

SURVEY DESCRIPTION PARCEL "A"

PART OF THE SW QUARTER OF SECTION 2 PERRY TOWNSHIP RICHLAND COUNTY. OHIO

Situated in the Township of Perry, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being a part of the Southwest quarter of Section 2 of Township 19 North, Range 19 West, and being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a railroad spike found and accepted as marking the northeast corner of said quarter and being a point in the centerline of Mock Road (T.H. 32), Thence, North 89 degrees 55 minutes 26 seconds West with the north line of said quarter and with said centerline 542.53 feet to a point referenced by an iron pin found on a bearing of South 00 degrees 10 minutes 47 seconds West and at a distance of 18.25 feet, said point marking the northwest corner of a parcel currently owned by P. Parker and B. Moore (ORV 3001, Page 1300), said point being the place of beginning of the parcel herein described;

Thence, South 00 degrees 10 minutes 47 seconds West with the west line of said Parker and Moore parcel and passing through said iron pin found and passing through a wooden corner post at a distance of 989.46 feet, a total distance of 989.96 feet to an iron pin set on the north line of a parcel currently owned by K. & D. Kleer (ORV 2274, Page 416);

Thence, North 89 degrees 55 minutes 26 seconds West with the north line of said Kleer parcel 472.00 feet to an iron pin set marking the southeast corner of a parcel currently owned by Jared M. Feilon, Trustee (ORV 3000, Page 1317);

Thence, North 00 degrees 10 minutes 06 seconds East with the east line of said Feilon parcel 449.09 feet to a point referenced by an iron pin set on a bearing of North 00 degrees 10 minutes 06 seconds East and at a distance of 4.00 feet;

Thence, South 89 degrees 55 minutes 26 seconds East 322.09 feet to a point;

Thence, North 00 degrees 10 minutes 47 seconds East passing through an iron pin set for reference at a distance of 515.87 feet, a total distance of 540.87 feet to a point on the north line of said quarter and in said centerline;

Thence, South 89 degrees 55 minutes 26 seconds East with the north line of said quarter and with said centerline 150.00 feet to the place of beginning, containing 6.73 acres according to a survey by Chad F. Craig P.S. #8195 for Seiler & Craig Surveying, Inc. on May 18, 2023, but subject to all easements, right of ways and highways of record.

Situated in the Township of Perry, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being a part of the Southwest quarter of Section 2 of Township 19 North, Range 19 West, and being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a railroad spike found and accepted as marking the northeast corner of said quarter and being a point in the centerline of Mock Road (T.H. 32), Thence, North 89 degrees 55 minutes 26 seconds West with the north line of said quarter and with said centerline 692.53 feet to a point referenced by an iron pin found on a bearing of South 00 degrees 10 minutes 47 seconds West and at a distance of 25.00 feet, said point being the place of beginning of the parcel herein described;

Thence, South 00 degrees 10 minutes 47 seconds West passing through said iron pin set, a total distance of 540.87 feet to an iron pin set;

Thence, North 89 degrees 55 minutes 26 seconds West 322.09 feet to a point on the east line of a parcel currently owned by Jared M. Feilon, Trustee (ORV 3000, Page 1317) and being referenced by an iron pin set on a bearing of North 00 degrees 10 minutes 06 seconds East and at a distance of 4.00 feet;

Thence, North 00 degrees 10 minutes 06 seconds East with the east line of said Feilon parcel and passing through said iron pin set, and passing through an iron pin set for reference at a distance of 515.88 feet, a total distance of 540.88 feet to a point on the north line of said quarter and in said centerline;
