

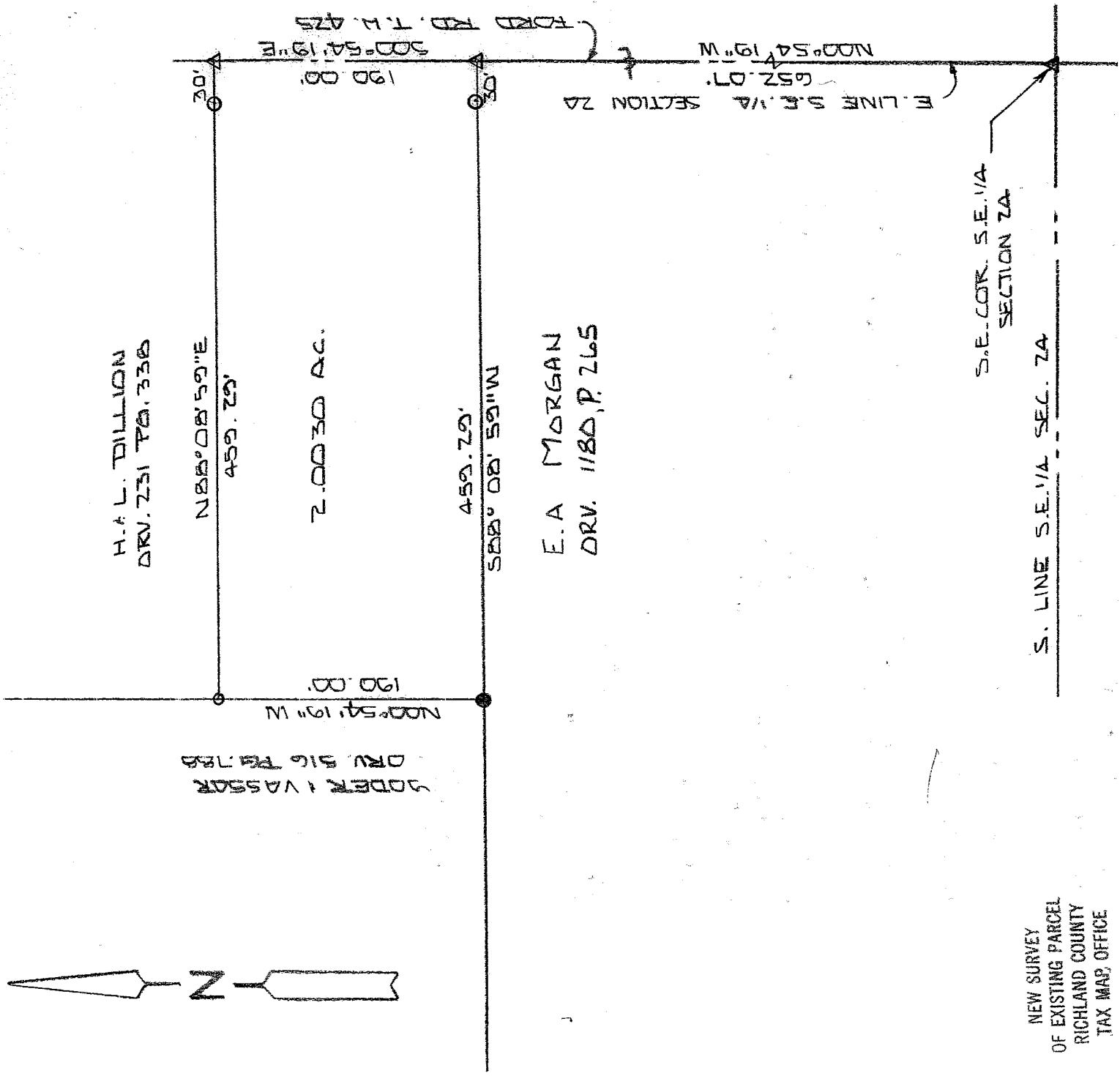

# PLAT OF SURVEY FOR ELIZABET MORGAN

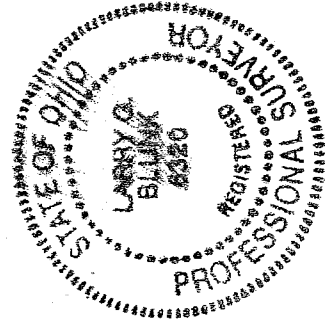

Located in the Township of Madison, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being a part of the Southeast Quarter of Section 24, Township 21, Range 18 and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a pk nail set in the Southeast Corner of the Southeast Quarter of Section 24.

Thence N 00 degrees 54' 19" W along the east line of the Southeast Quarter of Section 24, said line also being the centerline of Ford Rd. T.H. 425, a distance of 652.07 feet to a pk nail set and the True Place of Beginning.


Thence S 88 degrees 08' 59" W passing thru an iron pin set at 30.00 feet a total distance of 459.29 feet to an iron pin found.

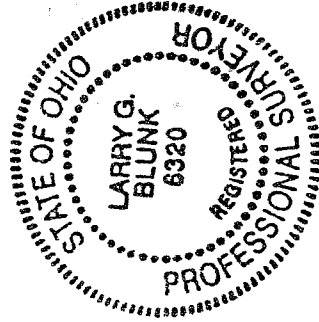
Thence N 00 degrees 54' 19" W a distance of 190.00 feet to an iron pin set.

Thence N 88 degrees 08' 59" E passing thru an iron pin set at 429.29 feet a total distance of 459.29 feet to a pk nail set on the east line of the Southeast Quarter of Section 24.

Thence S 00 degrees 54' 19" E along the east line of the Southeast Quarter of Section 24, said line also being the centerline of Ford Rd. T.H. 425, a distance of 190.00 feet to the True Place of Beginning and containing 2.0030 acres more or less but subject to all legal highways also all easements of record.
