the southwest corner of said parcel;

Thence, South 88 degrees 15 minutes 06 seconds West 50.00 feet to an iron pin set;

Thence, North 01 degree 35 minutes 41 seconds West passing through an iron pin set for reference at a distance of 635.81 feet, a total distance of 665.81 feet to a point in the centerline of Woodville Road;

Thence, North 88 degrees 54 minutes 08 seconds East with said centerline 99.75 feet to a point referenced by an iron pin found on a bearing of South 01 degree 34 minutes 19 seconds East and at a distance of 30.00 feet, said point also being the northwest corner of said Clark parcel;

Thence, South 01 degree 34 minutes 19 seconds East with the west line of said Clark parcel passing through said iron pin found 243.83 feet to an iron pin found on the southeast corner of said Clark parcel;

Thence, North 88 degrees 54 minutes 51 seconds East with the south line of said Clark parcel passing through an iron pin found at a distance of 238.00 feet, a total distance of 268.00 feet to the place of beginning, containing 2.69 acres according to a survey by Chad F. Craig P.S. #8195 for Seiler & Craig Surveying, Inc. on November 10, 2022, but subject to all easements, right of ways and highways of record.

Hooks & L.J. Trifiletti (O.R.V. 234, Page 866) and being the place of beginning of the parcel herein described;

Thence, continuing South 01 degree 35 minutes 41 seconds East with the centerline of Woodville Road 437.71 feet to a point being referenced by an iron pin found on a bearing of South 88 degrees 04 minutes 34 seconds West and at a distance of 23.72 feet, said point being the northeast corner of a parcel currently owned by R.L. Williamson JR. & D.S. Williamson Co Trustees (O.R.V. 2436, Page 94);

Thence, South 88 degrees 04 minutes 34 seconds West with the north line of said Williamson parcel and passing through said iron pin found 367.65 feet to an iron pin set;

Thence, North 01 degree 35 minutes 41 seconds West 438.84 feet to an iron pin set;

Thence, North 88 degrees 15 minutes 06 seconds East passing through an iron pin found for reference at a distance of 327.65 feet, a total distance of 367.65 feet to the place of beginning, containing 3.70 acres according to a survey by Chad F. Craig P.S. #8195 for Seiler & Craig Surveying, Inc. on November 10, 2022, but subject to all easements, right of ways and highways of record.
